#### **Cutting Instructions:**

WOF= Width of Fabric. All Fabric E pieces are Fussy Cut with the motif centered in the pieces. Trace and apply fusible web to fabric pieces marked with \* before cutting fabric.




#### **Sewing Instructions:**

All seams are sewn right sides together. Seam allowances are 1/4". Press seams as directed. Appliqué using a small blanket stitch and matching thread.

1. Sew (2) Fabric M Template 1 pieces on either side of the Fabric A 3 1/4" triangles. Press towards Fabric M. Sew a Fabric A 5 1/4" triangles to the top to make (4) A Units.




2. Sew the Fabric A 3 3/4" triangles to the end of each Fabric E 4 5/8" x 10 1/2" rectangle. Press towards Fabric E. Sew a Fabric M 7 7/8" triangles to the bottom to make (4) B Units.






3. Sew the A and B units together. Press towards the B Unit to make (4) A Blocks.




- 4. Fold the **Fabric C** Template 2 pieces and the **Fabric A** 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares in half twice. Finger press the folds. Fuse and appliqué the Template 2 pieces to the Fabric A squares, matching the marked folds, so that the Template 2 pieces are 1/4" from the raw edge of the squares.
- 5. Fold the **Fabric I, G, and K** Template 3 pieces in half twice. Finger press the folds. Fuse and appliqué the Template 3 pieces to the Template 2 pieces, so that the outer edge of Template 3 overlaps the inner edge of Template 2 by 1/4", to make (8) Block B.






- 6. Sew a pair of **Fabric D** 1 1/4" x 6 1/4" rectangles to opposite sides of the **Fabric E**, **H**, **J**, and **L** 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" squares. Press towards **Fabric D**, then sew a pair of **Fabric D** 1 1/4" x 7 3/4" to the remaining sides. Press towards **Fabric D to make** (13) C Units.
- 7. Sew a pair of **Fabric A** 1 7/8"  $\times$  8 1/4" rectangles to opposite sides of the C Units. Press towards the C Unit, then sew a pair of **Fabric A** 1 7/8"  $\times$  10 1/2" rectangles to the remaining sides and press towards the C Unit to make (13) C Blocks.



8. Fold the C Blocks in half twice and finger press the folds. Arrange a pair of **Fabric F** Template 4 pieces at each fold, so that the points meet at the inside square and the outer points are 1/4" from the raw edge of the C Blocks. Fuse and appliqué the Template 4 pieces to the C Blocks.



#### Finishing

- 9. Using the layout chart as a guide, sew the **Fabric B** 7 7/8" triangles, **Fabric B** 15 3/8" triangles, A Blocks, B Blocks, and C Blocks together into diagonal rows, paying close attention to the placement and orientation of each block. Press the even rows right and the odd rows left.
- 10. Sew the rows together into the quilt top, matching seam allowances carefully. Press towards the bottom of the quilt.
- 11. Make a backing approximately 64"x 64" from **Fabric N**.
- 12. Layer the backing right side down, batting, and quilt top right side up. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the quilt top.



13. Piece the 2 1/4" x WOF **Fabric N** strips using diagonal seams to make a continuous binding. Sew the binding around the quilt top. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy.
