Constructing diamond-in-square (DIS) units (using D unit as example)

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 $1/2" \times 2 \times 1/2"$ **B** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4 $1/2" \times 4 \times 1/2"$) **D** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **B** corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional 2 $1/2" \times 2 \times 1/2"$ **B** squares at the remaining corners of the 4 $1/2" \times 4 \times 1/2"$ **D** square to complete (1) DIS unit. Square to 4 $1/2" \times 4 \times 1/2"$ raw edge to raw edge.



2. Repeat to make a total of DIS units in the following combinations:

(8): **J/B**

(6): **E/B, F/B, G/B**

(5): **D/B, H/B**

(4): **I/B**

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew 8 units together for the top and bottom borders and attach. Then sew 12 units together for the side borders and attach.





- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 48 1/2" $\bf L$ strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 48 1/2" $\bf K$ strip to the left and right of quilt center, respectively; followed by (1) 1 1/4" x 42" $\bf K$ strip and (1) 1 1/4" x 42" $\bf L$ strip to the top and bottom of quilt center as shown on page 4.
- 3. Outer border. Sew (2) 4 1/4" x 25 1/4" **C** rectangles along the short sides to make (1) 4 1/4" x 50 strip. Repeat to make (2) strips, and add to opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew together (1) 4 1/4" x 40 1/2" and (1) 4 1/4" x 9 1/2" **C** rectangles to make a strip. Repeat to make (2) strips, and add to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top as shown on page 4.





Quilting Instructions

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
