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#### **Cutting Instructions:**

1. From fabric A, cut for:

Pieced basket units -

Widthwise, 14 (2 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 192 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") squares.

Widthwise, 6 (4 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 96 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") rectangles.

Widthwise, 3 (4 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 24 (4 7/8" x 4 7/8") squares.

Sashing rectangles -

Widthwise, 9 (2 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 17 (2 1/2" x 16 1/2") rectangles.

Inner border -

Widthwise, 7 (2 1/2" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 2 (2 1/2" x 56 1/2") and 2 (2 1/2" x 70 1/2") strips.

Step 2. From each fabric B, C and D cut for:

Pieced basket units -

Widthwise, 2 (2 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 21 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") squares.

Step 3. From each fabric E, F and G, cut from each fabric for:

Pieced basket units

Widthwise, 2 (2 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 15 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") squares.

4. From fabric H, cut for:

Pieced basket units -

Widthwise, 4 (2 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 14 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") squares.

Widthwise, 3 (4 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 24 (4 7/8" x 4 7/8") squares.

5. From fabric I, cut for:

Pieced basket units -

Widthwise, 3 (2 7/8" x 42"). Subcut 36 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") squares.

Sashing squares -

Widthwise, 1 (2 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 6 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") squares.

6. From fabric J, cut for:

Outer border -

Widthwise, 7 (4 1/2" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 2 (4 1/2" x 64 1/2") and 2 (4 1/2" x 74 1/2") strips.

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#### **Constructing Pieced Basket Units (using Fabric B as example)**

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") fabric B square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 (2 7/8" x 2 7/8") fabric A square. Sew 1/4" away from, on both right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units as shown below.:

Repeat to make a total of 6 fabric B and 2 fabric H small HST units as shown below:




2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (4 7/8" x 4 7/8") fabric H square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 (4 7/8" x 4 7/8") fabric A square. Sew 1/4" away from, on both right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 large HST units as shown below:



Square to 4 1/2"


3. Arrange and sew together 5 fabric B and 1 fabric H small HST units as shown below:





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Add 1 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") fabric A rectangle to the left of sewn unit to complete top half of basket unit as shown below:




Arrange and sew 1 fabric H, 1 fabric B small HST units and 1 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") fabric A rectangle, as shown below:



Add 1 fabric H large HST unit to the left of sewn unit to complete bottom half of basket unit as shown:



4. Sew both top and bottom halves to complete 1 basket unit.









#### **Block Assembly**

1. Arrange and sew together 4 basket units together into a block as shown: 1 fabric C, 1 fabric B, 1 fabric I and 1 fabric D. Repeat to make a total of 7 blocks.



Square to 16 1/2"

2. Arrange and sew together 4 basket units together into a block as shown: 1 fabric F, 1 fabric E, 1 fabric G, and 1 fabric I. Repeat to make a total of 5 blocks.



Square to 16 1/2"




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
#### **Quilt Assembly**

1. Arrange and sew 3 blocks and 2 (2 1/2" x 16 1/2") fabric A sashing rectangles into rows, noting the orientations of the basket blocks.



2. Pieced sashing row. Arrange and sew together 3 (2 1/2" x 16 1/2") fabric A sashing rectangles and 2 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") fabric I squares into a row.




Repeat to make a total of 3 pieced sashing rows.



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3. Quilt Center. Sew rows and pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.



4. Inner border. Sew 1 (41/2" x 70 1/2") fabric A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 1 (21/2" x 56 1/2") fabric A strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

5. Outer border. Sew 1 (4 1/2" x 74 1/2") fabric J strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 1 (4 1/2" x 64 1/2") fabric J strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

#### **Quilting Instructions:**

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.

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
