

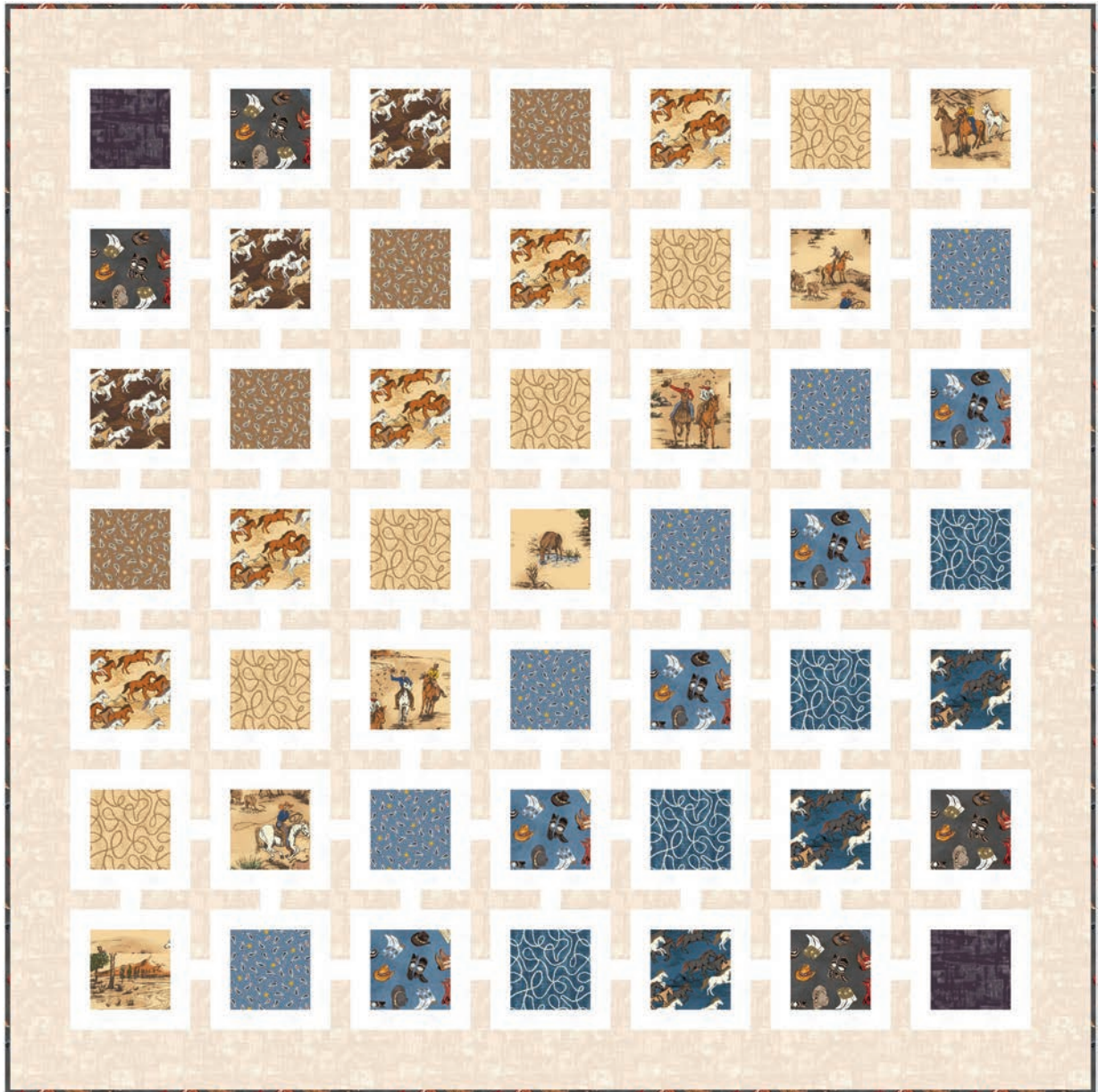

A		31835S Linen White	1-2/3	(4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (98) 1-1/2"x 4-1/2" rectangles (4) 6-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (98) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. Sashing Blocks (3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (84) 1-1/2" squares.
B		53053A-6 Denim	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (6) 4-1/2" squares.
C		53053A-7 Light Brown	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares.
D		53108-1 Tan	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (7) 4-1/2" squares.
E		53109-1 Tan	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (5) 4-1/2" squares.
F		53109-2 Dark Brown	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 4-1/2" squares.
G		53109-3 Indigo	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 4-1/2" squares.
H		53110-5 Charcoal BINDING INCLUDED	3/4	Binding: (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips. (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares.
I		53110-6 Denim	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (5) 4-1/2" squares.
J		53111-1 Tan	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (6) 4-1/2" squares.
K		53111-3 Indigo	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares.

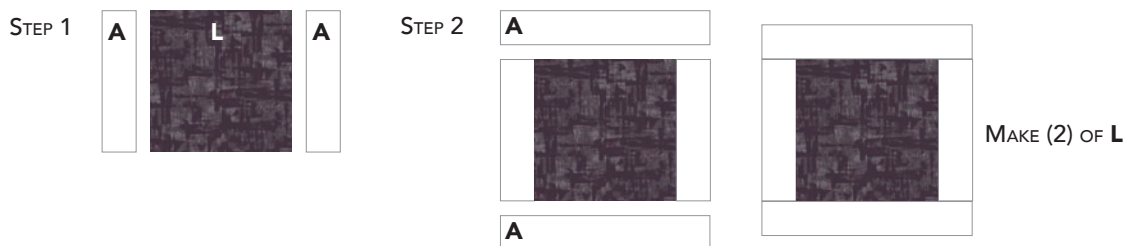

KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
L		52782-49 Graphite	1/4	(1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 4-1/2" squares.
M		52782-2 Sand	1-1/2	Sashing (4) 3" x WOF strips; subcut (96) 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles. (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (36) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. Outer Border (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips.
		Backing	3-1/2	60" x 60" piece of batting.

SQUARE BLOCKS

- Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) **L** 4-1/2" square.
- Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the remaining top and bottom sides of same **L** square to complete (1) Block. Make (2).

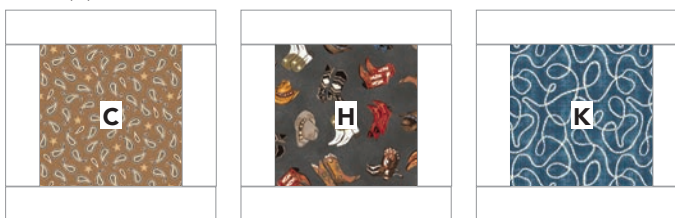


- Using fabric **A**, repeat Steps 1-2 to make a total number of Blocks:

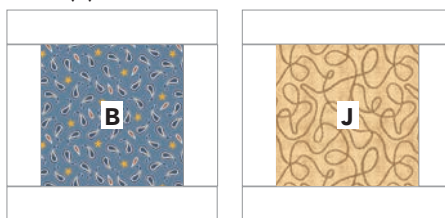

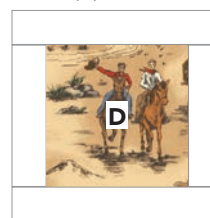

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VERTICAL SASHING

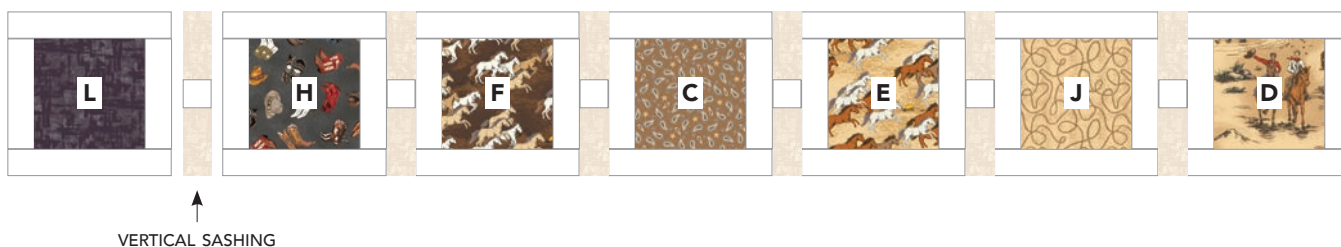
4. Sew (2) **M** 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) **A** 1-1/2" square. Make (42).

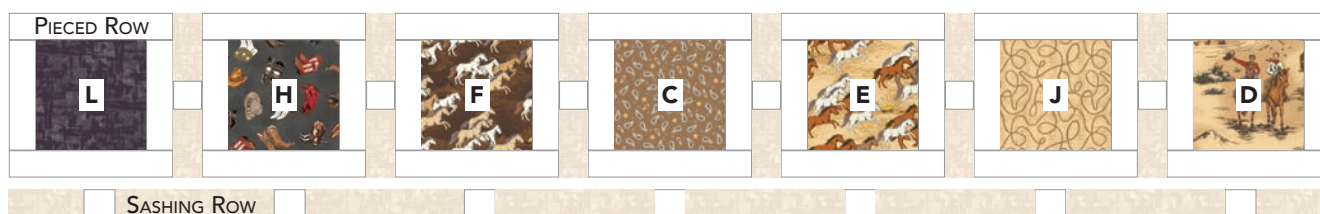
5. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew (7) Square Blocks and (6) Vertical Sashing to make (7) rows total. Row 1 is shown as an example.



6. Sashing Rows: Sew together (7) **A** 1-1/2" squares and (6) **M** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. Then add (2) **M** 1-1/2" x 3" rectangles to the opposite short sides to complete (1) Sashing Row. Make (6).



7. Sew together (7) Pieced Rows and (6) Sashing Rows to complete quilt center. Row 1 is shown as an example.

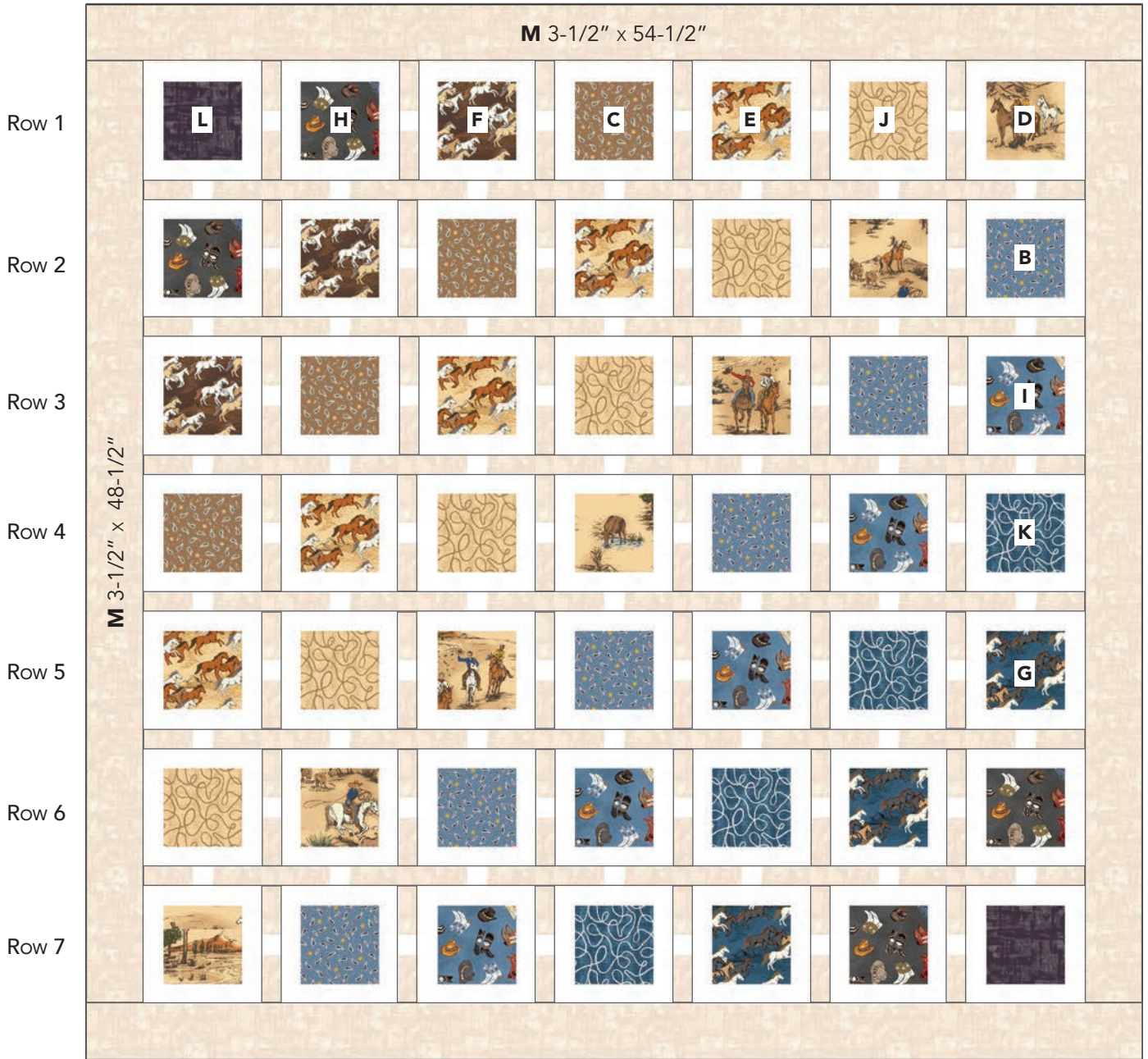


8. Outer Border: Sew (2) **M** 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center; followed by (2) **M** 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips to the top and bottom sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



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QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **H** 2-1/4" strips.
