A		42893-5	2	Background: (1) 15 ½" x 42" strip; cut into (4) 9 ½" x 15 ½" rectangles.  (6) 3 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (4) 3 ½" x 24 ½" strips, (4) 3 ½" x 12 ½" strips, and (8) 3 ½" x 9 ½" strips.  Walter's Place block: (1) 3 7/8" x 42" strip; cut into (8) 3 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal.  (1) 4 ¼" x 42" strip; cut into (4) 4 ¼" squares, cut twice on diagonal.  Star block: (2) 5 ¾" x 42" strip; cut into (9) 5 ¾" squares, cut twice on diagonal.  (3) 2 ¾" x 42" strips; cut into (36) 2 ¾" squares.

### **Block Assembly:**

Star block:

1. Sew the long side of a Fabric C 3 1/8" triangle to both short sides of a Fabric A 5  $\frac{3}{4}$ " triangle as shown to make a Flying Geese unit. Square up to 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5" unfinished. Make 4. Set aside.

2. Sew the Fabric C side of a Flying Geese unit to both sides of a Fabric B 5" square as shown. Square up to  $5" \times 9 \frac{1}{2}"$ .



3. Sew a Fabric A 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " square to both ends of a Flying Geese unit as shown. Square up to 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished. Make 2.






4. Sew the section in Step 3 to the top of the section in Step 2. Rotate and sew the remaining section in Step 3 to the bottom to complete the Star block. Square up to 9 1/2". Make 9.




#### Greek Cross block:

5. Sew the long side of a Fabric D and E 3 7/8" triangle together to make a half square triangle (HST). Square up to 3 ½". Make 4.







- 6. Sew a Fabric E and F 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle together as shown. Square up to 3 1/2". Make 4.
- 7. Sew a HST to both sides of a unit from Step 6 to make Row 1 of the block. Square up to 3 ½" x 9 ½". Make 2.



8. Sew a unit from Step 6 to both sides of a Fabric F 3 ½" square to make Row 2 of the block.



9. Row 1 to the top of the section in Step 8. Rotate and sew the second Row 1 to the bottom to complete the block. Square up to 9 1/2". Make 8.

#### Walter's Place block:

10. Sew a Fabric G 2 5/8" square to both sides of a Fabric F 2 5/8" square as shown.



11. Sew the long side of a Fabric B 2 3/8" triangle to both ends of the section in Step 10 as shown.



12. Sew the short side of a Fabric B 4 1/4" triangle to both sides of a Fabric G 2 5/8" square. Sew the long side of a Fabric B 2 3/8" triangle to the top as shown. Make 2 Pieced Triangle Units


13. Sew a Pieced Triangle Unit to the top and bottom of the section in Step 11 as shown. Set aside.



14. Sew the short side of a Fabric B 4 ¼" triangle to both sides of an inverted Fabric A 4 ¼" triangle as shown to make a 3 Pieced Triangle Unit. Make 4.



15. Sew the long side of a 3 Pieced Triangle Unit to all 4 sides of the unit in Step 13 -->

#### Cornerstones:

17. Sew a Fabric G 1 5/8" square to both long sides of a Fabric C 1 ¼" x 1 5/8" rectangle. Make 2.



18. Sew the short end of a Fabric C 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 5/8" rectangle to both sides of a Fabric G 1  $\frac{1}{4}$ " square.



19. Sew the section in Step 17 to the top and bottom of the section in Step 18 to complete the cornerstone. Square up to  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  unfinished. Make 24.

Cornerstone --> Make 24.



20. Sew the short end of a Fabric H 1 5/8" x 3 7/8" rectangle to both short ends of a

Fabric I 1 5/8" x 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle as shown. Make 2 -->



21. Sew the short ends of a Fabric C 1 ¼" x 3 7/8" rectangle to both short ends of a Fabric H 1 ¼" x 2 ¾" rectangle.

22. Sew a section from Step 20 to the top and bottom of the Step 21 section to complete the Eashing to  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 32.

Make 32.



### Quilt Row Assembly:

The quilt center is made of 5 horizontal rows of 5 blocks each plus the Sashing block rows. The Sashing rows are Rows 1, 3, and 5. Follow the diagrams for placement of each block, sew each row in the order stated below.

Row 1: Sew a Cornerstone block to both short ends of a Sashing block. Sew the short ends of a Fabric A 3 ½" x 24 ½" strip to both ends of that row as shown. Make 2.





Row 2: Starting in the center, sew the long sides of a Sashing block to both sides of a Greek Cross block. Sew a Star block to the left and right ends of the row. Sew the short end of a Fabric A 9 ½" x 15 ½" rectangle to the left and right ends to complete Row 2. Make 2.



Row 3: Sew (3) Sashing blocks alternating with (4) Cornerstone blocks, end to end. Sew a Fabric A  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the left and right end of the row. Make 2.



Row 4: Working from left to right, sew the long side of a Fabric A 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle to the left side of a Star block, Sashing block, Greek Cross block, Sashing block, Walter's Place block, Sashing block, Greek Cross block, Sashing block, Sas



Row 5: Working from left to right, sew end to end a Cornerstone, Sashing block, Cornerstone, Sashing block, Cornerstone, a Fabric A 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle, Cornerstone, Sashing block, Cornerstone, Sashing block, and end on the right with a Cornerstone. Make 2.

Row 6: This is the center horizontal row. From left to right sew together side by side a Sashing block, Greek Cross block, Sashing block, Walter's Place block, Fabric A 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle, Star block, Fabric A 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangle, Walter's Place block, Sashing Block, Greek Cross block, Sashing block. Make 1.






#### **Quilt Assembly:**

23. The quilt center will be sewn with horizontal seams from top to bottom as follows: Row 1, Row 2, Row 3, Row 4, Row 5, and Row 6.

Below Row 6 in this order, sew on another Row 5, Row 4, Row 3, Row 2 and Row 1.



#### Inner Border:

24. Sew the (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strips to the sides of the quilt center. Sew the (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strips to the top and bottom of quilt.

#### Outer Border:

- 25. Sew the (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strips to the sides of quilt center. Sew the (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 73  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strips to the top and bottom of quilt.
- 26. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; quilt as desired. Using the Fabric K  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips, bind the edges to finish.
