

General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.

<u>Piecing Instructions:</u> (Refer to block images for proper placement and rotation)

Half Square Triangle (HST) Units:

- Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) E1 square. Place E1 square right sides together with (1) D1 square. Sew 1/4" on either side of diagonal line, then cut on drawn line. Press open. Square to 4-1/2", repeat 5 more times to create (12) ED HSTs.
- 2. Repeat step 1 using (24) D1 squares with (24) G1 squares to make (48) DG HSTs, (6) E1 squares with (6) F1 squares to make (12) EF HSTs, and (24) H1 squares with (24) E1 squares to make (48) HE HSTs.
























BLOCK 1: (Refer to block images for proper placement and rotation)

- 3. Sew (2) DG HSTs together, then sew to left side of B1 square. Repeat on right side.
- 4. Sew together (1) E2 square, (2) GD HSTs and (1) ED HST, then sew to top. Repeat on bottom to complete BLOCK 1. Square to 16-1/2", make (6).












BLOCK 2: (Refer to block images for proper placement and rotation)

- 5. Sew (2) HE HSTs together, then sew to left side of C1 square. Repeat on right side.
- 6. Sew together (1) F2 square, (2) HE HSTs and (1) EF HST, then sew to top. Repeat on bottom to complete BLOCK 2. Square to 16-1/2", make (6).







Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

7. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1 & 3: Block 1 - Block 2 - Block 1 ROWS 2 & 4: Block 2 - Block 1 - Block 2

Border Assembly:

Border 1:

8. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 64-1/2"), cut (2) D 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 50-1/2") cut (2) D 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 2:

9. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 66-1/2"), cut (2) A 4-1/2" strips from pieced strip to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. 10. Sew the 4-1/2" X 58-1/2" A length of fabric strips to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
