| A |  | Solid White Flannel | 1-1/2 | <p>Pieced blocks: 5 (1 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 9 (1 1/2" x 6") and 9 (1 1/2" x 10 1/2") rectangles. 3 (2" x 42"). Subcut 9 (2" x 4 1/2") and 9 (2" x 6") rectangles. 2 (2 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 18 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") squares. 2 (4 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 9 (4 1/2" x 7") rectangles. 1 (6 3/8" x 42"). Subcut 5 (6 3/8" x 6 3/8") squares. Cut squares diagonally once to yield 10 half-square-triangles. Will use only 9. Sashing pieces: 4 (1 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 6 (1 1/2" x 12 1/2") sashing rectangles, and 2 (1 1/2" x 32 1/2") sashing strips Inner border #1: 4 (1 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 2 (1 1/2" x 34 1/2") and 2 (1 1/2" x 38 1/2") strips.</p> |
| B |  | 42088-3 Green | 1/4 | <p>Pieced blocks: 1 (2" x 42"). Subcut 6 (2" x 2") squares. 2 (2 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 6 (2 1/2" x 10 1/2") rectangles.</p> |
| C |  | Grey Solid Flannel | 1/8 | <p>Pieced blocks: 3 (1" x 42"). Subcut 9 (1" x 8 1/2") rectangles.</p> |
| D |  | 42090-4 Yellow | 1/4 | <p>Pieced blocks: 1 (2 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 3 (2 1/2" x 10 1/2") rectangles and 3 (2" x 2") squares.</p> |
| E |  | 42089-2 Blue | 1/4 | <p>Pieced blocks: 3 (1 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 9 (1 1/2" x 10 1/2") rectangles.</p> |
| F |  | 42090-1 Red | 5/8 | <p>Pieced blocks: 1 (4 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 9 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares. 3/8 yd for Binding: 2 1/4" bias strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.</p> |
| G |  | 42087-2 Blue | 3/4 | <p>Pieced blocks: 1 (6 3/8" x 42"). Subcut 5 (6 3/8" x 6 3/8") squares. Cut squares diagonally once to yield 10 half-square-triangles. Will only use 9. Outer border: 5 (3 1/2" x 42"). Piece strips and subcut 4 (3 1/2" x 42 1/2") strips.</p> |
| H |  | 42089-3 Green | 1/4 | <p>Inner border #2: 4 (1 1/2" x 42"). Subcut 2 (1 1/2" x 36 1/2") and 2 (1 1/2" x 40 1/2") strips.</p> |
| | | Backing | 3 | 45" x 54" piece of batting |



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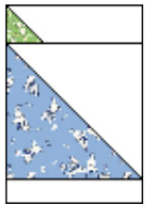
Constructing Pieced Blocks (using top left block as example)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (2" x 2") B square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of 1 (2" x 6") A rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal B corner triangle.



2. Sew 1 A half-square triangle and 1 B half-square triangle to make a HST unit, and add to the unit made in step 1.

3. Add 1 (1 1/2" x 6") A rectangle to the bottom of the unit to make Section 1.



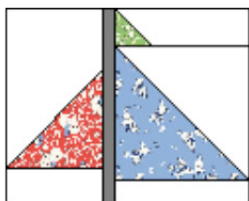
4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of 1 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") F square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of 1 (4 1/2" x 7") A rectangle. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal F corner triangle.



5. Add 1 (2" x 4 1/2") A rectangle to the unit made in step 4 to make Section 2.



6. Sew Section 1 and Section 2 to the right and left sides of 1 (1" x 8 1/2") C rectangle, respectively.



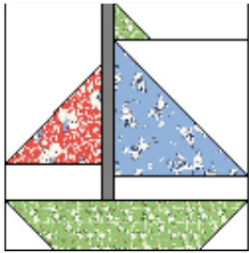


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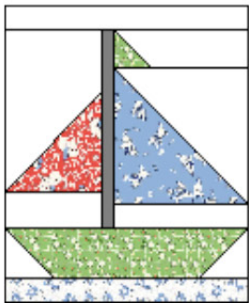
7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of 1 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of 1 (2 1/2" x 10 1/2") B rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") A square at the opposite corner of the same (2 1/2" x 10 1/2") B rectangle to complete sewn unit.



8. Sew units in step 6 and step 7 together.



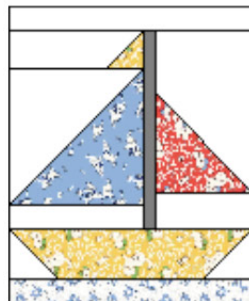
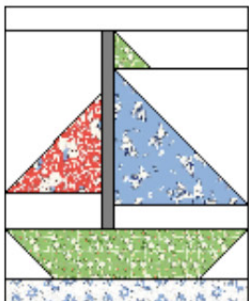
9. Sew 1 (1 1/2" x 10 1/2") A rectangle to the top, and 1 (1 1/2" x 10 1/2") E rectangle to the bottom of sewn unit made in step 8 to complete 1 block.



10. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways.

6 blocks:

3 blocks (note orientation of boat sails):





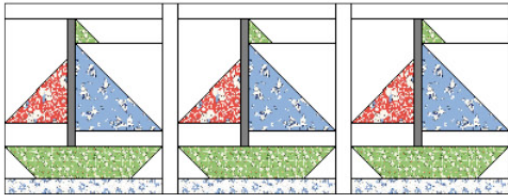
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Quilt Top Assembly

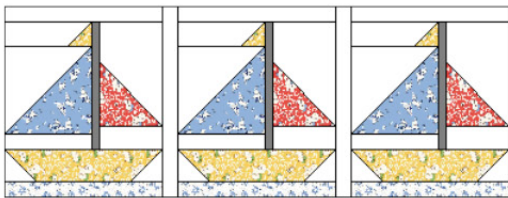
1. Quilt Center.

Pieced Rows. Sew 3 pieced blocks and 2 (1 1/2" x 12 1/2") A sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.

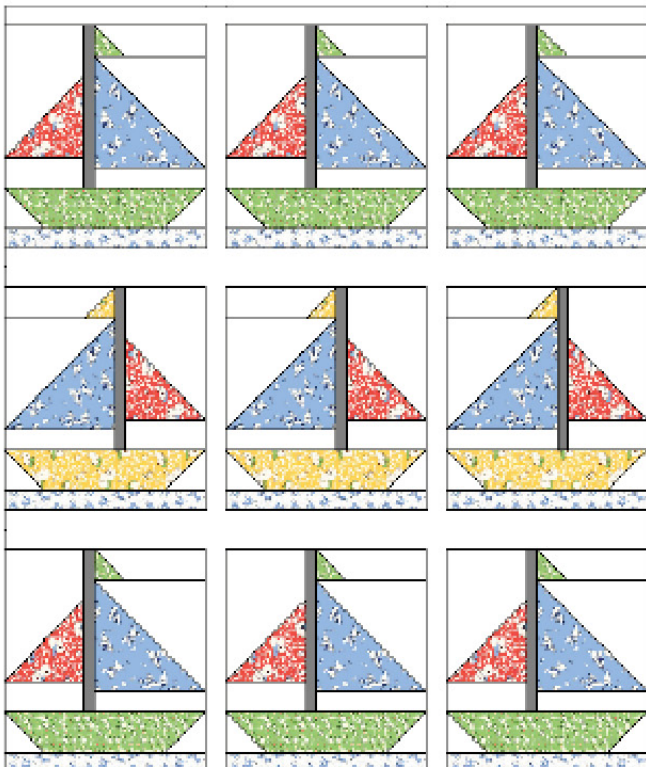
Rows 1 & 3



Row 2



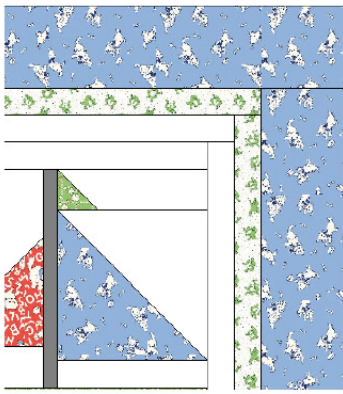
b. Sew pieced rows and 2 (1 1/2" x 32 1/2") A sashing strips to complete quilt center.





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2. Inner border #1. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 38 1/2") A strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 34 1/2") A strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
3. Inner border #2. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 40 1/2") H strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 36 1/2") H strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
4. Outer border. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 42 1/2") G strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 42 1/2") G strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
