
#### **General Instructions:**


- A. All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric.

<u>Piecing Instructions:</u> (Refer to block images below for proper placement)

Block 1: Square to 8-1/2", make (20)

- 1. Draw diagonal line on back of (80) E 2-1/2" squares.
- 2. Place (1) E 2-1/2" square right sides together on the left side of (1) C 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle square and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4".
- 3. Line up the EC rectangle along the right side of (1) E 4-1/2" square. Sew pieces together, stopping about 1" from bottom of E square. Press with seam allowance towards the C fabric. Square to 8-1/2"
- 4. Sew another EC rectangle to top and press, then repeat on left side and bottom.
- 5. Finish sewing partial seam created in Step 3 to compete BLOCK 1.





### Blocks 2A and 2B: Square to 8-1/2", make (2) each

- 6. Draw diagonal line on back of (2) B 2-1/2" squares
- 7. Place (1) B 2-1/2" square right sides together on the bottom left corner of (1) F 6-1/2" square and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to ¼".
- 8. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" strip to the right side, then sew (1) D 2-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangle to the top to complete BLOCK 2A. Square to 8 1/2"
- 9. Repeat steps 6-8 using D 2-1/2" squares, F 6-1/2" squares, B 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangles, and B 2-1/2" X 8-1/2" rectangles to create BLOCK 2B. Square to 8 1/2"






Blocks 3A and 3B: Square to 8-1/2" X 18-1/2" or 8-1/2" X 37-1/2", make (4) each

- 10. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" X 18-1/2" rectangle to top of (1) F 4-1/2" X 18-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) B 2-1/2" X 18-1/2" rectangle to bottom to complete BLOCK 3A.
- 11. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" X 37-1/2" rectangle to top of (1) F 4-1/2" X 37-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) B 2-1/2" X 37-1/2" rectangle to bottom to complete **BLOCK 3B**.

Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

### **Quilt Assembly:**

- 12. Sew (2) 2" X 42" G Border strips to sides of A 23-1/2" X 42" square.
- 13. Sew (2) 2-1/4" X 26-1/2" G Border strips to top and bottom to create QUILT CENTER. Square to 26-1/2" X 45-1/2".
- 14. Sew the following together and sew onto quilt center:

Sides: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 3B

Top/Bottom: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 3A - BLOCK 2A

15. Sew the following together, then sew onto guilt center:

Sides: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 3B

Top/Bottom: BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 1 - BLOCK 3A - BLOCK 2B

### Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
