- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.




Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block diagrams and images for proper placement)

Block 1 (make 4, square to 15-1/2")


Make Units:

- 1. Sew (1) C1 QST to (1) G1 QST. Press, then sew to (1) D1 HST to make CGD Unit. Square to 5-1/2", make (16).
- 2. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F1 square. Place right sides together with (1) B1 square, then sew 1/4" away on each side of line. Cut on drawn line, then press the BF HST Units open. Square to 3", make (4).
- 3. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on left end of B2 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4", and press open. Repeat on other end B2 rectangle to make FBF Long Unit. Square to 3" X 15-1/2", make (4).
- 4. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on left end of B3 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4, and press open. Repeat on other end B3 rectangle to make FBF Short Unit. Unit should measure 3" x 13". Make (4).



Make Block:

- 5. Sew (4) CDG Units together to create Block 1 Center. Block should measure 10 1/2"
- 6. Sew (1) B4 strip to each side of Block 1 Center.
- 7. Sew (1) FBF Long Unit to top.
- 8. Sew (1) BF HST Unit to right side of FBF Short Unit and press, then sew to bottom to complete BLOCK 1. Square to 15-1/2". Make (4).




Blocks 2 A, B, C and D (make 1 each, square to 15-1/2")

Make Units:

- 9. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) E1 square. Place right sides together one end of (1) G2 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4" and press open. Repeat on other end of G2 rectangle to make GE Unit. Square to 3" X 5-1/2", make (16).
- 10. Sew (1) G3 square to each end of GE Unit to make EGE Unit. Square to 3" X 10-1/2", make (8).
- 11. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F1 square. Place right sides together with (1) H1 square, then sew 1/4" away on each side of line. Cut on drawn line, then press the HF HST Units open. Square to 3", make (4).
- 12. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on left end of H2 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4, and press open. Repeat on other end H2 rectangle to make FHF Long Unit. Square to 3" X 15-1/2", make (4).
- 13. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on left end of H3 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4, and press open. Repeat on other end H3 rectangle to make FHF Medium Unit. Square to 3" X 13", make (4).
- 14. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on right end of H4 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4, and press open to make FH Short Unit. Unit should measure 3" x 10 1/2". Make (4).





Make Blocks:


- 15. Sew (1) GE Unit to each side of (1) A2 square, then sew (1) EGE Unit to top and bottom to create Block 2 Center. Block should measure 10-1/2". Make (4).
- 16. Follow chart below to sew remaining Units to Block 2 Centers to complete blocks.

Block 3: (make 1, square to 15-1/2")

Make Units:


- 17. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F1 square. Place right sides together with (1) D2 square, then sew 1/4" away on each side of line. Cut on drawn line, then press the FD HST Units open. Square to 3", make (2).
- 18. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on left end of D3 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4, and press open. Repeat on other end D3 rectangle to make FDF Medium Unit. Square to 3" X 13", make (2).
- 19. Draw diagonal line on back of (1) F2 square. Place right sides together on left end of D4 rectangle. Sew on line, trim excess to 1/4, and press open to make FD Short Unit. Block should measure 3" x 10-1/2". Make (2).





Make Block:

- 20. Sew (1) G5 to each side of A1, then sew G4 to top and bottom to create Block 3 Center. Square to 10-1/2".
- 21. Sew (1) FD Short Unit to each side of Block 3 Center.
- 22. Sew (1) FD HST Unit to left side of (1) FDF Medium Unit and press, then sew to top. Sew (1) FD HST Unit to right side of (1) FDF Medium Unit and press, then sew to bottom to complete BLOCK 3. Square to 15-1/2".



Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation)

Quilt Assembly:

23. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

Border Assembly:

Border 1:

24. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 45-1/2"), cut (2) F 3" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 50-1/2") cut (2) F 3" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 2:

25. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 50-1/2"), cut (2) G 1-3/4" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 53") cut (2) G 1-3/4" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 3:

26. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 53"), cut (2) A 5-1/2" WOF strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 63"), sew (2) A 5-1/2" LOF strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
