BLOCK A ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **B** 6-1/2" x 7" piece and (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece to the left and right sides of (1) **G** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip as shown. Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strip to the bottom.







2. Sew (1) \mathbf{F} 3" x 7" piece and (1) \mathbf{B} 2-1/2" x 3" piece to the left and right sides of (1) \mathbf{G} 1" x 3" strip as shown. Add to the bottom of the unit from step 1 to make the block center.



3. Sew (2) **G** 1" \times 9-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the block center. Sew (2) **G** 1" \times 10-1/2" white strips to the top and bottom.



- **4.** Sew (2) **E** 1-1/2" \times 10-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the block center. Sew (2) **E** 1-1/2" \times 12-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete Block A.
- **5.** Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of (4) of Block A, noting how the fabric and block orientation rotates in each block.

BLOCK B ASSEMBLY

6. Sew (2) C 1" x 9-1/2" strips to opposite sides of (1) A 9-1/2" square. Sew (2) C 1" x 10-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.





7. Sew (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the unit from step 6. Sew (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete Block B.



8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 to make a total of (4) blocks.

CROWN BLOCK ASSEMBLY

9. Sew (3) \mathbf{F} 1-1/2" squares and (2) \mathbf{G} 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" pieces together as shown to make a row.







10. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) **F** 2-1/2" squares. Place a marked square right sides together on one side of (1) **G** 2-1/2" \times 4-1/2" piece. Sew on the drawn line, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " past the seam, and press open. Repeat on the opposite end to make a flying geese unit. Make a second flying geese unit.



11. Join the two flying geese together as shown and add the following pieces to make the crown center as shown: (1) **F** 2" \times 8-1/2" piece, (1) **G** 1" \times 8-1/2" piece, (1) **F** 1-1/2" \times 8-1/2" piece, and (1) **G** 3-1/2" \times 8-1/2" piece.



12. Sew (2) **G** 1" x 8-1/2" strips to opposite sides, and add the pieced row from step 9 to the top to complete the block center.





13. Sew (2) **G** 1" \times 9-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the block center. Sew (2) **G** 1" \times 10-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.



14. Sew (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the block center. Sew (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete the crown block. Personalize as desired in the white space below the crown.



Personalize as desired on the white rectangle below the crown.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **15.** Referring to the Quilt Layout, lay out the (9) blocks in (3) rows of (3) blocks each, noting orientation. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows.
- **16.** Sew (2) \mathbb{C} 2-1/4" x 36-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew (2) \mathbb{C} 2-1/4" x 40" strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/4" strips.
