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“Raven Mantel Scarf”

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FABRIC CUTTING and SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

Using the included template, cut the following pieces:

6 – Orange Damask triangles (only 3 need to be fussy cut for the fronts)

4 – Green Skulls 4 – Black Words

8 – Purple Ravens 4 – Black Damask

Sew these triangles together, right sides together, in pairs of like fabrics with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam . Sew on the long sides, leaving the short side open.

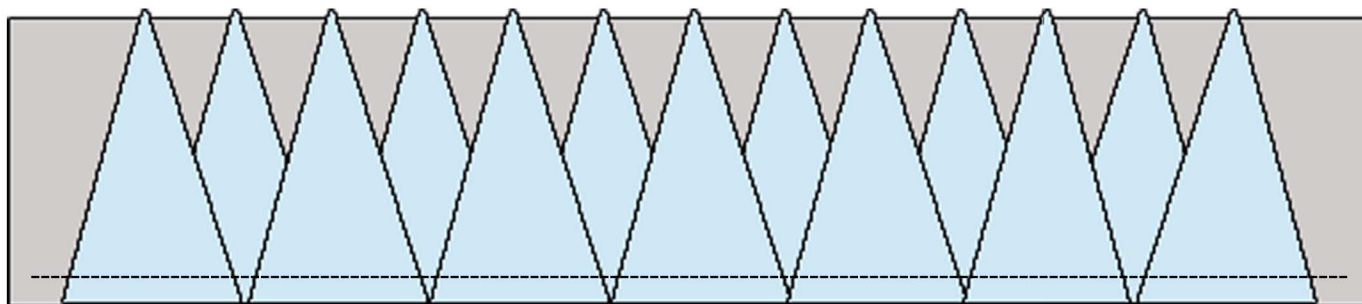
Trim excess fabric at tip and turn right sides out. Press well. You will have 13 triangles for your scarf.

Baste along top edge, $\frac{1}{8}$ " away from raw edges.

From the Orange Words, cut 2 – $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x Width of fabric strips.

Take one of these strips after its cut and lay it out right side up. Position your triangles along one edge, paying close attention to fabric placement. Leave $\frac{1}{2}$ " between the outer triangle edge and the end of the long side of the strip (see diagram below). The raw edges should be lined up with the bottom edge of the strip and the triangles should extend over the center of the strip.

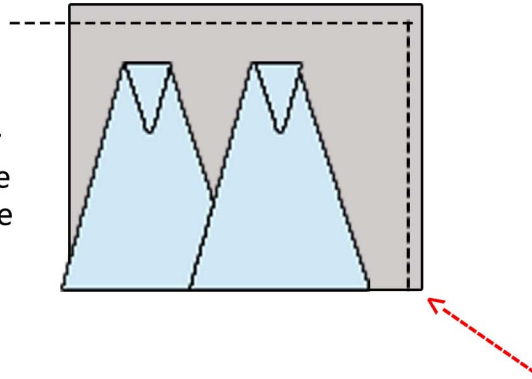
Baste triangles to orange strip $\frac{1}{8}$ " from raw edge (see below).



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Fold the triangle points before you sandwich the other two strips to be sure you do not catch the points in the seam



Sewing instructions continued:

Fold points up into the center of the strip so that they won't get caught in the seam. See Diagram above.

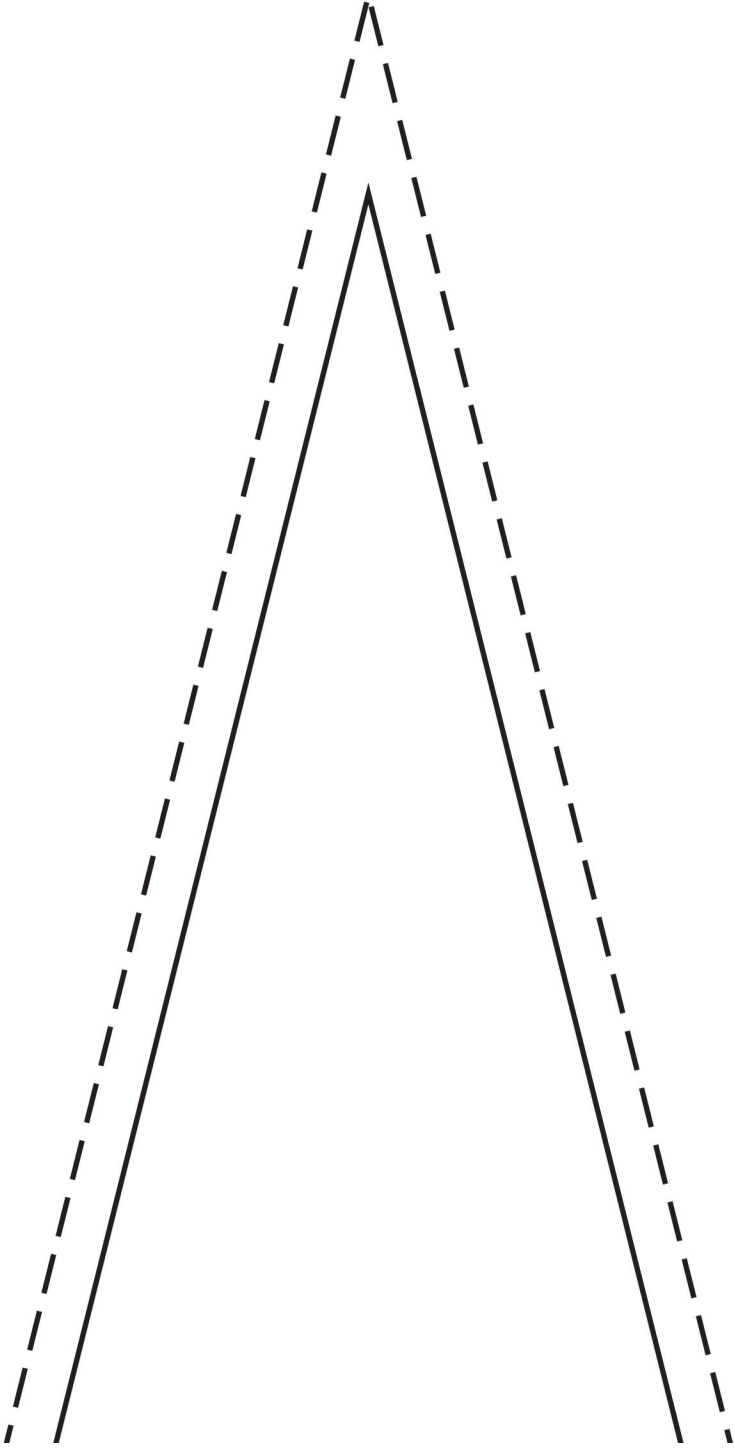
Lay second strip, right side down, on top of triangles (not shown). Pin edges. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " around the entire strip, leaving a 4" opening at the back. Trim excess fabric at triangle points and turn right side out. Turn in unfinished edges and top-stitch close to edge around the whole strip.

Embellish with bells, tassels, spiders, etc.
