A		31835S White	2-3/8	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (12) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" and (6) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles, (36) 2-1/2" squares. (7) 4-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (108) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. (9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (35) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles. (8) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (6) 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" strips.
B		37098-14 Duckling	1/2	(4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (18) 2-1/2" squares, (6) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (6) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
C		37098-67 Light Green	1/2	(5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (24) 2-1/2" squares, (7) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (8) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
D		51158-1 Black	5/8	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (36) 2-1/2" squares, (9) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (12) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
E		51158-2 Charcoal	1/2	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (30) 2-1/2" squares, (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (10) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
F		51158-3 Blue	5/8	(8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (42) 2-1/2" squares, (10) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (14) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
G		51158-4 Red	1/2	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (30) 2-1/2" squares, (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (10) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
H		51158-5 Grey	1-1/8	(7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (36) 2-1/2" squares, (6) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" and (12) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles. Binding: (7) 2-1/4 x WOF strips.

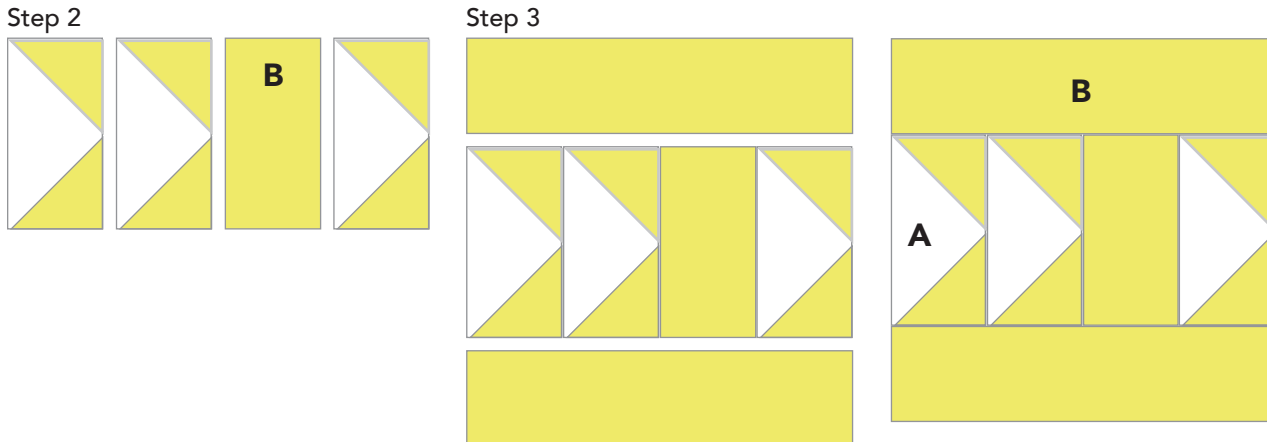

PIECED BLOCK A

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **B** 2-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **B** corner triangle. Repeat with an additional **B** 2-1/2" square at the opposite corner of the same **A** rectangle to complete a **Flying Geese Unit**. Make (3) units.

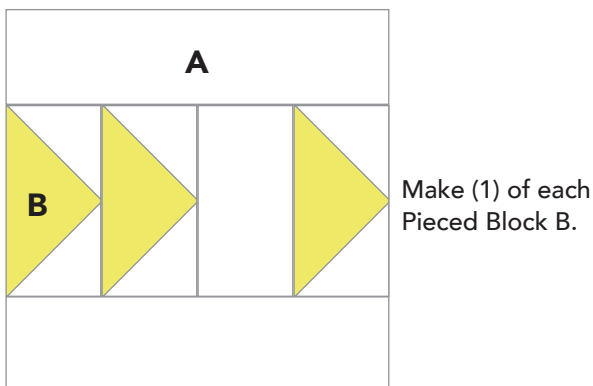


- 2.** Arrange and sew together, as shown below, (3) **Flying Geese Units** and (1) **B** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle to make a **Row Unit**.
- 3.** Add to the opposite long sides (2) **B** 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to complete (1) **Pieced Block A**.
- 4.** Make a total number of **Pieced Block A** for the following fabric combinations:
 (3) **B/A** (4) **C/A** (6) **D/A** (5) **E/A** (7) **F/A** (5) **G/A** (6) **H/A**

5. Following Steps 1-3, create (1) **Flying Geese Unit** for each of the following fabric combinations:
 (1) **A/B** (1) **A/C** (1) **A/D** (1) **A/E** (1) **A/F** (1) **A/G**

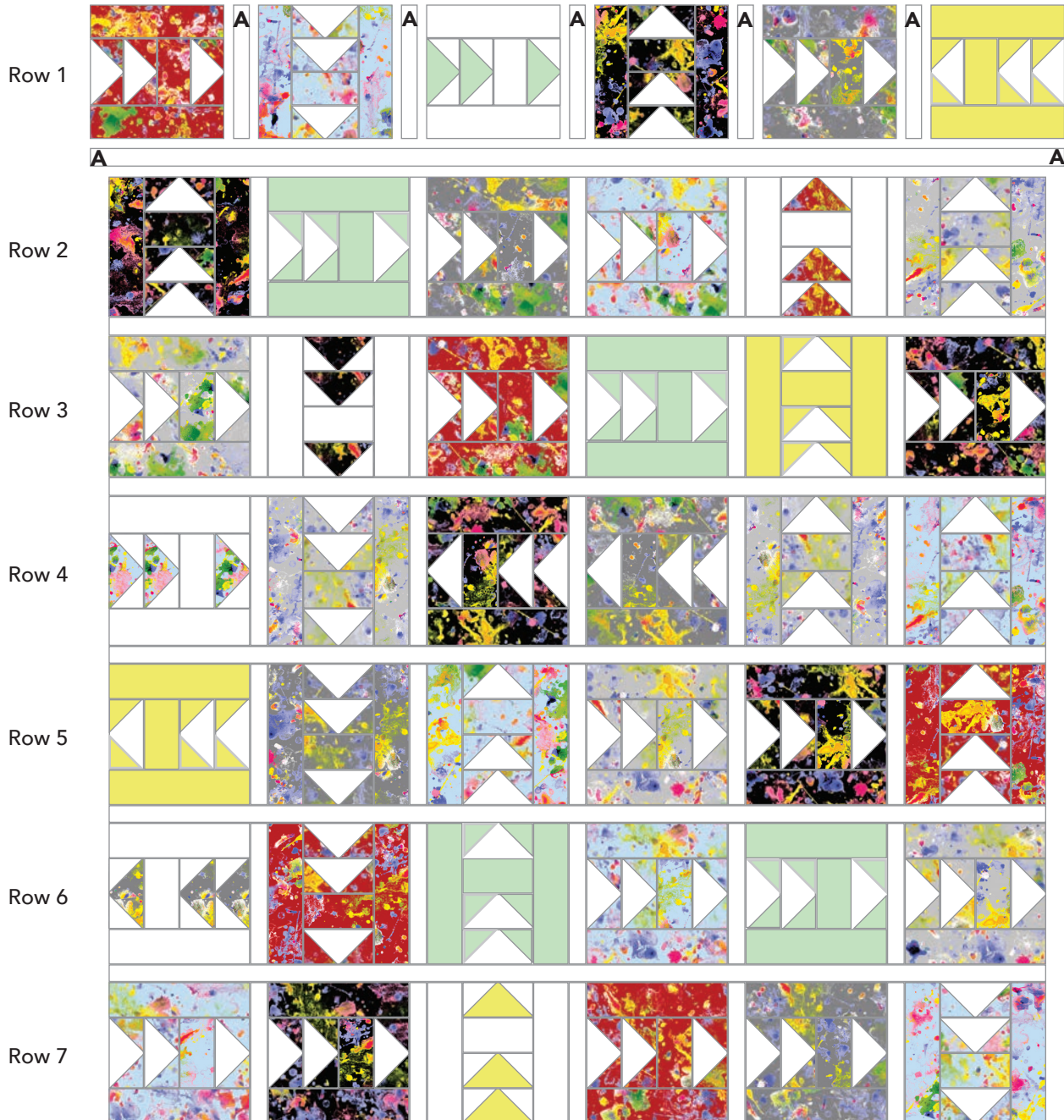

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Referring to **Quilt Top Image** for block placement and orientation, arrange and sew together (6) **Pieced Blocks** and (5) **A** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" sashing rectangles to make a **Pieced Row** as shown. Make a total of (7) **Pieced Rows**.
- Sew the (7) **Pieced Rows** completed in **Step 6**, and (6) **A** 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" sashing strips to complete **Quilt Top**.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **H** 2-1/4" strips.
