General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning project.

Piecing Instructions: (Refer to unit and block diagrams for proper fabric placement)


Unit Assembly:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) E4 square. Place E square in one corner of (1) F5 rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press E open towards F corner. Trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side to create UNIT 1. Square to 2-3/4" X 5", make (24).
- 2. Sew (1) F6 square to each side of (1) UNIT 1 to create UNIT 2. Square to 2-3/4" X 9-1/2", make (12).














- 3. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) F4 square. Place square in one corner of (1) G3 rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press F open towards G corner, trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4" to create GF UNIT. Square to 3-1/2" X 6-1/2", make (8).
- 4. As in step 3, sew (1) F4 square to (1) H4 rectangle to create HF UNIT. Square to 3-1/2" X 9-1/2", make (8).
- 5. Sew (1) **GF UNIT** to the bottom of (1) **F1** square, then sew (1) **HF UNIT** to left side to create **UNIT 3**. Square to 9-1/2", make (8).







- 6. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (1) F3 square. Place F square in one corner of (1) H3 rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press F open towards H corner, trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side using (1) E3 square to create HFE UNIT. Square to 5" X 9-1/2", make (8).
- 7. Repeat step 6 using F3 square, G2 rectangle, and E3 square to create GFE UNIT. Square to 5" X 9-1/2", make (8).
- 8. Sew (1) GFE UNIT to (1) HFE Unit to create UNIT 4. Square to 9-1/2", make (8).













BLOCKS 1 and 2: Make (3) of each, square to 9-1/2"

9. Sew (1) UNIT 1 to each side of (1) C1 square, then sew (1) UNIT 2 to the top and bottom to create BLOCK 1. 10. Sew (1) UNIT 1 to each side of (1) B1 square, then sew (1) UNIT 2 to the top and bottom to create BLOCK 2.

BLOCK 3: Make (2), square to 27-1/2"

11. Sew the following together into rows, then sew rows together.

Row 1: UNIT 3 - UNIT 4 - UNIT 3 Row 2: UNIT 4 - A1 - UNIT 4 Row 3: UNIT 3 - UNIT 4 - UNIT 3

Quilt Assembly:

- 12. Sew (1) BLOCK 1 to top and bottom of (1) BLOCK 2, then sew (1) F7 strip to each side. Sew (1) BLOCK 3 to left side to make top section.
- 13. Sew (1) BLOCK 2 to top and bottom of (1) BLOCK 1, then sew (1) F7 strip to each side. Sew (1) BLOCK 3 to right side to make bottom section.
- 14. Sew top and bottom sections together.



Border Assembly:

Border Blocks: (Refer to block images for proper fabric placement, square all blocks to 5". Make number of blocks indicated.)

- 15. Border Block 1 (BB1 10): Sew (1) G1 QST to (1) F2 QST, then sew to (1) H2 HST.
- 16. Border Block 2 (BB2 10): Sew (1) G1 QST to (1) E1 QST, then sew to (1) H2 HST.
- 17. Border Block 3 (BB3 10): Sew (1) G1 QST to (1) F2 QST, then sew to (1) H2 HST.
- 18. Border Block 4 (BB4 10): Sew (1) G1 QST to (1) E1 QST, then sew to (1) H2 HST.



19. Border Block 5 (BB5 - 4): Draw a diagonal line on the back of (1) E2 square. Place (1) E2 square right sides together with (1) H1 square. Sew a seam ¼" on either side of drawn line, then cut on drawn line. Press blocks (HST) open with seam allowance towards the H fabric.



















Border #1:

20. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 54-1/2"), cut (2) F 3" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 45-1/2"), cut (2) F 3" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border #2: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block rotation)

21. Sew the following blocks together, then sew to quilt:

Left Side: BB3, BB4, BB3, BB4, BB3, BB4, D2, BB2, BB1, BB2, BB1, BB2, BB1 Right Side: BB1, BB2, BB1, BB2, BB1, BB2, D2, BB4, BB3, BB4, BB3, BB4, BB3

Top: BB5, BB1, BB2, BB1, BB2, D1, BB4, BB3, BB4, BB3, BB5 Bottom: BB5, BB3, BB4, BB3, BB4, D1, BB2, BB1, BB2, BB1, BB5

Border #3:

22. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 68-1/2"), cut (2) E 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 58-1/2"), cut (2) E 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
