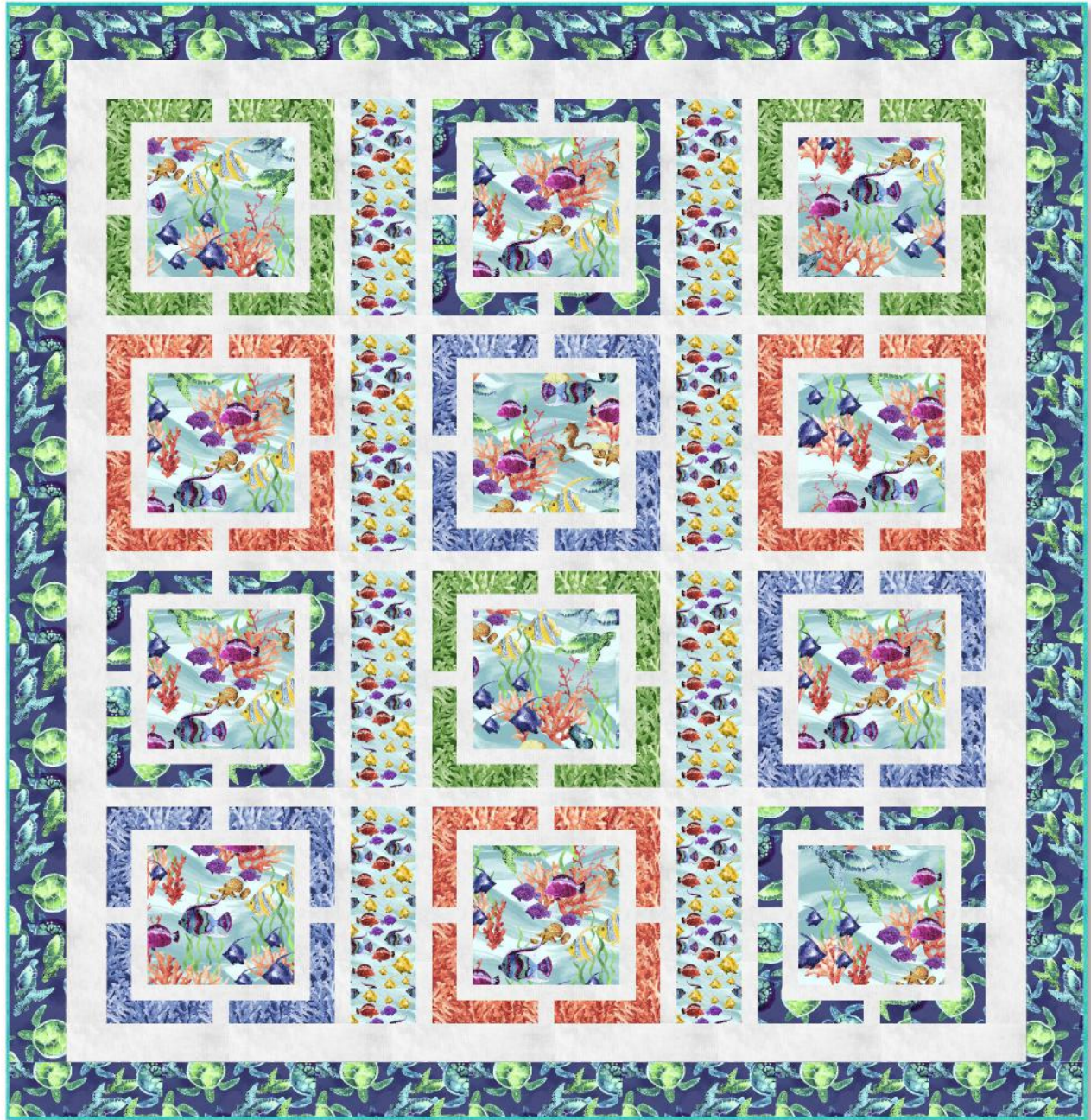

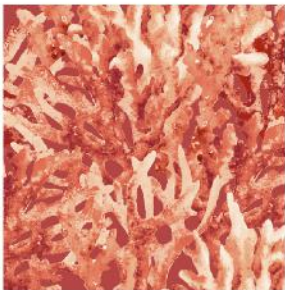
Supplies:

1. 3/8y green coral print (41491-4 Green)
2. 3/8y red coral print (41491-3 Coral)
3. 3/8y blue coral print (41491-Blue)
4. 1y focal print (41488-X Multi)
5. 1/2y blue swimming fish print (41489-2 Aqua)
6. 1 7/8y light gray tonal (37098-12 Chalk)
7. 1 1/8y blue sea turtle print (41490-1 Blue)

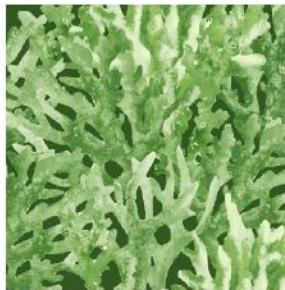
Optional: 5/8y turquoise tonal (37098-44), cut into 2 1/4" strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.

72"x 77" piece of backing fabric (4 5/8y)

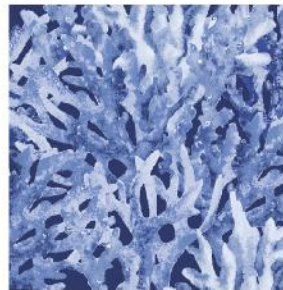
72" x 77" piece of batting

Cutting Instructions:

Page 3

Steps 1, 2 AND 3. From green coral, red coral and blue coral print, cut from each fabric for:

Pieced blocks -

Widthwise, 4 (2" x 42"). Subcut 12 (2" x 5 1/2") and 12 (2" x 7") rectangles.

4. From focal print, cut for:

Pieced blocks -

Widthwise, 3 (9 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 12 (9 1/2" x 9 1/2") squares.

5. From blue swimming fish print, cut for

Pieced sashing units -

Widthwise, 1 (14 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 8 (4 1/2" x 14 1/2") rectangles.

6. From light gray tonal, cut for:

Pieced blocks -

Widthwise, 2 (2" x 42"). Subcut 48 (1 1/2" x 2") rectangles.

Widthwise, 1 (9 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 24 (1 1/2" x 9 1/2") rectangles.

Widthwise, 1 (11 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 24 (1 1/2" x 11 1/2") rectangles.

Pieced sashing units -

Widthwise, 8 (1 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 16 (1 1/2" x 14 1/2") rectangles.

Sashing strips -

Widthwise, 4 (1 3/4" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 3 (1 3/4" x 54 1/2") strips.

Inner border -

Widthwise, 6 (3" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 2 (3" x 59 1/2") and 2 (3" x 60 1/4") strips.

7. From blue sea turtle print, cut for:

Pieced blocks -

Widthwise, 4 (2" x 42"). Subcut 12 (2" x 5 1/2") and 12 (2" x 7") rectangles.

Outer border -

Widthwise, 7 (4" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 2 (4" x 6x 1/4" and 4" x 66 1/2") strips.



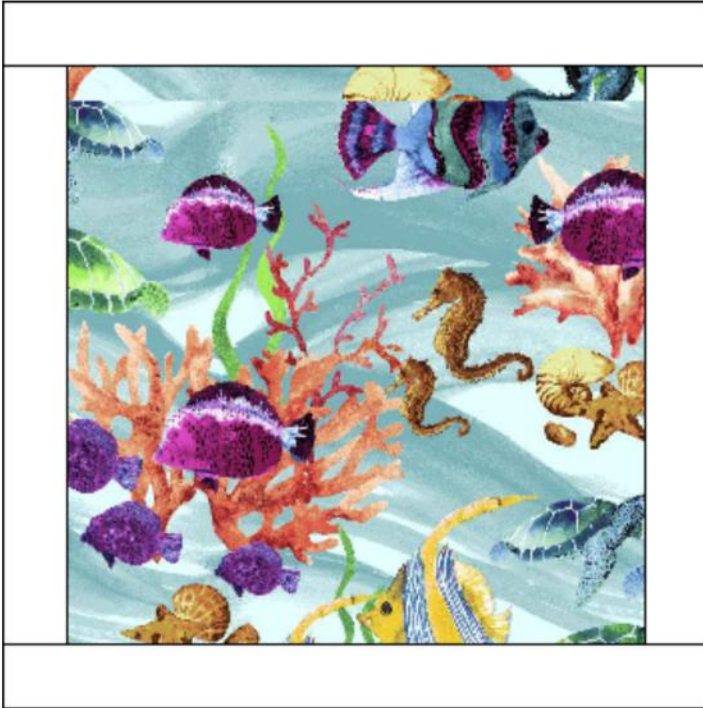

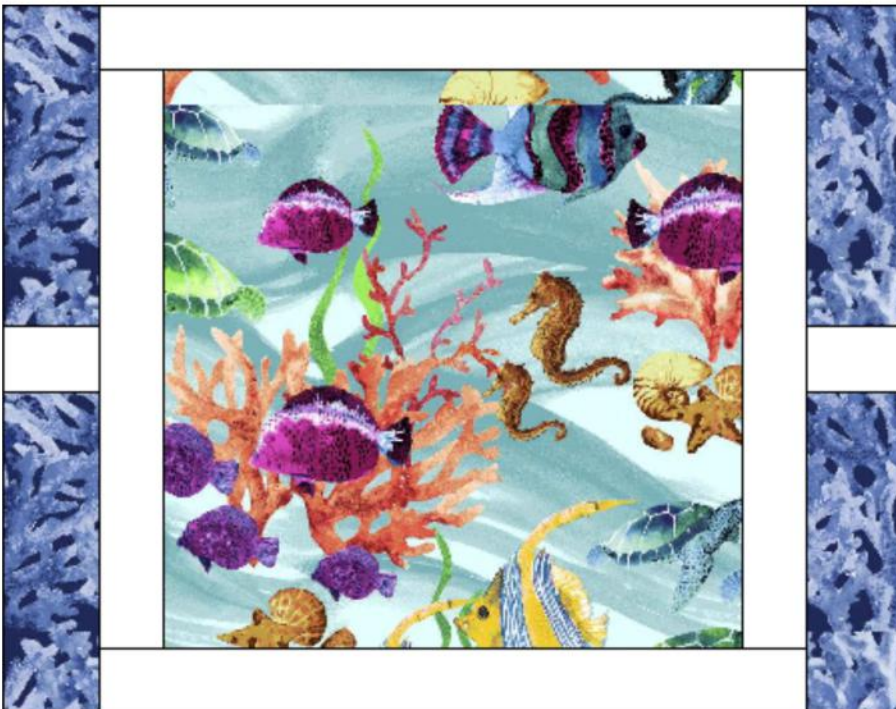

Constructing Pieced Block (using blue coral as example)

1. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 9 1/2") white rectangles on the opposite sides of 1 (9 1/2" x 9 1/2") focal square. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 11 1/2") white rectangles on the remaining opposite sides of focal square to complete block center.



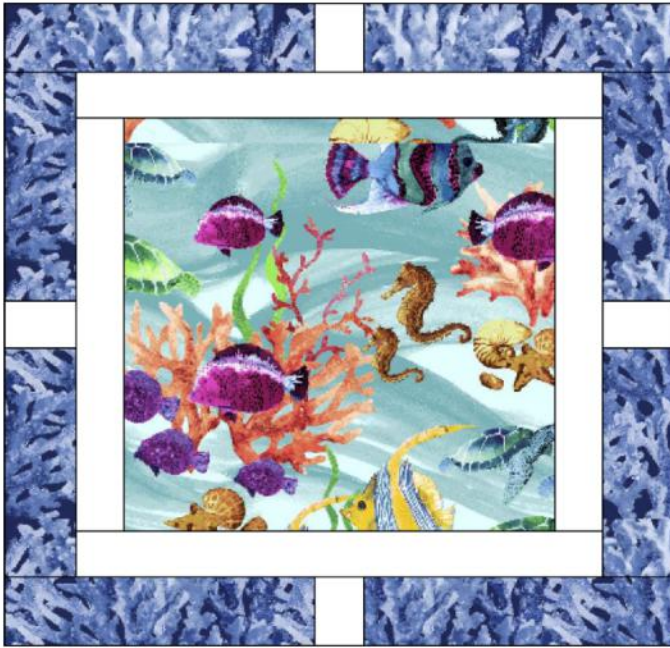
2. Sew 2 (2" x 5 1/2") blue coral rectangles to the opposite long sides of 1 (1 1/2" x 2") white rectangle into a column. Repeat to make a total of 2 columns, and add to the opposite sides of block center.

3. Sew 2 (2" x 7") blue coral rectangles to the opposite long sides of 1 (1 1/2" x 2") white rectangle into a row. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows, and add to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete 1 block.



Square to 14 1/2"

4. Repeat to make a total of three blocks for each of the following colorways:

Constructing Pieced Sashing Units

1. Arrange and sew together 2 (1 1/2" x 14 1/2") white and 1 (4 1/2" x 14 1/2") blue swimming rectangles to complete 1 unit.



Square to 6 1/2" x 14 1/2"

Quilt Center Assembly

1. Sewing blocks into rows. Sew 3 pieced blocks and 2 pieced sashing units together into rows.

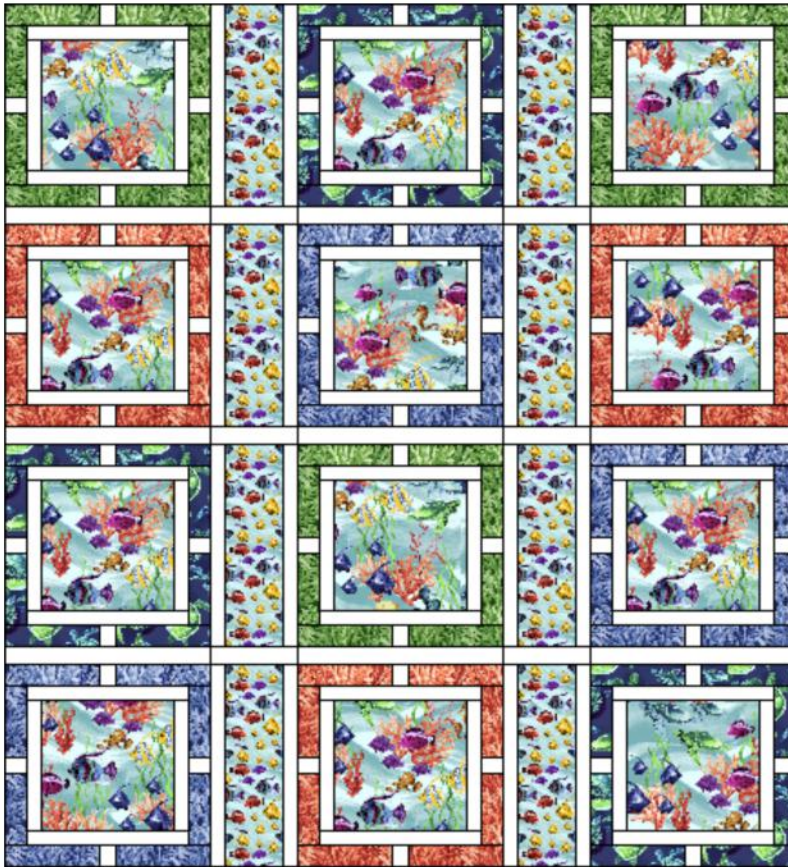

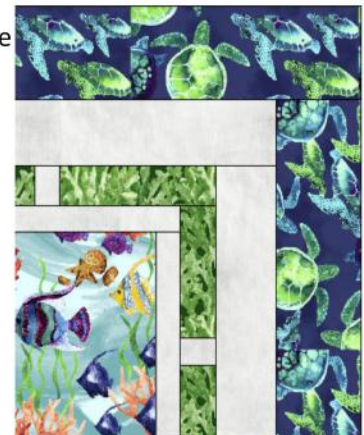


2. Arrange and sew together pieced rows and 3 (1 3/4" x 54 1/2") white sashing strips to complete quilt center.



Quilt Assembly

1. Inner border. Sew 2 (3" x 60 1/4") light gray tonal strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by 2 (3" x 59 1/2") light gray tonal strips on the top and bottom of quilt center.
2. Outer border. Sew 2 (4" x 65 1/4") blue sea turtle strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by 2 (4" x 66 1/2") blue sea turtle strips on the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.
3. Finished size: 66" x 71 3/4"

Quilting Instructions:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind to finish quilt.
