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Fabric Requirements

1 1/2 yards 37098-12 Chalk for background

1 1/2 yards 41556-X Multi for pieces and backing

5/8 yards 41558-3 Black for pieces and binding

1/8 yard 41557-1 Orange for pieces

1/8 yard 41557-2 Bone for pieces

1/8 yard 41559-1 Orange for pieces

1/8 yard 41559-4 Charcoal for pieces

1/8 yard 37098-01 Vine Black for pieces

1/8 yard 37098-17 Papaya for pieces

1/8 yard 41558-1 Orange for pieces

45"x 45" piece of batting

Cutting

Strips are cut at any desired measurement. The minimum and maximum widths are given.

From the 37098-12 Chalk cut:

(4) pieces from Template A

(2) 22 1/8" square, sub cut on the diagonal to make (4) Half Square Triangles (HST)

(2) strips 20" long, between 1 1/4"-2 1/4" in width

From the 41557-1 Orange, 41557-2 Bone,41558-1 Orange, 41559-1 Orange, 41559-4 Charcoal, 37098-01

Vine Black, and 37098-17 Papaya 41556-X Multi cut:

(4) strips 20" long of EACH print, between 1"-3
1/4" wide

From the 41558-3 Multi cut:

(1) 8 1/4" square, sub cut (1) of Template B on fold

(4) strips 20" long, between 1"-3 1/4" wide

(5) 2 1/4"x WOF strips




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
Instructions


Making the Blocks

1. Take all the 20" strips and randomly sew them together into (6) strip sets, measuring no less than 12" wide. Make sure that two of the strip sets have the 37098-12 Chalk 20" strips as the star strips. Press all of the seam allowances down.




2. From each strip set, cut (4) pieces from Template C as shown. Pay close attention, as the strips sets starting with the Chalk strips will be cut differently. There will be (24) wedges total.






3. Sew the Template C pieces together into pairs. Press to one side, and then sew (3) pairs together into a Quarter Circle, making sure there are (2) Chalk top pieces spaced throughout each Quarter Circle.






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4. Sew a 37098-12 Chalk Template A pieces to each Quarter Circle, matching ends and centers. Press towards the wedges. Sew these pieces together into a hollow square as shown.



5. Fold the 41558-3 Black Template B piece in half, and then half again, to mark the centers of the piece. Pin the hollow square to the Template B piece, matching centers and seam allowances as shown, so that the square is on point and the writing on the print is readable. Sew around the circle carefully to avoid puckers and press towards the circle, to make the Eye Block.



6. Sew the 37098-12 Chalk 22 1/8" HST to either side of the Eye Block. Press towards the HST. Trim and square the top to 43".



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7. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the 41558-3 Multi 2 1/4" wide binding strips, sew around the quilt top. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy!
