Additional Requirements:

- 2 1/4 yards light weight woven fusible
- (1) 20" invisible zipper for Pillow 4
- 1/4 yard of MistyFuse® or other 2 sided fusible webbing for Appliques on Pillow 3
- (3) 20" square pillow forms and (1) 19 x 13" oblong pillow form

Special Notes:

** All seam allowances are 1/4" wide

It is best to starch your fabric before you cut the pieces as the fabric can be very crawly and can easily ravel.

Make sure you take your time to cut and sew carefully. With all items that have lots of piecing, your project can very easily become too small and you will have trouble later attaching pieces to make the correct size.



Twilight Pillows

Pillow 1

Cutting:

From 41094-1 Indigo Blue, 41098-1 Indigo Blue, 41096-1 Indigo Blue and 41097-1 Indigo Blue

Cut (1) 10 1/4" x 10 1/4" square of each fabric for face of pillow

From 41100-1 Indigo Blue

Cut (1) 20" x 14 3/4" rectangle for backing

Cut (1) 20" x 10 3/4" rectangle for backing

From light weight woven fusible interlining

Cut (1) 20" x 20" square



Pillow 1

Assembly:

Face

1. With right sides together, sew 2 squares together. Press seam open.
2. Sew the other 2 squares together as instructed for the first. Press seam open.
3. With right sides together, match seams at center and sew the first row of squares to the second row. Press seams open.
4. Sew a 3/16" topstitch on each side of the center seams that catch the seam allowance and keep it flat. Diagram A
5. Apply the light weight fusible to the wrong side of the fabric following the manufacturer's recommended instructions.

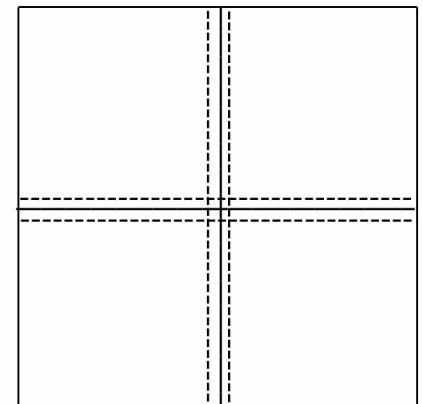

Back

6. Take 20" x 14 3/4" rectangle of the backing and on one long side, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1 1/2" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge. Diagram B
7. Take 20" x 10 3/4" rectangle and on one long side, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1/4" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge.
8. With right sides facing down, overlap the small piece on top of the larger piece so that the final length is 20". Pin the sides together to hold in place. The overlap is approximately 3".
9. Add an edge stitch on each end to hold the overlapped sections in place. Diagram C

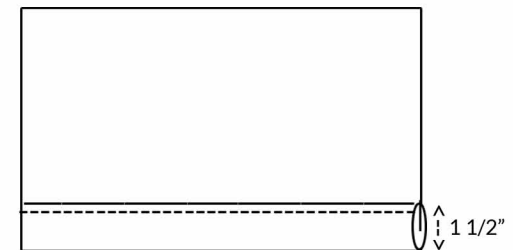

Finishing

10. With right sides together, place face on back and sew around the outside of the pillow shell on all 4 sides. Clip corner seam allowance and cover stitch seam allowance edges or add a tight zigzag stitch to prevent raveling. Turn and press.
11. Add a 20" pillow form to complete your pillow.

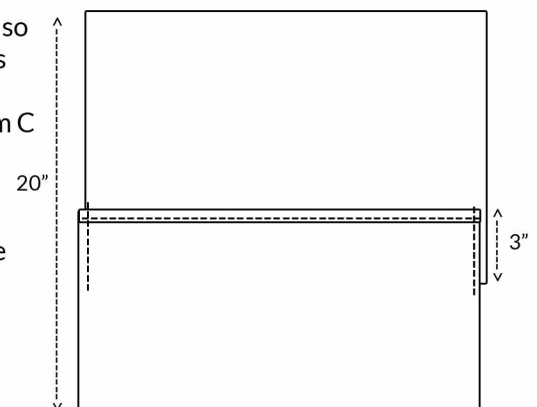

Pillow 2

Cutting:

- Cut (2) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" from 41094-1 Indigo Blue
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" from 41094-2 Twilight Blue
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" from 41095-1 Indigo Blue
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" from 41095-2 Twilight Blue
- Cut (3) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" and (2) 6 1/2" x 1 3/4" from 41096-2 Twilight Blue
- Cut (1) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" and (2) 6 1/2" x 1 3/4" from 41097-1 Indigo Blue
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" from 41098-1 Indigo Blue
- Cut (2) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" from 41099-1 Indigo Blue
- Cut (5) 1 3/4" x 6 1/2" and (2) 6 1/2" x 1 3/4" from 41099-2 Twilight Blue
- Cut (24) 1 5/8" x 6 1/2" and (2) 20 1/2" x 1 1/2" long from 41100-3 Ivory

From 41099-1 Indigo Blue

Cut (1) 20" x 14 3/4" rectangle for backing

Cut (1) 20" x 10 3/4" rectangle for backing

From light weight woven interlining

Cut (1) 20" x 20" square from the light weight woven interlining



Pillow 2

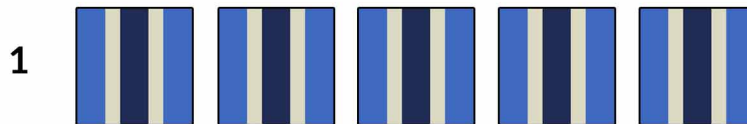
Assembly:

Face

1. Face will first be assembled in blocks.

BLOCK 1

Take (2) 6 1/2" strips of 41100-3 Ivory, (2) strips of Twilight Blue and (1) strip of Indigo Blue and assemble as follows to create (5) blocks. Each block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2". Press seams open.



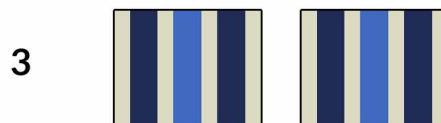
BLOCK 2

Take (3) 6 1/2" strips of 41100-3 Ivory, (2) strips of Twilight Blue and (1) strip of Indigo Blue and assemble as follows to create (2) blocks. Each block should measure 7 1/2" x 6 1/2". Press seams open.



BLOCK 3

Take (4) 6 1/2" strips of 41100-3 Ivory, (2) strips of Indigo Blue and (1) strip of Twilight Blue and assemble as follows to create (2) blocks. Each block should measure 8 1/2" x 6 1/2". Press seams open.



**Please note that accuracy in cutting as well as sewing is crucial to be sure the blocks all fit together properly. Take time to measure each block after sewn to be sure they measure correctly.*

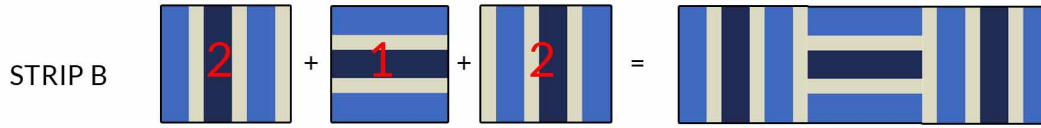
2. Arrange (3) of the blocks in a strip as shown. Repeat for a total of (2) strips. STRIP A
Press seams open.

3. Arrange (3) of the blocks in a strip as shown. STRIP B
Press seams open.



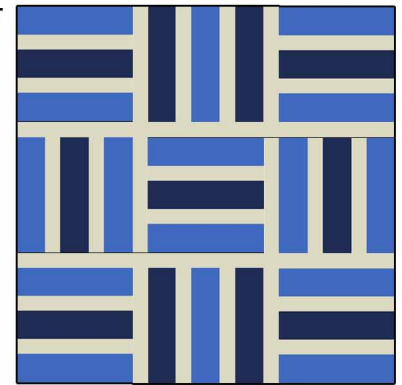
4. Take STRIP A and add one 20 1/2" strip of 41100-3 Ivory at the bottom as shown. Press seam open.



5. Take STRIP B and add one 20 1/2" strip of 41100-3 Ivory at the bottom as shown for STRIP A. Press seam open.



6. Take the 3 strips and arrange as follows to complete the top. Press seams open.
7. On the wrong side of top apply the lightweight woven fusible interlining to cover the seams and clean finish the back side of the top.



Back

8. Follow the back sewing instructions as given for Pillow 1.
**Note: Backing fabric is a stripe so take time to fussy cut stripes to match on back top to bottom*

Pillow 3

Cutting:

- From 41094-1 Indigo Blue
 - Cut (1) 20" x 8 1/2" strip
 - Cut (1) 20" x 5 1/2" strip
- From 41100-1 Indigo Blue Solid
 - Cut (1) 7 1/2" x 7" rectangle A
 - Cut (1) 7 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle B
 - Cut (1) circles from Template on last page
- From 41100-3 Ivory Solid
 - Cut (1) 7 1/2" x 6" rectangle C
 - Cut (1) 7 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle D
 - Cut (1) circles from Template on last page
- From 41095-1 Indigo Blue
 - Cut (1) 20" x 14 3/4" rectangle for backing
 - Cut (1) 20" x 10 3/4" rectangle for backing
- From Mistfuse® or any 2 sided fusible webbing
 - Cut (4) circles from Template on last page
- From light weight woven fusible interlining
 - Cut (1) 20" x 20" square

Page 6

Assembly:

1. Take the the (4) solid rectangles and arrange as shown in Diagram 1.
2. Press seams open and add a 1/8" topstitch on each side of the seams.
3. Take the (2) 41094-1 Indigo Blue strips and sew one on each side of the solid block strip; wider piece on top and the narrower piece at bottom. Press seams open. Add a 1/8" topstitch on each side of the seams.
4. Using circle template, cut circles from the solid fabric and arrange randomly on the solid area of pillow. They should overlap the seams as shown in Diagram 2.
5. Attach to the top using the fusible webbing following the manufacturer's recommended instructions. Secure to pillow using a tight zigzag stitch around each circle and center.
6. On the wrong side of top apply the lightweight woven fusible interlining to cover the seams and clean finish the back side of the top.

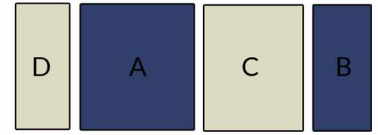

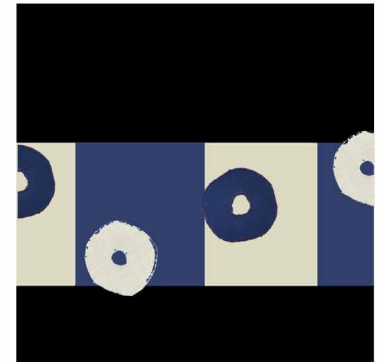

6. Follow the back sewing instructions as given for Pillow 1.

Pillow 4

Cutting:

41098-1 Indigo Blue

A - Cut (1) 3 1/4" square

B - Cut (1) 5 3/4" x 3 1/4" rectangle

41098-2 Twilight Blue

C - Cut (2) 3 1/4" x 4 1/4" rectangles

D - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" rectangle

E - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 4 3/4" rectangle

41095-1 Indigo Blue

F - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 5 3/4" rectangle

G - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" rectangle

H - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 7" rectangle

41095-2 Twilight Blue

I - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 7 1/2" rectangle

J - Cut (1) 3 1/4" x 5 3/4" rectangle

41096-2 Twilight Blue

K - Cut (1) 5 3/4" x 5 1/2" rectangle

L - Cut (1) 6" x 5 3/4" rectangle

41094-1 Indigo Blue

M - Cut (1) 5 1/2" x 6" rectangle

41100-3 Ivory Solid

N - Cut (7) 1 3/4" x 3 1/4" rectangle

O - Cut (14) 1 7/8" square

Light Weight Woven Fusible Interlining

Cut (1) 19" x 13" rectangle



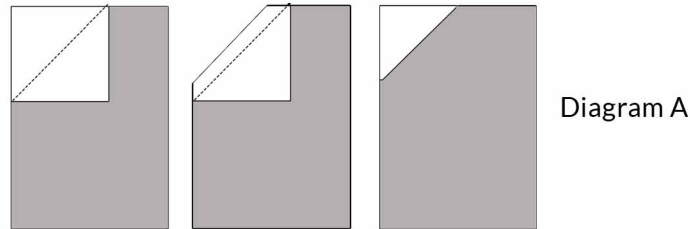

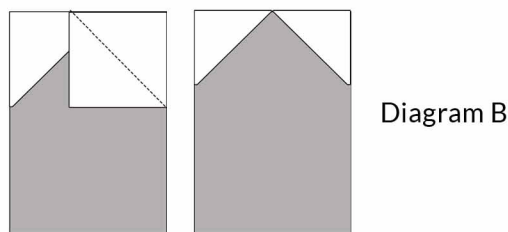
Twilight Pillows

Assembly:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 'O' Ivory squares. The sewing instructions will all be the same for all pointed rectangles:
(2) C, (1) D, (1) E, (1) G, (1) H, (1) I
With right sides together, place the ivory square on top of the upper left corner of the rectangle and sew from top to bottom following diagonal line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4" and press triangle flat and seams open. Diagram A



3. With right sides together, repeat the same steps for the upper right corner of rectangle. Diagram B



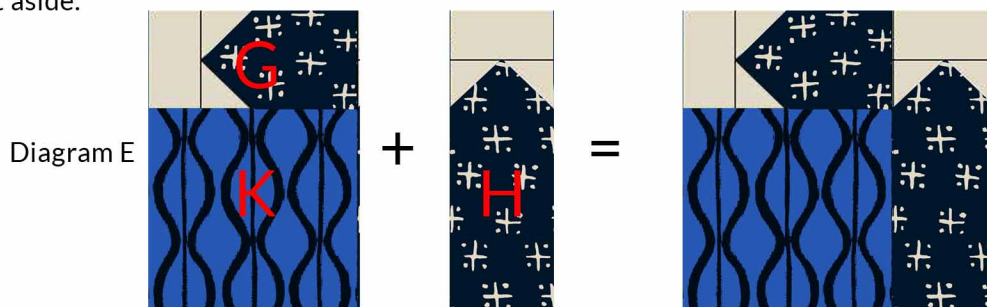
4. Take the 'N' ivory rectangles and on the pointed end of each rectangle, sew with right sides together. Diagram C
You will have a total of 7 pointed rectangles.



5. Sewing in sections, take the following pieces for Section 1 - (1) D, (1) A, (1) J
With right sides together, sew pointed rectangle D and square A together. Press seam open. Take rectangle J and with right sides together, sew to square A on the other side. Press seam open. Diagram D
Set aside.



6. Section 2 - (1) G, (1) K, (1) H
With right sides together, sew pointed rectangle G and rectangle K as shown. Press seam open. Take pointed rectangle H and with right sides together, sew to the side of the first section. Press seam open. Diagram E
Set aside.

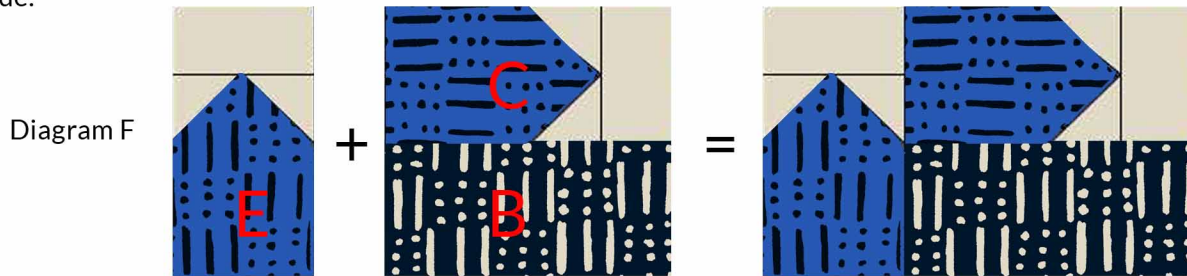

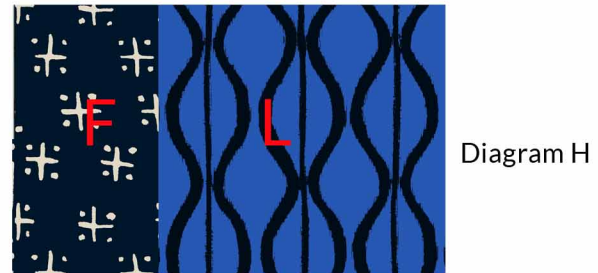
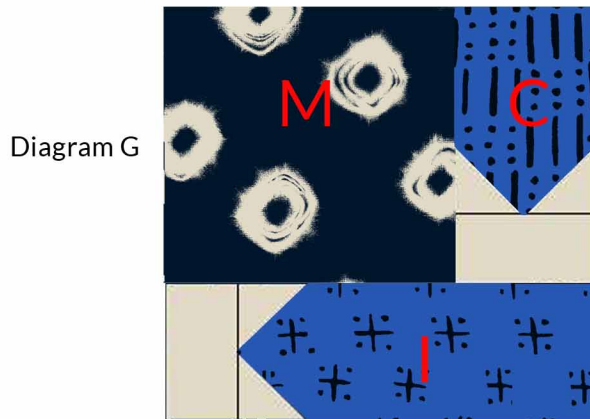
6. Section 3 - (1) C, (1) E, (1) B

With right sides together, sew pointed rectangle C and rectangle B as shown. Press seam open. Take pointed rectangle E and with right sides together, sew to the side of the first section. Press seam open. Diagram F Set aside.



7. Section 4 - (1) M, (1) C, (1) I

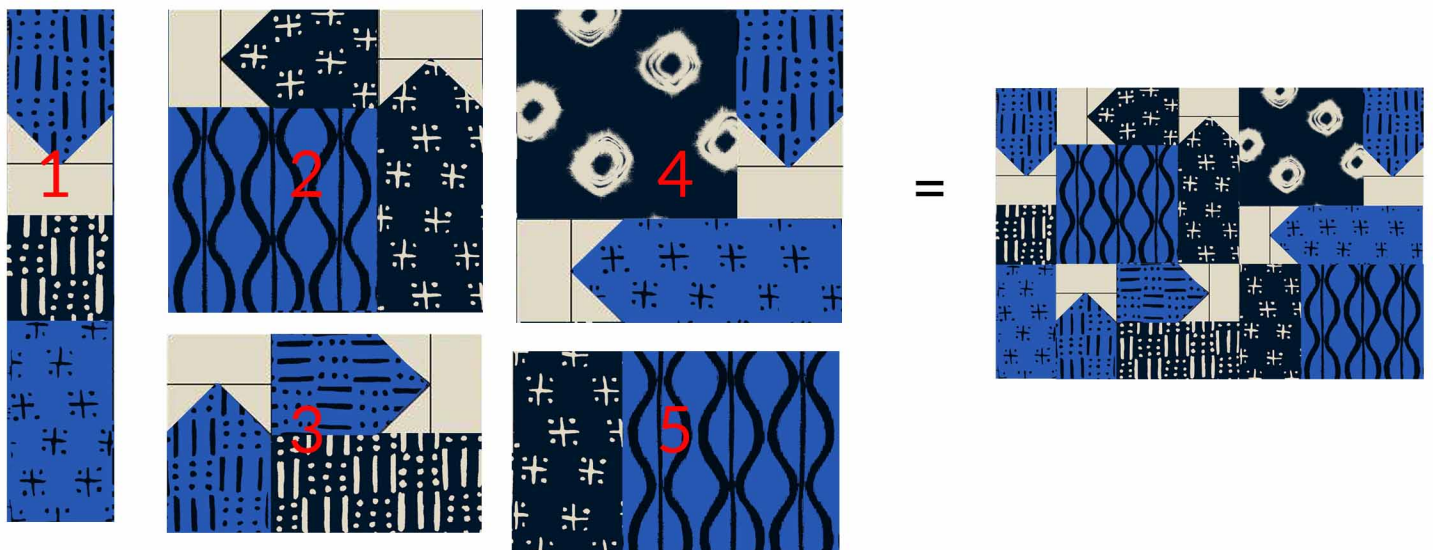
With right sides together, sew pointed rectangle C and rectangle M as shown. Press seam open. Take pointed rectangle I and with right sides together, sew to the bottom of the first section. Press seam open. Diagram G



8. Section 5 - (1) F, (1) L

With right sides together, sew rectangle F and L together. Press seam open. Set aside. Diagram H

9. Assemble the sections as shown below - make sure you watch the orientation of each section.

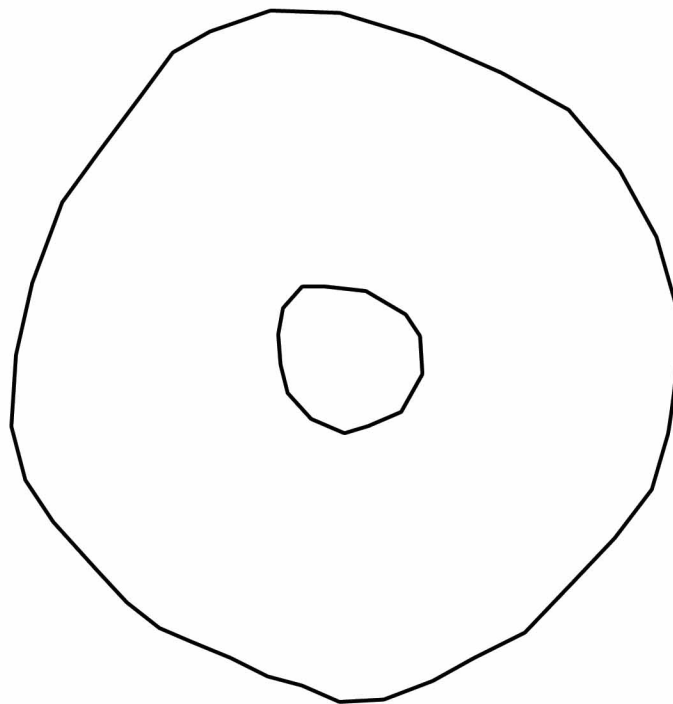
10. On the wrong side of the top apply the the lightweight woven fusible interlining to cover the seams and clean finish the back side of the top.

Back

11. Take invisible zipper and apply to the bottom seam of the pillow following the manufacturer's recommended instructions. *There is a great invisible zipper tutorial online at: www.jonagiammalva.com*
12. Once zipper is set, leave it partially open. With right sides together, sew around the other 3 sides of the pillow. Clip corner seam allowance and cover stitch seam allowance edges or add a tight zigzag stitch to prevent raveling. Turn and press.
13. Add a 19" x 13" pillow form to complete your pillow.
