#### **Constructing Star Blocks**


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2"  $\times$  2" <pri>print> square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2"  $\times$  3 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal <pri>print> corner triangle.

Repeat to make (2) units using 2"  $\times$  3-1/2" **A** rectangles and (2) units using 2"  $\times$  5" **A** rectangles.

2. Sew units to the left and right sides of (1) 3  $1/2" \times 3 1/2" <$  print> square. Unit should measure  $6 1/2" \times 3 1/2"$  raw edge to raw edge.




3. Sew (1) 2" x 5"  $\mathbf{A}$  sewn unit made in Step 1 and (1) 2" x 2"  $\mathbf{A}$  square to make a row unit. Repeat to make (2) row units, and add to the remaining top and bottom sides of 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" <pri>cprint> square to make a block center. Block center should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.





4. Sew (2) 2"  $\times$  6 1/2" **A** rectangles to the opposite sides of block center, followed by (2) 2"  $\times$  9 1/2" **A** rectangles to complete (1) star block.




5. Make a total of (4) blocks each using the fabrics: **D, H, I, J.** 

#### **Constructing house block**

1. Row 1: Sew together from left to right: (1) 2"  $\times$  2 1/2" <print> rectangle, (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2 1/2" **A** rectangle, (1) 2 1/2"  $\times$  4 1/2" <print> rectangle, (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2 1/2" A rectangle, and (1) 2"  $\times$  2 1/2" <print> rectangle. Unit should measure 2 1/2"  $\times$  9 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.




2. Row 2: Sew together pieces to make a row: (1) <print> H, (1) A K, (1) <print> J, (1) A I, and (1) <print> D.






**NOTE:** The house blocks in the middle of the quilt, using skus **C**, **I** and **J**, are reversed.



- 3. Row 3.
- a. Sew (2) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2 1/2"  $\wedge$  rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  2 1/2" <pri> rectangle. Add (1) 2 1/2"  $\times$  3 1/2"  $\wedge$  rectangle and (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  3 1/2"  $\wedge$  rectangle to the top and bottom of sewn unit, measuring 3 1/2"  $\times$  5 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.



b. Sew together (3) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" **A** rectangles and (2) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" <print> rectangles.




Add (2) 1 1/2"  $\times$  5 1/2"  $\triangle$  rectangles to the top and bottom of sewn unit, followed by (1) 1 1/2"  $\times$  5 1/2" <pri>print rectangle to the top, measuring 5 1/2"  $\times$  5 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.




c. Sew units made in steps a and b to the left and right sides of (1) 1  $1/2" \times 5 1/2" < print >$ 

rectangle, respectively.


**NOTE:** The house blocks in the middle of the quilt, using skus **C**, **I** and **J**, are reversed.



4. Sew Rows 1-3 to complete (1) house block.



NOTE: The house blocks in the middle of the quilt, using skus **C**, **I** and **J**, are reversed. Look to the right for the correct positioning for these houses.



5. Make a total number of house blocks using the fabrics:

2 blocks: B

1 block: C, D, F, G, H, I, J



#### Constructing corner chain blocks


- 1. 9-patch units.
- a. Sew (1) 2"  $\times$  2" <print1> square and (1) 2"  $\times$  3 1/2" **A** rectangle to make a row unit. Repeat to make (2) row units.




Sew (2) 2" x 2" A squares to the opposite sides of (1) 2" x 2" <print1> square to make a row unit.



b. Sew row units together to complete (1) 9-patch units. Repeat to make (2) 9-patch units.




- 2. HST unit.
- a. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 5  $1/2" \times 5 1/2"$  **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 5  $1/2" \times 5 1/2" \times 5 1/2"$  square. Sew 1/4" away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST unit against 45-degree of quilting ruler, and trim HST units to measure  $5" \times 5"$  raw edge to raw edge.





3. Sew together (2) 9-patch units, (1) HST unit and (1)  $5" \times 5"$  **A** square into a 4-patch to complete (1) corner chain block.



4. Make (1) block each for <print1>/<print2> combinations: F/D, H/B, B/H, C/H, F/J, I/G, J/G, C/B, D/E, I/E, D/I and E/D.

#### **Constructing chain blocks**

- 1. Construction of 9-patch and HST units are the same as in corner chain blocks.
- 2. Sew together (2) <fabric 1> 9-patch, (1) <fabric2> HST unit, and (1) <fabric 3> HST unit to make a four-patch to complete (1) block.
- 3. Make a total number of blocks in the combination <fabric1>/<fabric2>/<fabric3>


2 blocks: J/C/B

1 block: C/B/D, D/B/H, H/D/I, I/H/J, B/I/E, C/J/G, B/C/J, E/I/C, G/E/B, E/B/G



### **Quilt Center Assembly**

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (7) pieced blocks to make a pieced row.



2. Sew pieced rows to complete quilt center as shown on page 9.





#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 63 1/2" **A** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3 1/2" x 69 1/2" **A** strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 2  $1/2" \times 69 1/2"$  **C** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2  $1/2" \times 73 1/2"$  **C** strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
- 3. Inner border #3. Sew (2) 1  $1/2" \times 73 \ 1/2" \ \mathbf{K}$  strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1  $1/2" \times 75 \ 1/2" \ \mathbf{K}$  strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.
- 4. Outer border. Sew (2)  $5" \times 75 \ 1/2"$  **J** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2)  $5" \times 84 \ 1/2"$  **J** strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### **Quilting Instructions**

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
