| 1 1/4 yard 41260-3 Teal | strips at top and bottom of center panel, second border setting triangles & corners |
| Fat Quarter each assorted*
(medium and dark prints) | 2 1/2 yards med & dark prints* second border star piecing, fourth border piecing |

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CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Generals panel

Fussy cut 17 1/2" X 21" rectangle, centering generals.

Note: If necessary, it is OK to cut the panel smaller than this as the first two borders can be adjusted.

The important dimension is that the quilt center, at the end of the first border, measure 26" X 26".

41261-1 Cranberry

Cut (2) 3" X 21" strips for first border.

Cut (2) 3" X 26" strips for first border.

Note: You may need to cut these borders wider and longer, if the center panel cannot be cut 17 1/2" X 21". It is recommended that the center panel, strips for top and bottom and the first (red) border be cut to fit each individual situation and the strips and red border sizes adjusted as needed.

Cut (4) 6 1/2" squares for fourth border corner blocks

41262-4 Brown ***ALL CUTS FOR THIS FABRIC ARE LENGTHWISE**

Cut (2) 3 1/4" X 43" strips for third border.

Cut (2) 3 1/4" X 48 1/2" strips for third border.

Cut (5) 2 1/4" strips, lengthwise of fabric. Piece, as necessary, to make 250" of binding.

41264-6 Cream

Cut (48) 2" squares for second border star piecing.

Cut (12) 4 1/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to make (48) triangles for second border star piecing.

41260-3 Teal

Cut (2) 3" X 21" strips for top and bottom of center panel.

Cut (4) 9" squares for second border corners.

Cut (12) 4 3/4" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally to make (48) setting triangles for second border star blocks.

Medium and Dark Prints

41262-4 Brown, 41262- 1 Cranberry, 41271-2 Indigo, 41267-3 Teal

Cut (2) 3 1/2" square.

Cut (8) 2 1/2" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (16) triangles

Medium and Dark Prints

41266-5 Gold, 41261-1 Cranberry, 41260-2 Indigo, 41265-7 Purple

Cut (1) 3 1/2" square.

Cut (4) 2 1/2" squares. Cut each square once diagonally to make (8) triangles.

From Assorted Fat Quarters (medium and dark prints)

Cut (32) 6 1/2" squares for fourth border.



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DIRECTIONS

Center

1. Sew 41260-3 3" x 21" Teal strips to top and bottom of Confederate Generals panel.
2. Press and trim. Quilt center should now measure 21" X 21".

First Border

1. Sew 41261-2 Cranberry print border strips to quilt center.
2. Press and trim. It is very important that quilt center now measure 26" X 26" so that additional rows will fit properly.

Variable Stars -- to make each star:

1.



Diagram 1

Refer to Diagram 1 and sew (1) medium or dark triangle to each side of a cream (41264-6) triangle. Press and trim. Unit should measure 2" X 3 1/2". Repeat to make (4) units for each Variable Star block.

Diagram 2

Use units made in Step 1, a matching medium or dark 3 1/2" square and (4) 2" cream squares.

Refer to Diagram 2 for placement of fabrics and units.

Press. Block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Diagram 3

Sew the long side of (1) 4 3/4" triangle tool print to each side of a Variable Star block, as shown in Diagram 3.



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- Repeat Steps 1 - 3 to make a total of (12) Variable Star blocks, each set on point as shown in Diagram 3.
- Sew blocks into (4) strips of three Variable Stars set on point, as shown in Diagram 4.

Diagram 4

- Referring to quilt cover, sew units made in Step 5, and 9" corner squares of 41260-3 Teal to quilt center. Quilt should now measure 43" X 43".

Third Border

- Sew 41262-4 Brown border strips to quilt center.
- Quilt should now measure 48 1/2" X 48 1/2".

Fourth Border

- Sew 6 1/2" blocks together into (4) strips of eight assorted blocks each.
- Sew one strip on each side of the quilt center.
- On the remaining 2 strips, add the (4) 41261-1 Cranberry blocks, one to each end of the 2 strips. Attach to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
- Press. Quilt should now measure 60 1/2" X 60 1/2". Quilt and bind as desired.



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
