
#### Instructions:

#### Block A:

1. Sew a Fabric A 2" square to the short ends of a Fabric H 2"  $\times$  5" rectangle to make a Unit 1. Make 2. Sew to the left and right side of a Fabric H 8" square as shown in Diagram 1.



2. Sew the short end of a Fabric A 2" x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to both short ends of a Fabric H 2" x 5" rectangle to make Unit 2. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the block as shown in Diagram 2.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make (2) blocks each. Fabrics B, C, D, E, G, H, J, L M, N, O and P.


Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make (1) block each from Fabric F and K. Set aside. You will have a total of (28) Blocks A.

#### Block B:

1. Sew a Fabric Q 2" square to both sides of a Fabric I 2" square to make unit 3. Sew a Fabric Q 2" x 5" rectangle to the top and bottom of Unit 3. See Diagram 3.



2. Sew a Fabric A 2" x 5" rectangle to both sides of the unit in Diagram 3 to make unit 4. Sew a Fabric A 2" x 8" rectangle to the top and bottom of unit 4. See Diagram 4.



3. Sew the short ends of a Fabric A 2"  $\times$  3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the sides of a Fabric I 2" square as shown to make Unit 5. Make 2. Sew to the sides of the unit 5. See Diagram 5.



4. Sew the short ends of a Fabric A  $2'' \times 5''$  rectangle to the sides of a Fabric "I" 2'' square as shown to make Unit 5. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the block. Repeat to make (28) B blocks. Set aside.







#### Assembling the Quilt Rows

The quilt center is made of 8 horizontal rows of 7 blocks each, alternating blocks A and B.

1. Row 1: Sewing from left to right, start with a Block B, and sew (7) alternating blocks A and B ending with a Block B. Follow the photo for placement of the Block A fabrics in the row. Repeat to make rows 3, 5, and 7, starting and ending with a Block B checking color placement in each row for each Block A.



2. Row 2: Sewing from left to right, start with a Block A, and sew (7) alternating blocks B and A ending with a Block A. Follow the photo for placement of the Block A fabrics in the row. Repeat to make rows 4, 6, and 8, starting and ending with a Block A and checking for color placement.



3. Sew the (8) rows of blocks together to complete the quilt center.

#### Borders:

- 1. Sew the Fabric Q 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 84  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the sides of the quilt.
- 2. Sew the Fabric Q 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 76" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Layer quilt, quilt as desired and bind using the Fabric Q 2 ½" strips.
