


PIECING INSTRUCTIONS STRIP SET A ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strip onto either side of (1) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip lengthwise. Press toward Fabric I.
- 2. Repeat to create (4) identical Strip Set A, each measuring 8 ½" x WOF.
- 3. From Strip Set A, subcut (64) 2 ½" x 8 ½" units. Label as Unit A.



STRIP SET B ASSEMBLY:


- 4. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strip onto either side of (1) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric G strip lengthwise. Press toward Fabric G.
- 5. Repeat to create (4) identical Strip Set B, each measuring 8 ½" x WOF.
- 6. From Strip Set B, subcut (64) 2 ½" x 8 ½" units. Label as Unit B.



BLOCK ASSEMBLY:


- **7.** To create Block Colorway 1, arrange the following pieces:
 - **a.** (4) 4 ½" **Fabric E** squares.
 - **b.** (1) 8 ½" **Fabric B** square.
 - c. (4) Unit A.
 - d. (4) Unit B.
- **8.** Arrange the pieces gathered above as shown in the diagram, and sew. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block Colorway 1 should measure $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- 9. Repeat to create (4) Block Colorway 1.






- 10. To create Block Colorway 2, arrange the following pieces:
 - a. (4) 4 1/2" Fabric K squares.
 - **b.** (1) 8 ½" **Fabric D** square.
 - c. (4) Unit A.
 - d. (4) Unit B.
- **11.** Arrange the pieces gathered above, and sew referencing Step 8. Once complete, Block Colorway 2 should measure 16 ½" x 16 ½" unfinished.
- 12. Repeat to create (8) Block Colorway 2.
- **13.** To create Block Colorway 3, arrange the following pieces:
 - **a.** (4) 4 ½" **Fabric E** squares.
 - **b.** (1) 8 ½" **Fabric C** square.
 - **c.** (4) Unit A.
 - d. (4) Unit B.
- **14.** Arrange the pieces gathered above, and sew referencing Step 8. Once complete, Block Colorway 3 should measure 16 ½" x 16 ½" unfinished.
- 15. Repeat to create (4) Block Colorway 3.

Create (8) Colorway 2 K K K 16 ½"



SASHING ASSEMBLY:


- **16.** Create a strip set for the sashing by sewing (3) 2" x WOF **Fabric A** strips and (2) 6 ¼" x WOF **Fabric H** strips together, alternating between **Fabrics A** and **H** as shown in the diagram.
- 17. Repeat to create (3) identical strip sets, each measuring 16 ½" x WOF.
- 18. From the strip sets, subcut (40) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units for sashing. Set units aside for quilt assembly.





QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- **19.** Create horizontal block rows. Arrange Block Colorways 1-3 in a 4 x 4 grid as shown in the diagram. Place (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieced sashing unit vertically in between each block and at either end of each block row.
- **20.** Create horizontal sashing rows. Arrange (4) 2 %" x 16 %" pieced sashing units and 2 %" cornerstone squares from **Fabrics F** and **J**. Place horizontal sashing rows between each block row and at the top and bottom of the quilt top. Alternate between **Fabrics F** and **J** cornerstones as shown in the diagram.
- 21. Sew horizontal block rows together, pressing seams toward the pieced sashing units.
- 22. Sew horizontal sashing rows together, pressing seams toward the pieced sashing units.
- **23.** Sew horizontal block and sashing rows together to complete quilt top assembly. The quilt top should measure 74 ½" x 74 ½" unfinished.





FINISHING THE QUILT:

- **24.** Sandwich quilt top with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method. Quilt as desired.
- **25.** Create binding using (8) **Fabric A** 2 ¼" x WOF strips.
- **26.** Attach binding using your preferred method.
