
General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are ¼" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.

<u>Piecing Instructions:</u> (Refer to block images for proper placement and rotation)


BLOCK 1: (square to 12-1/2", make 4)

1. Sew (1) J 2" X 9-1/2" strip to each side of (1) B 9-1/2" square, then sew (1) J 2" X 12-1/2" to top and bottom to complete BLOCK 1.





BLOCKS 2 and 3: (square to 12-1/2", make 4 each)


- 2. <u>Unit 1</u>: Sew (2) C 3" squares and (2) F 3" squares together as shown. Square to 5-1/2", make 8.
- 3. <u>Unit 2</u>: Similar to Unit 1, sew (2) C 2-1/4" squares and (2) J 2-1/4" squares together. Square to 4", make 16.
- 4. Unit 3: Similar to Unit 1, sew (2) F 2-1/4" squares and (2) J 2-1/4" squares together. Square to 4", make 16.




- 5. <u>BLOCK 2</u>: Sew Units and pieces together as shown into rows, then sew rows together to complete **BLOCK 2**.
- 6. BLOCK 3: Sew Units and pieces together as shown into rows, then sew rows together to complete BLOCK 3.











Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

- 7. Cut (2) 2" X 21-1/2" strips from H Border strip and sew to sides of A 21-1/2" square.
- 8. Cut (2) 2" X 24-1/2" strips from H Border strip and sew to top and bottom to create QUILT CENTER.
- 9. Sew (1) BLOCK 3 to the top of (1) BLOCK 2, then sew to left side of QUILT CENTER.
- 10. Sew (1) BLOCK 2 to the top of (1) BLOCK 3, then sew to right side of QUILT CENTER.
- 11. Sew together (from left to right) (1) BLOCK 1, (1) BLOCK 3, (1) BLOCK 2, (1) BLOCK 1, the sew to top of QUILT CENTER.
- 12. Sew together (from left to right) (1) BLOCK 1, (1) BLOCK 2, (1) BLOCK 3, (1) BLOCK 1, the sew to bottom of QUILT CENTER.

Border Assembly:

Border 1:

13. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 48-1/2"), cut (2) H 2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 51-1/2") cut (2) H 2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Border 2:

- 14. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 51-1/2"), cut (2) E 5-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt.
- 15. Sew (1) G 5-1/2" square to each side of (1) E 5-1/2" X 51-1/2" LOF strips. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
