

**Quilt Assembly**

9. Following figure 5, sew blocks together into three rows.(Figure 5)

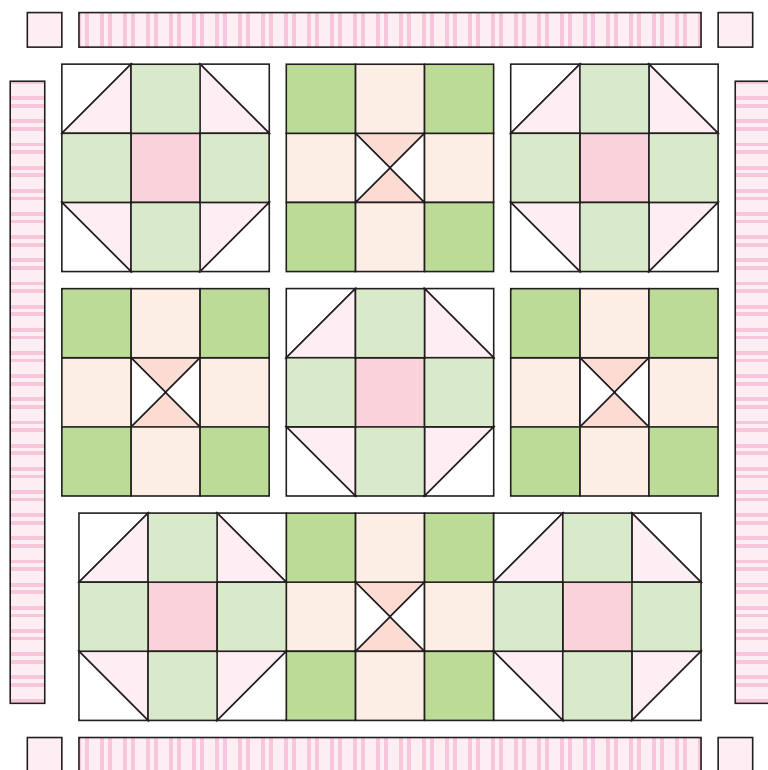

10. Sew two 2-1/2" Fabric H strips to left and right sides of quilt top.

11. Sew two 2-1/2" Fabric G squares to left and right sides of remaining Fabric H strips and attach to top and bottom of quilt top.

**Finishing the Quilt**

Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

<b>Fabric A</b> #26831 Pink	1/4 yd	(5) 4-1/2" squares
<b>Fabric B</b> #26837 Green	1/2 yd	(20) 4-1/2" squares
<b>Fabric C</b> #26833 Pink	1/3 yd	(16) 4-1/2" squares
<b>Fabric D</b> #26838 Green	1/3 yd	(16) 4-1/2" squares
<b>Fabric E</b> #26836 Pink	1/4 yd	(2) 5-1/4" squares
<b>Fabric F</b> #1000 White Chamois	1/2 yd	(10) 4-7/8" squares (2) 5-1/4" squares
<b>Fabric G</b> #4200 Lt. Pink Chamois	1/2 yd	(4) 2-1/2" squares (10) 4-7/8" squares
<b>Fabric H</b> #26498-1 Pink Stripe Chamois	1/2 yd	(4) 2-1/2"x 36-1/2" strips
<b>Fabric I</b> #7200 Lime Green Chamois	3-1/4 yds	(5) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut and piece 44" square (backing)

## Block A

1. Sew two 4-1/2" Fabric B squares to left and right sides of one Fabric A square.
2. Layer one 4-7/8" Fabric F square and one 4-7/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and sew 1/4" on each side of drawn line. Cut apart on drawn line to make two half-square triangle squares. Repeat, for a total of four half-square triangle blocks. (Figure 1)
3. Sew two half-square triangles to left and right sides of one Fabric B square. Repeat.

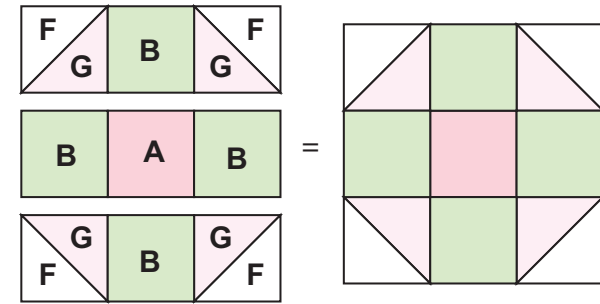


Figure 2 – Block A

4. Sew step 3 strips to top and bottom of step 1 strip to complete Block A. Make five blocks.(Figure 2)

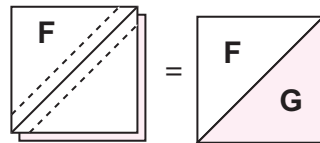

## Block B

5. Use one each 4-7/8" Fabric F and E square to make two half-square triangles. Turn one half-square triangle unit to its reverse side and draw a diagonal line from one corner to another, perpendicular to the seam. Position the two half-square units right sides together, with contrasting triangles facing each other. Sew 1/4" on each side of drawn line, Cut apart on drawn line and press units open. Repeat, for a total of four quarter-square triangles.(Figure 3)

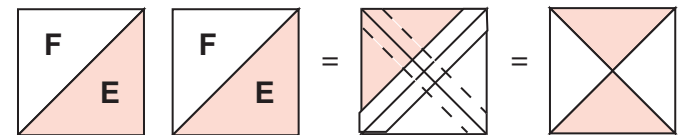

6. Sew two 4-1/2" Fabric C squares to left and right sides of step 5 quarter-square triangle.
7. Sew two 4-1/2" Fabric D squares to left and right sides of one 4-1/2" Fabric C square.

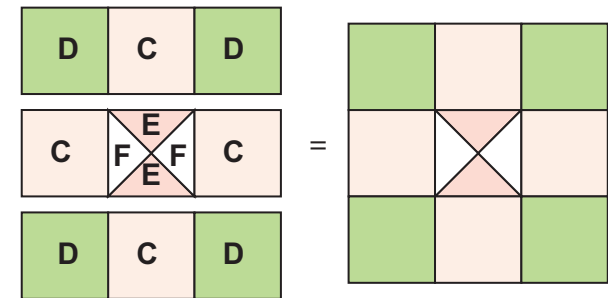


Figure 4 – Block B

8. Sew step 7 strips to top and bottom of step 6 strip to complete Block B. Make four blocks. (Figure 4)
