Α		43262-4 Cream	1 FQ	(1) 10-1/2" square for coffee pot background and (4) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips for sashings.
В		43263-3 Wine	1/2	(2) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips (sashing). 14 squares 2-1/2" for borders, and (4) strips 2-1/4" x WOF (for binding). Also cut a patch large enough for the coffee pot lid.
С		43258-X Multi	1/2	(4) cup panels into 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" squares. Transfer coffee pot markings to template material and cut the main coffee pot body from this fabric.
D		43261-4 Cream	1/8	(10) squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (setting squares and border blocks).
Е		43261-2 Gold	1/8	(4) 2-1/2" squares and (2) sashing strips 2-1/2" x 10-1/2".
F	2	43262-5 Olive	1 FQ	(2) 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips for side borders and patches for coffee pot applique.
G		43259-2 Gold	1/3	(2) 4-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips for top and bottom borders.

				10" square paper backed fusible webbing for coffee pot applique

For coffee pot applique patches, transfer template markings to template material and cut out. Transfer fusible webbing to wrong side of fabric selected for applique BEFORE cutting out patches. Follow manufacturers directions.



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Sewing for Table Runner

- 1. Assemble the coffee pot patches and arrange on the 10-1/2" cream square. Remove the paper from the fusible webbing and use an iron to fuse patches in place. Applique using matching thread.
- 2. Sew a **B** 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the coffee pot block. Press seams toward the coffee cup block.
- 3. Sew the two sets of five print 2-1/2" squares into the two vertical rows, which are on either side of the coffee pot block.
- 4. Sew two of the 5-1/2" coffee cup panel squares together as shown in quilt photo. Repeat for remaining two panels. Join these panels to the vertical rows of squares.
- 5. Add the **A** strips to the top and bottom; add the remaining **G** strips and the **B** squares to complete the two units.
- 6. Sew the center Coffee Pot unit with the two coffee cup panels, referring to the Runner Assembly Diagram.
- 7. Add the side \mathbf{F} 4-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips. Press seams toward the outside.
- 8. Finally, make four 4-Patch border blocks with the remaining $\bf B$ and $\bf A$ squares. Sew one to each short end of the $\bf G$ 4-1/2" x 29-1/2" strips and add for top and bottom borders.

Finishing

- 1. Layer quilt, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Sew the four 2-1/4" x WOF strips of **B** into a long strip and use to bind table runner.



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
