





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Fabric Requirements

7/8 yard White Solid for background

1/4 yard 40288-X Multi for blocks

1/4 yard 40289-X Multi for blocks

1/4 yard 40290-1 Green for blocks

1/4 yard 40290-2 Grey for blocks

1/4 yard 40291-1 Green for blocks

1/4 yard 40291-3 Red for blocks

1/4 yard 40292-1 Green for blocks

2/3 yard 40292-3 Red for blocks and binding

1 yard any Seasons Greetings fabric for backing

45"x 45" piece of batting

Cutting

From the White Solid cut: 32 squares, 3 7/8"
12 rectangles, 1"x 9 1/2"
5 strips, 1"x 38"
2 strips, 1"x 39 1/2"

From the 40288-X Multi cut: 4 rectangles, 3 1/2"x 6 1/2" 8 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"

From the 40289-X Multi cut: 4 rectangles, 3 1/2"x 6 1/2" 8 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"

From the 40290-1 Green cut: 8 squares, 3 7/8"
16 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"

From the 40290-2 Grey cut: 8 squares, 3 7/8"
16 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"



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From the 40291-1 Green cut: 4 rectangles, 3 1/2"x 6 1/2" 8 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"

From the 40291-3 Red cut: 4 rectangles, 3 1/2"x 6 1/2" 8 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"

From the 40292-1 Green cut: 8 squares, 3 7/8"
16 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2"

From the 40292-3 Red cut: 8 squares, 3 7/8" 16 rectangles, 2"x 3 1/2" 4 strips, 2 1/4"x 42"

Instructions

Making the Blocks

- 1. Take the White Solid 3 7/8" squares and draw a line on the diagonal on each using a fabric marker. Place a White Solid 3 7/8" square right sides together (RST) with a 40290-1 Green 3 7/8" square and sew a line 1/4" away from either side of the drawn line. Press and cut the square apart on the drawn line. Open the pieces and press again to make two HST squares 3 1/2".
- 2. Repeat the above step for the remaining 40290-1 Green 3 7/8" squares, and then for the 40290-2 Grey, 40292-1 Green, and 40292-3 Red squares to make 16 HST squares of each print.













3. Take 8 of the 40290-1 Green 2"x 3 1/2" rectangles and sew them RST with the 40288-X Multi 2"x 3 1/2" rectangles. Trim and square to 3 1/2". Sew the 8 remaining 40290-1 Green 2"x 3 1/2" rectangles to either side of the 40288-X Multi 3 1/2"x 6 1/2" rectangles. Trim and square to 3 1/2"x 9 1/2".




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- 3. Repeat step two, pairing the following prints:
 - 40289-X Multi with the 40290-2 Grey
 - 40291-1 Green with the 40292-3 Red
 - 40291-3 Red with the 40292-1 Green



4. Take the 40290-1 Green HST squares, matching 3 1/2" green/multi squares, and 3 1/2"x 9 1/2" green/multi rectangles and sew them together as shown to make 4 snowball blocks. Repeat for the remaining pairs of prints to make 4 snowball blocks of each pairing. Trim and square to 9 1/2".





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Making the Quilt Top

- 5. Take 3 of each Snowball block and sew a 1"x 9 1/2" white solid rectangle to the bottom. Press towards the white.
- 6. Referring to the layout diagram for block order and placement, sew the blocks together into four columns, so that the snowball block without a white sash is on the bottom of the column as shown.



- 7. Sew the columns together with the 1"x 37 1/2" white solid strips between each column, and then sew the last 1"x 39 1/2" white solid strips to the top and bottom. Press the top well. There will be one
- 8. Piece the backing fabric together with leftover prints from the quilt top to make it at least 45" square. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the 40292-3 Red 2 1/4" wide binding strips, sew around the quilt top. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy!



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
