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Piecing Instructions:

Half Square Triangle Units:

1. Take (1) 5" A square and (1) 5" G square and place right sides together. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **G** square, then sew seam ¼" on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line, then press the (2) half square triangles (HST) open with the seam allowance towards darker fabric. Square to 4-1/2". Repeat to make (4) Large AG HST Units.





2. Repeat step 1 using the following squares to make all HST Units:

Large BG HST Units (8) - B and G 5" squares

Large CG HST Units (4) - C and G 5" squares

Medium DG HST Units (8) - D and G 4" squares – square to 3-1/2"

Medium EG HST Units (8) - E and G 4" squares

Medium FG HST Units (8) - F and G 4" squares

Small AG HST Units (8) - A and G 3" squares – square to 2-1/2"

Small BG HST Units (8) - B and G 3" squares

Small CG HST Units (8) - C and G 3" squares






















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Stem Units:

3. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of (2) 4-1/4" **G** squares, place (1) right sides together on top right corner of (1) **A** 4-1/2" square, then sew on drawn line. Press **G** square open and trim excess on the back to ¼". Repeat on opposite corner with other **G** square to complete **Large AG Stem Unit**. Square to 4-1/2", make (1).









4. Repeat step 3 using the following squares to make all Stem Units:

Large BG Stem Units (2) – B 4-1/2" and G 4-1/4" squares

Large CG Stem Unit (1) - **C** 4-1/2" and **G** 4-1/4" squares

Medium DG Stem Units (2) - D 3-1/2" and G 3-1/4" squares – square to 3-1/2"

Medium EG Stem Units (2) - E 3-1/2" and G 3-1/4" squares

Medium FG Stem Units (2) - F 3-1/2" and G 3-1/4" squares

Small AG Stem Units (2) - A 2-1/2" and G 2-1/4" squares – square to 2-1/2"

Small BG Stem Units (2) - **B** 2-1/2" and **G** 2-1/4" squares

Small CG Stem Units (2) - C 2-1/2" and G 2-1/4" squares



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Quilt Assembly: (refer to quilt diagram for proper rotation of blocks)

6. Sew the following pieces and blocks together into vertical rows.

Row 1:	Row 2:	Row 3:	Row 4:	Row 5:

7. Measure rows (ours are 56"), cut (4) G 2" sashing strips to fit, then sew rows and sashing strips together.

Border Assembly:

Border #1

8. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 56"), cut (2) **G** 3-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 54-1/2") cut (2) **G** 5-3/4" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #2:

9. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 66-1/2"), cut (2) **B** 1" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 55-1/2") cut (2) **B** 1" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt. <u>Trim the B border to ½" before adding Border #3.</u>

Border #3:

10. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 67"), cut (2) **G** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 57") cut (2) **G** 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
