



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FOUR-PATCH BLOCK

 Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) P 1-1/2" square. Place marked P square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) U 3-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal P corner triangle. Make (8).



Four-Patch Unit: Noting rotation and placement of units, sew together (2) Corner Triangle Units and (2) P 3-1/2" squares into (1) block. Block measures 6-1/2" square unfinished. Make (4).




- Block measures: 6-1/2" square unfinished.
- 3. Using fabric U, repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make (4) blocks for fabrics B to T.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

REFER TO QUILT IMAGE FOR BLOCK PLACEMENT AND ORIENTATION GUIDE.

4. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew (8) Four-Patch Blocks, as shown below. Make (10).

Row 1 is shown.




Make (10) pieced rows.

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5. Noting rotation and placement, sew together pieced rows to complete quilt top.



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **T** 2-1/4" strips.
