

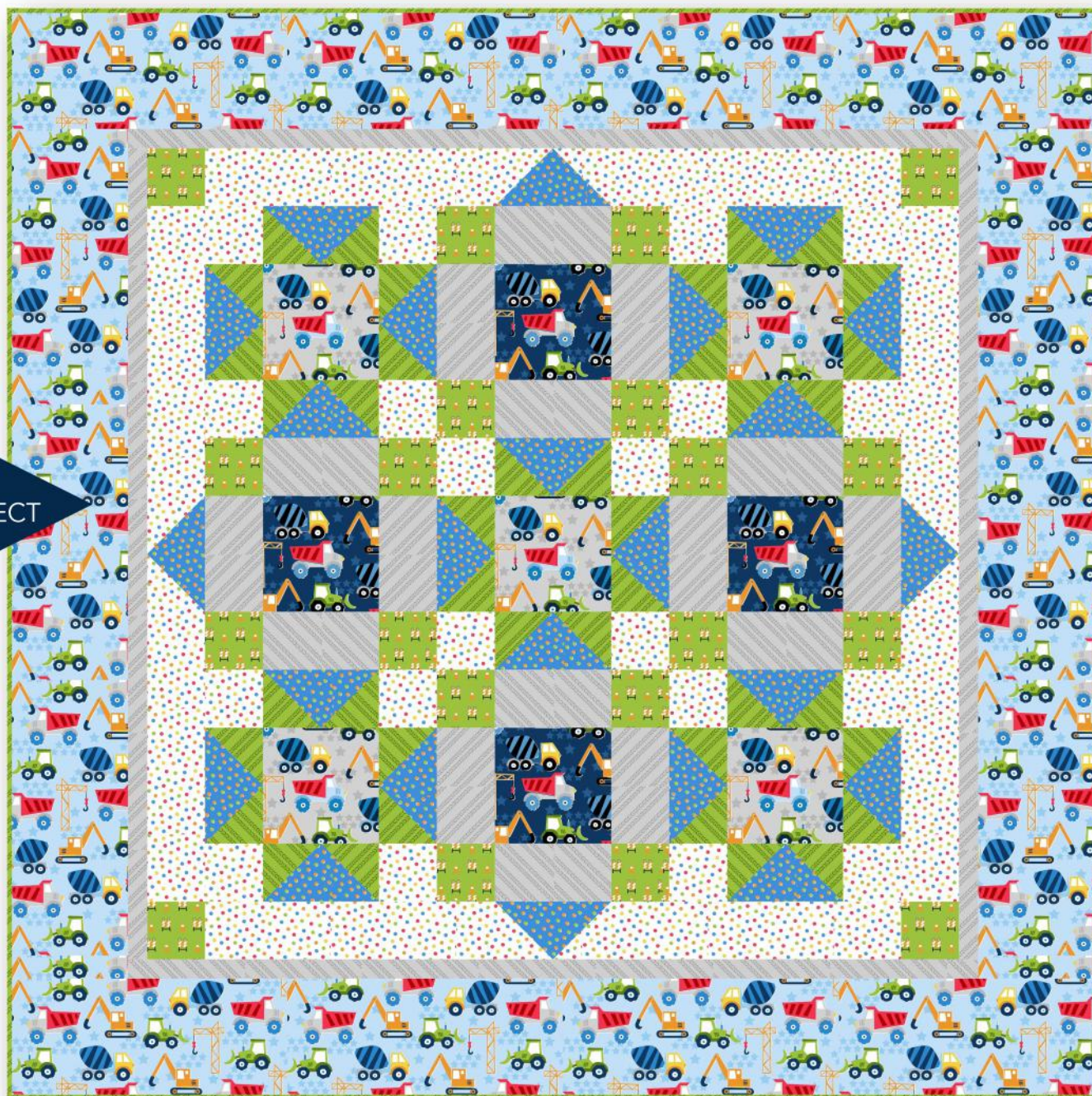



A @		42925-1 Navy	1/4 YD	(1) 6-1/2" X 42" strip, Subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares A1
B @		42925-2 Blue	1 5/8 YD	From length of fabric cut: (2) 6-1/2" X 56-1/2" strips From remainder cut: (4) 6-1/2" X 29" strips *
C @		42925-3 Grey	1/4 YD	(1) 6-1/2" X 42" strip, Subcut (5) 6-1/2" squares C1
D @		42928-7 Green	1/4 YD	(2) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; Subcut (20) 3-1/2" squares D1
E		42929-2 Blue	1/2 YD	(4) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; Subcut (24) 3-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangles E1
F		42929-5 White	3/4 YD	(7) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; Subcut (8) 3-1/2" X 15-1/2" rectangles F1 and (28) 3-1/2" squares F2
G @		42930-3 Grey	5/8 YD	(3) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; Subcut (16) 3-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangles G1 (5) 1-1/2" X 42" strips * BORDER
H @		42930-7 Green	7/8 YD	(4) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; Subcut (40) 3-1/2" squares H1 (6) 2-1/4" X 42" strips * BINDING

Backing Fabric: 3 5/8 YD

Batting: 64" X 64"

* = Sew together vis short ends, then go to Assembly Instructions



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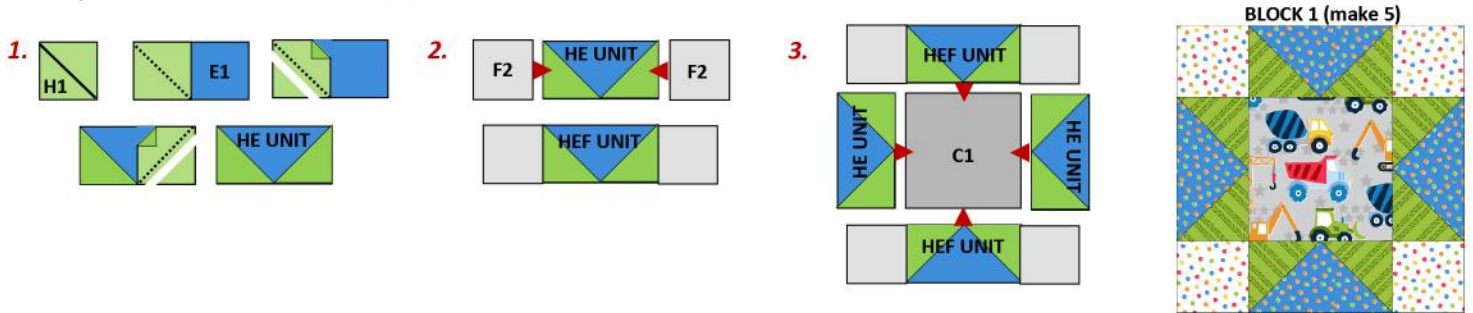
General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.

Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block images below for proper placement)

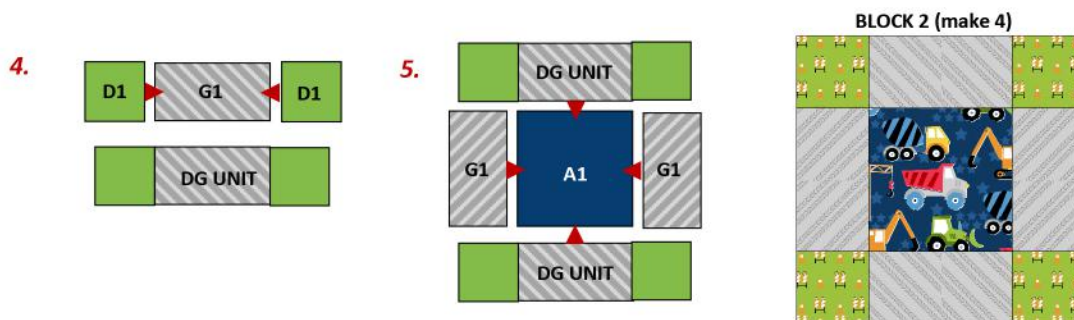
Block 1:

1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) H1 square. Place H1 square on one side of (1) E1 rectangle and sew along the diagonal line. Trim excess fabric on the reverse side to 1/4". Press H corner open towards the E corner. Repeat on other side to create HE UNIT. Square to 3-1/2" X 6-1/2", make (20).
2. Sew (1) F2 square to each side of (1) HE UNIT to create HEF UNIT. Square to 3-1/2" X 12-1/2", make (10).
3. Sew (1) HE UNIT to each side of (1) C1 square, then sew (1) HEF UNIT to top and bottom to create BLOCK 1. Square to 12-1/2", make (5).



Block 2:

4. Sew (1) D1 square to each side of (1) G1 rectangle to create DG UNIT. Square to 3-1/2" X 12-1/2", make (8).
5. Sew (1) G1 rectangle to each side of (1) A1 square, then sew (1) DG UNIT to top and bottom to create BLOCK 2. Square to 12-1/2", make (4).



Block 3:

6. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F2 square. Place F2 square on one side of (1) E1 rectangle and sew along the diagonal line. Press F corner open towards the E corner. Trim excess fabric on the reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side to create BLOCK 3. Square to 3-1/2" X 6-1/2", make (4).





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Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

7. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together as shown in Quilt Assembly Diagram.
ROWS 1 & 3: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1
ROW 2: BLOCK 2 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 2

Border Assembly:

Border 1:

8. Sew (1) F1 rectangle to each side of (1) BLOCK 3. Make (2), then sew to sides of quilt.
9. Sew (1) F1 rectangle to each side of (1) BLOCK 3, then sew (1) D1 square to each end. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 2:

10. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 42-1/2"), cut (2) G 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.
11. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 44-1/2"), cut (2) G 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 3:

12. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 44-1/2"), cut (2) B 6-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.
Sew the 6-1/2" X 56-1/2" B length of fabric strips to top and bottom of quilt.
13. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 56 1/2"), cut (2) B 6 1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
