

	2 yards	37153-2 Blue	Snowball blocks	Fussy cut thirteen 10 ½" squares.
			Points of snowball blocks.	Cut four 2 ½" strips, recut into 52 squares.
	1 3/4 yards	37156-5 Yellow	Strips for 25 Patch block.	Cut nine 2 1/2" strips.
			20 Border triangles	Cut two 11 1/4" strips recut into five squares and cut twice diagonally.
	3/4 yard	37154-3 Navy	16 Border triangles	Cut two 11 1/4" strips recut into four squares and cut twice diagonally.
			4 Corner triangles	Recut two leftover squares to be 10 7/8" square and cut once diagonally.
	1 yard	37160-2 Blue	Strips for 25 Patch block.	Cut twelve 2 ½" strips.
	3/8 yard	37156-4 Red	Strips for 25 Patch block	Cut four 2 1/2" strips.
	1/2 yard	37157-5 Yellow	Binding	Cut seven strips 2 1/4".

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
Making the Quilt

Making the snowballs:


- 1. Mark a diagonal line on the back of the 52 yellow squares. Position the marked square on the corners of the fussy cut blocks, Sew on the marked line.
- 2. Iron and trim the back half of the yellow squares. That's 13 snowballs!

Making the 25 patch blocks:


1. Sew the precut 2 1/2" strips together into the following sets. Press each strip set.



2. Recut Set A into twenty- four 2 ½" segments. Repeat for Set B. Recut Set C into twelve 2 ½" segments.



3. Sew the segments into the blocks as pictured. Make 12 blocks.






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Assemble the quilt top:

- 1. Alternate the blocks as pictured. Sew into rows.
- Sew the rows together.



Borders

1. Sew 5 yellow triangles alternating them with 4 navy triangles as pictured. Make 4 sets.



- 2. Sew to the four sides of quilt top. Pressing as you go.
- 3. Attach the corner triangles.

Finishing the Quilt

- 1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top.
- 2. Baste according to your favorite quilting method.
- 3. Quilt as desired. (Take to your local longarm quilter.)
- 4. Sew binding strips together and attach.
