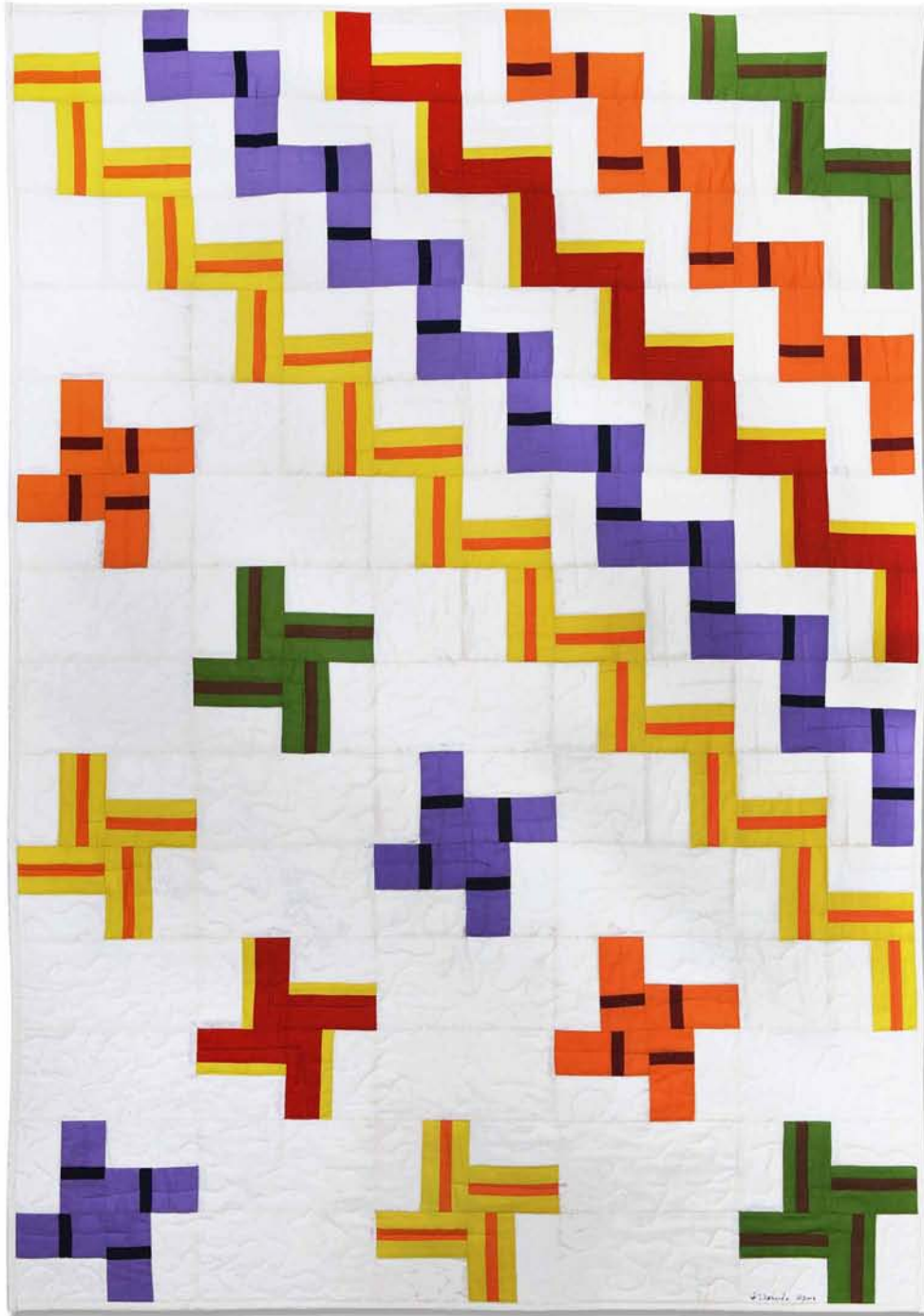

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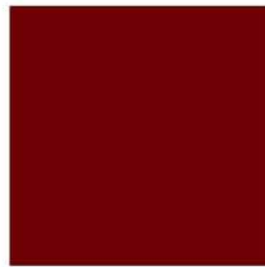

## CUTTING

"Colonies Solids" #36545

#1 Ivory	1 7/8 yd.	(17) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2", (6) 4 1/2" squares (17) 2 1/2" X W. O. F. – 5 used for binding
#2 - Purple	3/8 yd.	(2) 2" X W.O.F. (2) 2 1/2" X W.O.F.
#3 - Indigo	1/8 yd.	(2) 1" X W.O.F.
#4 - Madder Red	1/8 yd.	(1) 1" X W.O.F.
#5 - Turkey Red	1/8 yd.	(2) 2" X W.O.F.
#6 - Brown	1/8 yd.	(2) 1" X W.O.F.
#7 - Chrome Yellow	3/8 yd.	(2) 1" X W.O.F., (6) 1 1/4" X W.O.F.
#8 - Poison Green	1/6 yd.	(2) 1" X W.O.F., (2) 1 1/2" X W.O. F.
#9 - Cheddar	3/8 yd.	(2) 1 1/2" X W.O.F., (2) 3" X W.O.F. (3) 1" X W.O.F.

Also needed: 45" X 60" backing, 45" X 60" batting, thread to notch, scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, acrylic ruler mat.

**Note:** The pieced 4 1/2" blocks are cut from width – of – fabric strips pieced into the different color combinations, then cut into individual 4 1/2" blocks.

# "Zig-Zags and Pinwheels"

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## Directions:

1. Piece together W.O.F. colored strips to make one 2 1/2" X W.O.F. strips in the following combinations.

Combo #1 – two 1 1/4" chrome yellow on each side of one 1" cheddar  
Make (3).

Combo #3 – one 1" chrome yellow and one 2" turkey red - make (2).

Combo #5 – one 1" poison green, one 1" brown and one 1 1/2" poison green.  
Make (2).



Sew (1) 2 1/2" x W.O.F. strip of ivory to each of the strip combos. Cut each combo into a 4 1/2" square. You will have (28) Combo #1, (17) Combo #3 and (13)

Combo #5.

Set aside.

2. For Combo #2 and #4 piece together W.O.F. colored strips to make one 4 1/2" X W.O.F strips in the following combinations.

Combo #2 – one 2" purple, one 1" indigo, one 2 1/2" purple. Make (2).

Combo #4 - one 1 1/2" cheddar, one 1" madder red, one 3" cheddar. Make (2).



Cut each strip into 2 1/2" width to make 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" piece. Make (25) in Combo #2. Make (17) in Combo #4.

Cut (42) 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" from the 2 1/2" X W.O.F. ivory strips.

Sew one ivory 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" to each of the Combo #2 and #4 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" pieces to make (42) 4 1/2" squares -(25) Combo #2 and (17) Combo #4.

Set aside



3. To assemble the quilt in rows 1 – 14, refer to the photo for placement of the blocks and colors. Each row has (10) blocks. Sew rows together in order of completion.

Row # 1 – (1) #1, (2) #2, (2) #3, (2) #4, (2) #5, (1) 4 1/2" ivory square

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Row # 2 - (2) #1, (2) #2, (2) #3, (2) #4, (2) #5



Row #3 - (1) 4 1/2" ivory square, (2) #1, (2) #2, (2) #3, (2) #4, (1) #5



Row #4 - (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #1, (2) #2, (2) #3, (2) #4



Row #5 - (2) #4, (1) 4 1/2" ivory, (2) #1, (2) #2, (2) #3, (1) #4



Row #6 - (2) #4, (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #1, (2) #2, (2) #3



Row #7 - (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #5, (1) 4 1/2" ivory, (2) #1, (2) #2, (1) #3



Row #8 - (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #5, (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #1, (1) #2



Row #9 - (2) #1, (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #2, (1) 4 1/2" ivory, (2) #1, (1) #2



Row #10 - (2) #1, (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #2, (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #1



Row #11 - (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #3, (1) 4 1/2" X 8 1/2" ivory, (2) #4, (1) 4 1/2" ivory, (1) #1



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Row #12 – (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory, (2) #3, (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory, (2) # 4, (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory



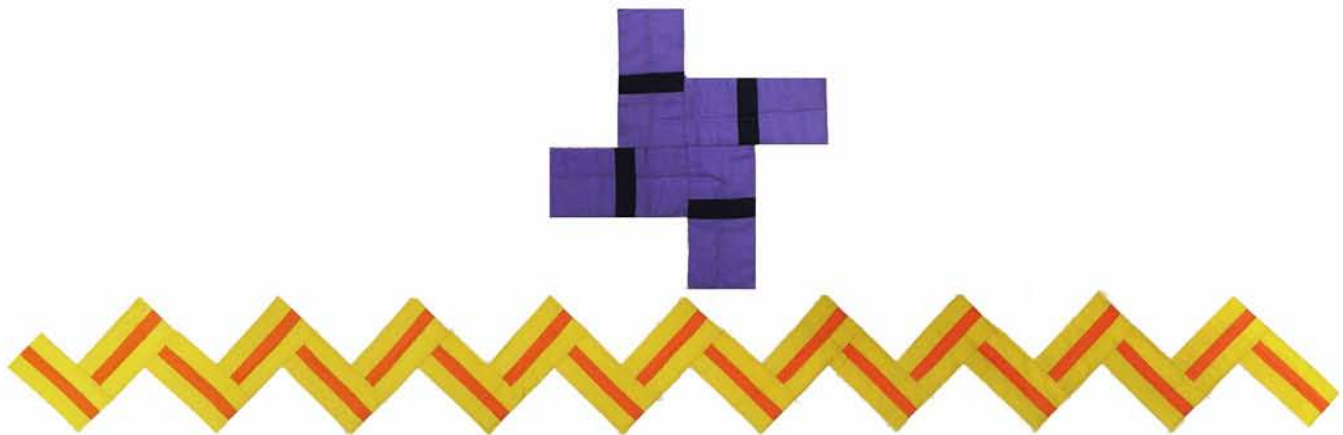
Row #13 – (2) #2, (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory, (2) #1, (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory, (2) # 5



Row #14 – (2) #2, (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory, (2) #1, (1) 4 ½" X 8 ½" ivory, (2) #5



4. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste.
5. Quilt as desired
6. Bind quilt using 2 ½" X W.O.F. ivory strips pieced as needed for length.



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
