
#### **Making the Blocks**


All seam allowances are 1/4".

1. To make each block you will need (4) matching print squares, (3) white squares, and (1) coordinating solid square. Place (1) print square right sides together (RST) with (1) coordinating solid square, and pin in place. Sew around the entire perimeter of the square. Cut the squares into quarters on the diagonal to yield (4) half square triangles (HSTs) as illustrated in Fig. 1. Press seam towards the darker fabric. Trim each HST to 4½" square. Repeat with the remaining print and white squares.

Please note that the HSTs will have bias cut edges that can stretch. Handle carefully and use plenty of pins when assembling into blocks.






## Night Bunnies

2. Arrange your HSTs as illustrated in Fig 2. Sew together in rows, pressing seams in alternating directions by row to nest the seams.

- 3. Sew the rows together, pinning at seams and nesting them. Press seams open.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make a total of 16 blocks, referring to the quilt photo for color combinations.

### **Quilt Assembly**

- 5. Sew your blocks together in (4) rows of (4), pinning at the seams. Press seams open.
- 6. Sew the rows together, pinning at the seams. Press seams open.

### **Quilting Instructions**

7. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish the quilt.
