General Instructions

Use 1/4" seam allowances throughout. Labeling the cut pieces and the pieced units will make assembly a breeze. Accurate cutting and seam allowances will insure success. It is suggested that all seams should be pressed open to reduce bulk. Please read the instructions carefully as there are many pieces and fabrics used. The old saying "check twice cut once" should be followed.

House Blocks

There are nine house blocks in the pattern using four different fabrics (Fabrics 10, 11, 13 and 14) The diagram at right applies to all house blocks.

Cutting Instructions for All House Blocks

Fabric 3 (Black Snowman)

Cut 2 strips 3" X Width of Fabric (WOF). Sub-cut 9 pieces 8" long and mark them piece G.

Fabric 9 (Blue Snowflake)

Cut 9 strips 1 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 9 pieces 12 1/2" long and mark them piece A. Sub-cut 18 pieces 4 1/2" long and mark them piece B. Sub-cut 9 pieces 2 1/2" long and mark them piece D. Sub-cut 18 pieces 6 1/2" long and mark them piece H. Cut 2 strips 3" X WOF.

Sub-cut 18 pieces 4" long and mark them piece E.

Fabric 10 (Green Snowflake)

Cut 1 strip 3" X WOF.

Sub-cut 4 pieces 5 1/2" long and mark them piece F. Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 2 pieces 5 1/2" long and mark them piece I. Cut 1 strip 2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 4 pieces 4 1/2" long and mark them piece K. Sub-cut 2 pieces 5 1/2" long and mark them piece J. Cut 1 strip 1 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 4 pieces 2 1/2" long and mark them piece M. Cut 1 strip 1" X WOF.

Sub-cut 2 pieces 2 1/2" long and mark them piece O.

Fabric 11 (Red Snowflake)

Cut the same pieces as for fabric 10.


Fabric 12 (Blue Pin dot)

Cut 3 strips 2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 9 pieces 12 1/2" long and mark them piece P.

Fabric 13 (Green Pin dot)

Cut the same pieces as for fabric 10.



Fabric 14 (Red Pin dot)

Cut 1 strip 3" X WOF.

Sub-cut 6 pieces 5 1/2" long and mark them piece F. Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 3 pieces 5 1/2" long and mark them piece I. Cut 1 strip 2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 6 pieces 4 1/2" long and mark them piece K. Sub-cut 3 pieces 5 1/2" long and mark them piece J. Cut 1 strip 1 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 6 pieces 2 1/2" long and mark them piece M. Cut 1 strip 1" X WOF.

Sub-cut 3 pieces 2 1/2" long and mark them piece O.

Fabric 15 (Black Spin Blender)

Cut 1 strip 1 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 18 pieces 1 1/2" long and mark them piece C. Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 9 pieces 4 1/2" long and mark them piece L. Cut 2 strips 1 3/4" X WOF.

Sub-cut 18 pieces 2 1/2" long and mark them piece N.



Assembly

The pattern will show the assembly of a house block using Fabric 14 (Red Pin Dot). You will follow the same instructions to complete all of the house blocks making a total of:

2 Fabric 10 house blocks mark them HB-10

2 Fabric 11 house blocks mark them HB-11

2 Fabric 13 house blocks mark them HB-13


3 Fabric 14 house blocks mark them HB-14

Sew together two piece B's, 2 piece C's and one piece D in the order shown below. Label it House Row 1.




Place a Piece F on top of a Piece E right sides together (RST) with the long side of F perpendicular to E aligned with the lower right corner and side of E. On the wrong side of F draw a diagonal line from the lower left corner to the point where the top right corner of E intersects. Sew on the line. Press, flip and trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



Place a Piece G on the right end of the unit just completed (RST) with the long side of G perpendicular to the unit and aligned with the upper right corner and side. On the wrong side of G draw a diagonal line from the upper left corner to the point where the bottom right corner of the unit intersects. Sew on the line. Press, flip and trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.



Place a Piece E on the right end of the unit just completed (RST) with the long side of E perpendicular to the unit and aligned with the upper right corner and side. On the wrong side of E draw a diagonal line from the upper left corner to the point where the bottom right corner of the unit intersects. Sew on the line. Press, flip and trim leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Label this House Row 2.




Sew a piece K to each side of a piece L. Sew a piece I to the top of the unit. Label this Unit 1.



Sew two piece M's, two piece N's and one piece O together as shown.



Sew a piece J to the top and a piece F to the bottom as shown. Mark this Unit 2.



Sew Unit 1 to left side of Unit 2 to form the house base as shown below.



Sew a piece H to each side of the house base and label it House Row 3.

Sew House Rows 1, 2, and 3 together to form the house. Next sew piece A to the top and piece P to the bottom to complete the house block.







Fussy cut a snowman circle of your choice from Fabric 8. Applique it to the house block using your favorite method – placing it as shown. The block should measure 12 1/2" X 12 1/2".



Uneven Nine-Patch Blocks

The diagram at right applies to all four blocks.

Cutting Instructions for All Uneven Nine-Patch Blocks

Fabric 1 (House Scene)

Cut 1 strip 8 1/2" WOF.

Sub-cut 4 squares 8 1/2" X 8 1/2" and mark them piece A.

Fabric 6 (Black with Cardinals)

Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 16 pieces 8 1/2" long and mark them piece B.

Fabric 11 (Red Snowflake)

Cut 1 strip 2 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 16 squares 2 1/2" X 2 1/2" and mark them piece C.

Assembly

Sew a piece B to each side of piece A as shown.



Sew a piece C to each side of piece B as shown - make 2 units.



Sew a C/B/C unit to the top and bottom of a B/A/B unit to form the block as shown. The block should measure 12 1/2" X 12 1/2".



Make 4 blocks.

Tree Blocks (Make 6 Large and 4 Small)


Rotary cutting template diagrams can be found in Appendix 1 (large tree) and Appendix 2 (small tree). Single piece applique patterns can be found in Appendix 3 (large tree) and Appendix 4 (small tree). Make a total of 6 large and 4 small trees.

Rotary Template Method (Diagram at right)

Trace the templates A(L) - H(L) in appendix 1 and A(S) - H(S) in appendix 2 onto template plastic and cut out.

Fabric 4 (Green Tree Fabric)

Cut 3 strips 3 1/2" X WOF. (for large trees) Cut 2 strips 2 3/4" X WOF. (for small trees)







Fold the 3 1/2" strips in half wrong sides together (WST). Align the large templates B(L), D(L), F(L), and H(L) on the strips matching the bases and fabric edge as shown below. Cut the templates using your rotary cutter and ruler. Folding the strips in half yields 2 pieces of each template per cut. For six large trees – cut each template 3 times.



Cut the small tree templates from the 2 3/4" strips. Use the same procedure as above with templates B(S), D(S),F(S), and H(S). Cut each template twice to yield 4 of each small piece.

Fabric 9 (Blue Snowflake)

Cut 2 strips 3 1/2" X WOF. (for large trees) Cut 2 strips 2 3/4" X WOF. (for small trees)

Fold the 3 1/2" strips in half WST. By folding the strips in half each template cut will yield the piece and it's reverse. (i.e. A(L) and A(L)Rev.). Use templates A(L),C(L),E(L) and G(L) and cut each template six times.



Fold the 2 3/4" strips in half WST. Use templates A(S),C(S),E(S) and G(S) and cut each template 4 times.

Assembly

All seams should be pressed to the green fabric. The numbers in parenthesis are the number for the small trees.

Sew piece A to the left side of piece B. Sew piece A(Rev) to the right side of the unit as shown. The unit should measure 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" (2 3/4" X 6 1/2"). Make 6 (4) units and mark them Tree Row 1.



Sew piece C to the left side of piece D. Sew piece C(Rev) to the right side of the unit shown. The unit should measure 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" (2 3/4" X 6 1/2"). Make 6 (4) units and mark them Tree Row 2.



Sew a piece E to the left side of piece F. Sew a piece E(Rev) to the right side of the unit as shown. The unit should measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ X 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 7 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 7 $\frac{1}$




Sew a piece G to the left side of piece H. Sew a piece G(Rev) to the right side of the unit as shown. The unit should measure 3 1/2" X 6 1/2" (2 3/4" X 6 1/2"). Make 6 (4) units and mark them Tree Row 4.





Sew the tree rows together (Rows 1-4) to complete the blocks. The large trees should measure 6 1/2" X 12 1/2" and the small trees 6 1/2" X 9 1/2". Make six large and four small tree blocks.





Applique Method (Diagram at right)

The large tree pattern is in two pieces in appendix 3. Cut out the pieces and align to make a full template. The template should measure 12'' tip to base. Remember to add $\frac{1}{2}''$ if you wish to use needle turn applique.

The small tree pattern is one piece and can be found in appendix 4. It should measure 9".

Fabric 4 (Green Tree Fabric)

Trace the tree pattern onto a fusible applique product if using raw edge applique. Fuse to the wrong side of the fabric and cut out on the solid line. If using the needle turn method, trace the pattern on the fabric and cut on the dotted line. Make 6(4) trees.

Fabric 9 (Blue Snowflake)

Cut three strips 7" X WOF.

Sub-cut 6 rectangles 7" X 13". (Large Tree backgrounds)

Sub-cut 4 rectangles 7" X 10". (Small Tree backgrounds)

Center the trees on the background rectangles and fuse or applique in place.

Trim the large tree rectangles to 6 1/2" X 12 1/2" leaving 1/4" at the bottom and top as shown in the diagram (1/4" from the tree base and base tips on the lower left and right and the tree tip). Make 6 Large Tree blocks.



Trim the small tree rectangles to $6\ 1/2''\ X\ 9\ 1/2''$ leaving 1/4'' at the bottom and top as shown in the diagram (1/4'' from the tree base and base tips on the lower left and right and the tree tip). Make 4 Small Tree blocks.





Raw edge applique does not require decorative stitching but it is recommended (small zig-zag, blind hem, blanket stitch, etc.).

Quilt Assembly

Fabric 5 (Let It Snow)

Cut one strip 12 1/2" X WOF.

Sub-cut 6 rectangles 6 1/2" X 12 1/2" (Need 4 for large spacers). Sub-cut 2 of the rectangles to yield 4 pieces 3 1/2" X 6 1/2". (small spacers).

The spacers will be used with the small and large trees to form 12 1/2" X 12 1/2" blocks.

The body of the quilt is assembled in four columns.

Column 1:

Green snowflake house (HB-10)

Uneven pine-patch

Large tree and large spacer

Green pin-dot house (HB-13)

Uneven nine-patch

Column 2:

Two large trees and two small spacers

Red pin-dot house (HB-14)

One small tree, one large spacer and one small spacer

Red snowflake house (HB-11)

Two small trees

Column 3:

Red snowflake house (HB-11)

One large tree and one large spacer

Green pin-dot house (HB-13)

One large tree, one small tree and one small spacer

Red pin-dot house (HB-14)









Column 4:

Uneven nine-patch

Green snowflake house (HB-10)

Red pin-dot house (HB-14)

Uneven nine-patch

One large tree and one large spacer



Sew columns 1-4 together from left to right to complete the quilt body which should measure 48 1/2" X 60 1/2".

The quilt borders are cut as follows:

Fabric 2(Blue Snowman)

Cut 7 strips 3 1/2" X WOF.

Join with diagonal seams to form one long strip.

Fabric 10 (Green Snowflake)

Cut 6 strips 1 1/2" X WOF.

Join with diagonal seams to form one long strip.

From the Fabric 10 strip -

Cut two strips 48 1/2" long and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt body.

Cut two strips 62 1/2" long and sew to each side of the quilt body.

From the Fabric 2 strip -

Cut two strips 50 1/2" long and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt body.

Cut two strips 68 1/2" long and sew to each side of the quilt body.






