

1. MAKING THE BLOCKS:

Sew a **G** square to an **H** square. Make a second **G/H** unit.



Sew the **G/H** units to opposite sides of an **N** rectangle.



Sew together a **C**, **T** and **D** squares to make a pieced row. Make a second **C/T/D** row. Sew **C/T/D** rows to the top and bottom of the unit from step 2. Repeat to make a total of nine tan blocks.

2. QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:


Sew the **B, R,** and **V** strips short ends together to make one long strip. From this strip, cut (25) 1.5" x 8.5" sashing rectangles. Note: Some will be pieced; some will be just one fabric.



Lay out 3 gray #1 blocks, 3 tan #1 blocks and (5) 1.5" x 8.5" Fabric **B/R/V** sashing rectangles to make block row #1. Sew the blocks and sashing rectangles together. Make a total of 3 of block row #1.



In the same way, lay out 3 gray #2 blocks, 3 tan #2 blocks and (5) $1.5" \times 8.5"$ Fabric **B/R/V** sashing rectangles to make block row #1. Sew the blocks and sashing rectangles together. Make a total of 2 of block row #2.



To make pieced sashing row #1, lay out (6) **M** 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles alternating with (3) **Q** 1.5" x 2.5" rectangles and (2) **S** 1.5" x 2.5" rectangles as shown. Sew the rectangles together. Make a second pieced sashing row #1.



In the same way, make pieced sashing row #2 using (6) **F** 2.5" x 6.5" rectangles alternating with (3) **S** 1.5" x 2.5" rectangles and (2) **Q** 1.5" x 2.5" rectangles as shown. Make a second pieced sashing row #2.



Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram, lay out block rows #1 and #2 alternating with sashing rows #1 and #2. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.

Sew the (6) F 3.5" x 42" strips short ends together into a long strip. Cut (2) 48.5" lengths and (2) 47.5" lengths. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt center. Sew the remaining lengths to the top and bottom.



3. QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

Outer border. Sew F (2) $3.5" \times 48.5"$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) F $3.5" \times 47.5"$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

4. QUILTING INSTRUCTIONS:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
