#### 1. CONSTRUCTING "C" BLOCK (USING BLUE BLOCK AS EXAMPLE):

Flying geese units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2" x 2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) F 2" x 3.5" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A triangle. Repeat with another (1) A 2" x 2" at the other end of the same (1) F 2" x 3.5" rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 flying geese units.

Sew 2 flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) B 3.5" x 3.5" square to make a row.



Sew (2) F 2" x 2" squares to the opposite short sides of 1 flying geese unit.



Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.

Sew all rows to complete 1 block.




Make a total of number of blocks in the following color way:

#### 2. CONSTRUCTING "B" BLOCK (USING BLUE BLOCK AS EXAMPLE):

Diamond-in-Square. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) B 5" x 5" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal corner white triangle. Repeat with an additional (3) F 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares at the remaining corners of the same (1) B 5" x 5" square to complete 1 diamond-in-square block center.



Flying geese units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 2-3/4"  $\times$  2-3/4" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) F 2-3/4"  $\times$  5" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another A 2-3/4"  $\times$  2-3/4" square at the other corner of the same F 2-3/4"  $\times$  5" rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 flying geese units.

Sew 2 flying geese units to the opposite sides of block center to make a row.



Sew (2) F 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" square to the opposite short sides of 1 flying geese unit to make a row.




Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.




Sew rows together to complete 1 whole block.



Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following color ways:





Making C half blocks. Use the same procedure to make the flying geese units, as shown.





Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) C 3-1/4"  $\times$  3-1/4" square. Place square, right sides together on (1) F 3-1/4"  $\times$  3-1/4" square. Sew 1/4" away from, and on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield 2 HST unit. Open and press. Aligning the diagonal seam of the HST with the 45-degree line of a ruler, trim HST to measure 2-3/4"  $\times$  2-3/4" raw edge to raw edge.

Sew 2 HST units to the opposite short sides of flying geese unit, as shown, to make a row.



Sew (2) F 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares to the opposite short sides of flying geese unit, as shown, to make a row.



Sew rows together to complete (1) C half block.



Repeat to make a total of 2 half blocks.



#### 3. CONSTRUCTING "A" BLOCK (USING BLUE BLOCK AS EXAMPLE):

Flying geese units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) F 3.5" x 3.5" square. Place square, right side together, at a corner of (1) A 3.5" x 6.5" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white corner triangle. Repeat with another (1) F 3.5" x 3.5" square at the other corner of the same (1) A 3.5" x 6.5" rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 flying geese units.

Sew two flying geese units to the opposite sides of 1 blue Block C to make a row.



Sew (2) A 3.5" x 3.5" squares to the opposite short sides of 1 flying geese to make a row.



Repeat to make 2 rows.


Sew rows together to complete 1 block.



Repeat to make a total of 1 block in the following color ways:










#### 3. QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:

Arrange and sew blocks into pieced columns.

Block A

Block B (whole and half blocks)

Block C








Vertical sashing blocks. Arrange and sew (2)  $\mathbf{F}$  1" x 36.5" and (1)  $\mathbf{I}$  1" x 36.5" strip to make a vertical sashing block. Repeat to make 2 vertical sashing blocks.




Sew pieced columns and vertical sashing blocks to complete quilt center.




#### 4. QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

Inner border #1. Arrange and sew (2) **F** 1" x 36.5" and (1) **I** 1" x 36.5" strip to make a pieced border strip. Repeat to make 2 pieced border strips, and sew the pieced strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center.





Arrange and sew (2) I 1"  $\times$  33.5" and (1) I 1"  $\times$  33.5" strips to make a pieced border strip. Repeat to make 2 pieced border strips and add to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.



Inner border #2. Sew (2) H 1"  $\times$  39.5" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) H 1"  $\times$  34.5" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

Inner border #3. Sew (2) F 1"  $\times$  40.5" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) F 1"  $\times$  35.5" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

Outer border. Sew (2) B  $2.5" \times 41.5"$  strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) B  $2.5" \times 39.5"$  strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



#### 5. QUILTING INSTRUCTIONS:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
