

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Fabric Requirements

1 1/4 yds 41273-X (can be cut lengthwise on fold)

1 1/4 yds 41274-X (can be cut lengthwise on fold)

1 5/8 yds 41275-2

5/8 yd 41278-4

1/2 yd 41278-3,5,6

1/3 yd 41276-4

1/2 yd 41277-4

3/4 yd 41277-2

Fat 1/8s of 41276-1,3 and 41278-1,7





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Cutting Instructions

From the all-over scenic print (41273-X), cut $2 - 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " LENGTHWISE strips

From the scenic stripe (41274-X) cut 2 - 4" LENGTHWISE strips

From the brown border fabric (41275-2) cut 4 - 5" LENGTHWISE strips for outer border

From cream tonal (41278-4) cut:

- 3-3 3/8" strips; cut into 32 3 3/8" squares, cut once diagonally
- $2-3\frac{3}{4}$ " strips; cut into 16 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares, cut twice diagonally

From the red tonal (41278-5) cut:

- $5 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips for inner border
- 8 oak leaves for applique
- 3 circles for applique

From the orange tonal (41278-6) cut:

- $1-3\frac{3}{4}$ " strip; cut into $8-3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares, cut twice diagonally
- 12 oak leaves for applique
- 2 circles for applique

From the green tonal (41278-3) cut:

- $1-3\frac{3}{4}$ " strip; cut into $8-3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares, cut twice diagonally
- 5 rings for applique

From the cream trees (41276-4) cut $5 - 8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for applique background

From the light pebbles (41277-4) cut:

 $3-4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips; cut into $20-4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

From the dark pebbles (41277-2) cut:

- $2-1\sqrt[3]{4}$ " strips; cut to 40 ½" for horizontal inner borders
- $6-2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for binding

From your remaining assorted colors, cut a TOTAL of 11-5" squares for hourglass blocks.

Piecing Instructions

Using the cream quarter triangles and the orange and green quarter triangles, make these units. Make 32 of each.





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Sew a cream half triangle to each of these units.



Sew 4 units of like color together to create a block. Make 8 blocks or each color.





Sew blocks into 2 rows of 8 blocks each, alternating colors.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each light pebble 4 ½" square. Sew these to the 8 ½" squares as connector corners to create the square in a square blocks.

Sew on drawn line. Trim off excess leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press triangle out. Repeat on remaining 3 corners.







Prepare applique using your preferred method. The given templates do <u>not</u> include a seam allowance. Stitch your Oak Leaf and Reel blocks to the centers of the square in a square blocks. Sew blocks together into a row.


Collect the 5" squares for hourglass blocks and pair them together in contrasting colors. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one of the squares. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on drawn line and press seam toward the same fabric in each half square triangle. Draw a line diagonally, but in the opposite direction of your stitching on one of these half square triangles. Lay right sides together, with like fabrics opposite each other. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on line and press seams to one side.

Trim to 3 7/8". Make 22 blocks. Sew together into 2 rows of 11 blocks each.











Page 5

Reference the cover photo for row placement. Pin well and sew rows together.

Piece red inner border strips into one long strip using diagonal seams.

Measure quilt center from top to bottom. Cut 2 inner border strips to this length. Pin carefully and sew to quilt.

Measure quilt across, including borders just sewn on. Cut 2 inner border strips to this length, pin and sew to quilt.

Repeat process for brown outer borders.

Quilt, bind and enjoy!
