## PIECED BLOCK A

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) B 2-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) A 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal B corner triangle. Repeat with an additional B 2-1/2" square at the opposite corner of the same A rectangle to complete a Flying Geese Unit. Make (3) units.



Make (3) B/A
B combination.
2. Arrange and sew together, as shown below, (3) Flying Geese Units and (1) B 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a Row Unit.
3. Add to the opposite long sides (2) B 2-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to complete (1) Pieced Block A.
4. Make a total number of Pieced Block $A$ for the following fabric combinations:
(3) $\mathbf{B} / \mathbf{A}$
(4) $\mathbf{C} / \mathbf{A}$
(6) $\mathbf{D} / \mathbf{A}$
(5) $\mathbf{E} / \mathbf{A}$
(7) $\mathbf{F} / \mathbf{A}$
(5) $\mathbf{G} / \mathbf{A}$
(6) $H / A$

5. Following Steps 1-3, create (1) Flying Geese Unit for each of the following fabric combinations:
(1) $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{B}$
(1) $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{C}$
(1) $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{D}$
(1) $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{E}$
(1) $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{F}$
(1) $\mathbf{A} / \mathbf{G}$

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Referring to Quilt Top Image for block placement and orientation, arrange and sew together (6) Pieced Blocks and (5) A 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing rectangles to make a Pieced Row as shown. Make a total of (7) Pieced Rows.
7. Sew the (7) Pieced Rows completed in Step 6, and (6) A 1-1/2" $\times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips to complete Quilt Top.
