Inspired by Kelly Ventura's "Aria" collection for Windham Fabrics
Size: 53" x 74"

Materials

- 1 fat quarter “Aria” bundle
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yard Artisan cotton - 40171-20

Backing Fabric & Binding

- Composed of fabrics of your choice.

Cutting Instructions

- From your fat quarter bundle cut:
 - 22 9.5” squares
 - 84 5” squares
- From Artisan Cotton 40171-20 cut:
 - 118.5” x 40.75” piece (center block, section 1)

Assembly (All blocks are chosen at random for this scrappy-inspired quilt. See section guide below for assembly assistance.)

- Sew two sets of four 5” blocks together; piece to short sides of center block. (Section 2)
- Sew two sets of 11 5” blocks together; piece to long sides of center block. (Section 3)
- Sew two sets of three 9.5” blocks together; piece to short sides of center block. (Section 4)
- Sew two sets of eight 9.5” blocks together; piece one set to long side of center block and trim excess. Repeat for the opposite long side, staggering piece to trim. (Section 5)
- Sew two sets of 10 5” blocks together; piece to short sides of center block. (Section 6)
- Sew two sets of 17 5” blocks together, piece to long sides of center block to complete piecing. (Section 7)

Finishing the Quilt

Layer the top, batting and backing together and baste. Quilt as desired and then bind.
