

BLOCK 1


- 1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) D 2-1/2" square. Place D, right sides together, at the corner of (1) A 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle. Repeat at the opposite corner of A to complete unit. Make (4) Flying Geese Units.
- 2. Sew (2) A 2-1/2" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) Flying Geese Unit to make a Row Unit. Make (2).
- 3. Sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) D 4-1/2" square to make a Center Row Unit.
- 4. Sew Row and Center Row Units together to complete (1) Block 1. Note rotation of Row Units.

Repeat Steps 1-4 to make a total of (18) Block 1. Make the following quantities, using A 2-1/2" square and A 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle with the following fabrics:





BLOCK 2

6. Repeat Steps 1-4 using for:

Make (8) of **B/A/I**

Step 1 (Flying Geese Unit): (2) A 2-1/2" squares and (1) B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.


Step 2 (Row Unit): (2) B 2-1/2" squares.

Step 3 (Center Row Unit): (1) I 4-1/2" square.

Step 4: Sew Row and Center Row Units together to complete (1) Block 2, as shown below.

7. Repeat Steps to make a total of (17) Block 2. Make the following quantities:

Make (8) of **B/A/I**

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

- 8. Arrange and sew together a total of (5) Blocks, as shown (page 5), to make (1) Pieced Row. Rows 1, 3, 5, 7: (3) Block 1 and (2) Block 2 Rows 2, 4, 6: (2) Block 1 and (3) Block 2
- 9. Sew together Pieced Rows to complete Quilt Center.

BORDERS

- 10. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) A 2" x 56-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) A 2" x 43-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of Quilt Center.
- 11. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) C 1-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) C 1-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of Quilt Center.
- 12. Outer Border: Sew (2) F 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of Quilt Center, followed by (2) F 4-1/2" x 53-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of Quilt Center to complete Quilt Top.





FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **H** 2-1/4" strips.
