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## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Create diamond units in (4) colorways using Template B pieces. Reference the assembly diagrams when sewing diamond units. When sewing diamond units, press away from Fabric $\mathbf{H}$. Use the following guide to create diamond units for Block Colorways 1-5 and in the correct quantities:
a. Fabric H + Fabric M: Create a total of (16) for Block Colorways 1 and 3.
b. Fabric H + Fabric J: Create (8) for Block Colorway 2.
c. Fabric H + Fabric L: Create (8) for Block Colorway 4.
d. Fabric H + Fabric K: Create (4) for Block Colorway 5.

2. Arrange (4) H/M diamond units, (4) Fabric C Template A pieces, (8) $63 / 4 \prime$ " Fabric A HST and (8) $51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A HST to form Block Colorway 1 (See diagrams on Pages 3 \& 4).
3. First, attach Fabric A HST to the sides of the diamond units and Template A pieces. Keep Block Colorway 1 laid out on your workstation while attaching Fabric A HST to avoid confusion. Press toward Fabric A.

## 4. Second, sew Block Colorway 1 into quadrants, pressing toward Template A pieces.

5. Last, sew Block Colorway 1 quadrants together to complete block assembly. Trim the block to measure $201 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. When trimming, ensure that there is a $1 / / 1$ seam allowance between the Template $A$ and diamond unit points and the edge of the block as indicated with a red circle.


6. Gather (4) $33 / 4$ " Fabric $G$ squares with a drawn diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.
7. Place (1) $33 / 4$ " Fabric $\mathbf{G}$ square onto each corner of the Block Colorway 1 created in the above steps, RST.
8. Sew along the drawn diagonal line on each Fabric $\mathbf{G}$ square. Trim excess corner fabric to a $1 / 4$ " and press toward the corner to complete SNF techniques. This completes Block Colorway 1 assembly.

9. Using the assembly instructions provided in Steps 2-8, create (2) of each Block Colorway 1-4 and (1) Block Colorway 5. Diagrams show fabric combinations for Block Colorways 1-5. All blocks should measure $201 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

10. Create horizontal block rows. Arrange Block Colorways $1-5$ in a $3 \times 3$ grid as shown. Place (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I sashing strip vertically in between each block and at either end of each block row.
11. Create horizontal sashing rows. Arrange (3) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I sashing strips and (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G cornerstone squares to form a horizontal sashing row. Repeat to create (4), placing horizontal sashing rows between each block row and at the top and bottom of the quilt top.
12. Sew horizontal block rows together, pressing seams toward the sashing strips.
13. Sew horizontal sashing rows together, pressing seams toward the sashing strips.
14. Sew horizontal block and sashing rows together to complete the quilt top. The quilt top should measure $681 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $68^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

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## FINISHING THE QUILT:

15. Sandwich quilt top with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method. Quilt as desired.
16. Create binding using (8) Fabric G $21 / 4 \prime \times$ WOF strips.
17. Attach binding using your preferred method.
