

А		42934-1 Blue	1	(4) 12-1/2" x 8-1/2" vertical pieces, fussy cut as desired. (4) 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" horizontal pieces, fussy cut as desired.
В		42935-1 Blue	1/4	(1) 6" x WOF strip, subcut into (4) 6" squares.
С		42936-2 Grey	1/2	(1) 12-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut into (2) 12-1/2" x 8-1/2" vertical pieces (2) 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" horizontal pieces.
D		42937-2 Grey	1/2	(1) 6" x WOF strip, subcut into (4) 6" squares. (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut into (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces. (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut into (16) 2-1/2" squares.
E		42938-1 Blue	5/8	(1) 5" x WOF strip, subcut into (4) 5" squares cut diagonally in half once, and (2) 4-1/2" squares. (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut into (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces. (1) 3" x WOF strip, subcut into (8) 3" squares. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut into (4) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces and (8) 2-1/2" squares.
F		42938-3 Red	1 5/8	(2) 5" x WOF strips, subcut into (5) 5" squares cut diagonally in half once, (1) 4-1/2" square, and (16) 2-1/2" squares. (1) 3" x WOF strip, subcut into (12) 3" squares. (16) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut (2) strips into (4) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces and reserve remainder for border and binding.
G		42938-4 Green	5/8	(1) 5" x WOF strip, subcut into (4) 5" squares cut diagonally in half once, and (2) 4-1/2" squares. (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut into (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces. (1) 3" x WOF strip, subcut into (8) 3" squares. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, subcut into (20) 2-1/2" squares.

Sewing Directions


Large Snowflake Block (12" square finished)

1. Fold a 4-1/2" **E** square in half in both directions and finger press to find center points of each side. Fold and finger press (4) 3-3/4" **H** triangles to find the center of the long edge. Matching center points, position (2) **H** triangles right sides together on opposite sides of an **E** square and sew. Center and sew remaining **H** triangles to the top and bottom of the square and press.



2. In the same way, add (4) 5'' **E** triangles to the edges of the unit from Step 1. Trim to measure 8-1/2'' square.







3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) 3" \mathbf{H} squares. Pair a marked square right sides together with a 3" \mathbf{E} square. Sew ¼" on either side of the drawn line, cut on the line, and press units open. Trim each half-square triangle unit (HST) to measure 2-1/2" square. Make (8) half-square triangle units. Sew HST units to opposite ends of (1) 2-1/2" \times 4-1/2" \times 4 piece. Make (4).















4. Sew (2) units from Step 3 to opposite sides of a block center from Step 2, noting orientation. Sew 2-1/2" **E** squares to both ends of the remaining (2) units from Step 3. Sew pieced units to the top and bottom to complete the Large Snowflake block. Make a total of (2) blue, (2) green, and (1) red Large Snowflake blocks.









Santa Block (12" square finished)

5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 2-1/2" $\bf H$ squares. Layer the marked square on one end of a 2-1/2" $\bf x$ 4-1/2" $\bf G$ piece. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and press open. In the same way, position and stitch a marked 2-1/2" $\bf H$ square to the opposite end to create a flying geese unit. Make a total of (16) each $\bf G$, $\bf E$, and $\bf D$ flying geese units.


















6. Sew (3) flying geese units together lengthwise in the following order: **G**, **D**, **E**. Make (8) **G-D-E** units. In the same way, make (8) **E-D-G** units. Referring to the diagram below, sew the **G-D-E** units and **E-D-G** units to the long sides of 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" and 12-1/2" x 8-1/2" **A** pieces, noting orientation of both the fabric motifs in the A pieces and the position of the flying geese units. Make a total of (2) of each Santa block configuration shown.



Framed Diamond Block (12" square finished)

7. Add 5-1/4" **F** triangles to the sides of a 6" **D** square as in step 1; trim to measure 8-1/2" square.

8. Sew 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **H** pieces to opposite sides of the pieced square. Sew 2-1/2" **D** squares both short ends of (2) additional 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" **H** pieces. Sew these pieced units to the top and bottom of the pieced square to complete the Framed Diamond block. Make a total of (4) Framed Diamond blocks.








Snow Crystals block (12" square finished)

9. Referring to Step 3, use (2) 3" **H** squares and (2) 3" **F** squares to make a total of (4) HSTs. Lay out the HSTs, (3) 2-1/2" **F** squares and (2) 2-1/2" **H** squares into (3) rows of (3) each, as shown. Sew the units into rows and join the rows to complete a red quarter block.





10. Sew (2) 2-1/2" $\bf G$ squares and (2) 2-1/2" $\bf H$ squares together to make a four-patch unit. Sew (1) 2-1/2" $\bf x$ 4-1/2" $\bf H$ piece to one side of the unit. Sew (1) 2-1/2" $\bf G$ square to (1) 2-1/2" $\bf x$ 4-1/2" $\bf H$ unit. Join to the pieced unit to complete the green quarter block.









11. Lay out a red quarter block, green quarter block, and (2) 6-1/2" **H** squares into (2) rows of (2) units each. Sew the units into rows and join the rows to complete the Snow Crystals block. Make a total of (4) Snow Crystals blocks.








Snowman Block (12" square finished)

12. Press each 6" **B** square under ¼" on all sides. Find the center of an 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" **C** piece. Center the **B** square diagonally on the **C** piece and hand applique or topstitch in place. Make (2) horizontal block centers and (2) vertical block centers, noting the orientation of the Fabric **C** motifs.

13. Sew (1) 2-1/2" \times 12-1/2" \times piece and (1) 2-1/2" \times 12-1/2" \times piece to each block center, noting orientation and position as shown in the diagram below.









Assembly

- 1. Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram, lay out the blocks into (5) rows of (5) blocks each, noting orientation of all the blocks. Sew the blocks into rows, and join the rows to complete the quilt center.
- 2. Sew (7) 2-1/2" \times WOF **F** strips short ends together into one long strip. Cut (2) 64-1/2" lengths and (2) 60-1/2" lengths. Sew the shorter strips to the sides of the quilt and the longer strips to the top and bottom.
- 3. Layer the quilt back right side down, batting, and quilt top right side up. Baste layers together and quilt as desired. Use the (7) 2-1/4" x WOF **F** strips to bind the quilt.
