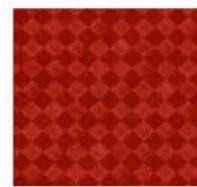

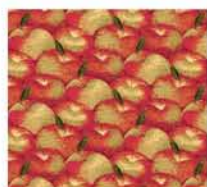

## Fabric Requirements

1 Panel	Light A	39052-X Multi (Panel) ***	1/4 Yard	Light B	39055-3 Cream
1/4 Yard	Light C	39058-5 Gold	1-3/8 Yards	Light D	39054-3 Cream
1/4 Yard	Medium A	39058-2 Green	1/4 Yard	Medium B	39058-1 Red
1/4 Yard	Medium C	39057-X Multi	1/2 Yard	Dark A	39056-X Multi
5/8 Yards	Dark B	39058-6 Black (Includes Binding)			

3-1/4 Yards Backing of your choice

56" x 60" Batting

## Cutting the Fabric

1. Light A – Fussy Cut a rectangles at 21-1/2" x 25-1/2" - Center.
2. Light B – Cut (1) strip at 6-1/2" x WOF – Sub-cut into (4) 6-1/2" squares – Border 2 Cornerstones.
3. Light C – Cut (2) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF – Sub-cut into (8) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles – Border 2.
4. Light D – Cut as follows:
  - a. Cut (2) strips from RAW edge to RAW edge at 5-3/4" x 43-1/2" (Sides) – Border 4.
  - b. From the balance of the fabric cut (4) strips at 5-3/4" x WOF which remains – then sew together at the 5-3/4" edge then sub-cut into (2) 5-3/4" x 50" rectangles (Top/Bottom) – Border 4.
5. Medium A – Cut (2) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF – Sub-cut into (12) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles – Border 2.
6. Medium B – Cut (2) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF – Sub-cut into (10) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles – Border 2.
7. Medium C – Cut (2) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF – Sub-cut into (12) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles – Border 2.

## Cutting Instructions cont.

8. Dark A – Cut as follows:

a. Border 1 – Cut (4) strips at 2” x WOF – Sub-cut into (2) 2” x 25-1/2” rectangles (Sides), and (2) 24-1/2” rectangles (Top/Bottom).

b. Border 3 – Cut (4) strips at 2” x WOF – Sub-cut into (2) 2” x 40-1/2” rectangles (Sides) and (2) 39-1/2” rectangles (Top/Bottom).

9. Dark B – Cut as follows:

a. Border 2 – Cut (2) strips at 2-1/2” x WOF – Sub-cut into (8) 2-1/2” x 6-1/2” rectangles.

b. Binding – Cut (6) strips at 2-1/2” x WOF.

## Sewing Instructions

Step 1 – Center and Border 1

10. Sew (1) Dark A 2” x 21-1/2” rectangle to each side of the Light A 21-1/2” x 25-1/2” rectangle then sew (1) Dark A 2” x 24-1/2” rectangles to the Top and Bottom to finish Border 1 at 24-1/2” x 28-1/2”.

Note: From this point forward each time a border is sewn on it will then be referred to as the CENTER for easier construction.

Step 2 – Border 2

11. Sew the SIDES together as follows to measure 6-1/2” x 28-1/2” – Make (2) --- Refer to the picture below for easier



12. All pieces are 2-1/2” x 6-1/2” and are sewn together at the 6-1/2” edge from Left to Right. Sew Medium B, Light C, Medium A, Medium C, Dark B, Medium B, Light C, Medium A, Medium C, Dark B, Medium B, Light C, Medium A, Medium C.

13. Sew (1) to each SIDE of the Center rotating so that the Medium B is on top at the Left and on bottom at the right.

## Sewing Instructions cont.



14. Sew the TOP and BOTTOM together as follows to measure 6-1/2" x 36-1/2" - Make (2) --- Refer to the picture above for easier placement of pieces.

15. All pieces are sewn together at the 6-1/2" edge from Left to Right. Sew Light B 6-1/2" square, Medium C, Medium A, Light C, Medium B, Dark B, Medium C, Medium A, Light C, Medium B, Dark B, Medium C, Medium A, Light B 6-1/2" square.

16. Sew (1) to the TOP and BOTTOM rotating so that the Medium C is towards the Left for the TOP and to the Right for the BOTTOM to finish Border 2 at 36-1/2" x 40-1/2".

### Step 3 - Border 3

17. Sew (1) Dark A 2" x 40-1/2" rectangle to the SIDES of the Center then sew (1) 2" x 39-1/2" rectangle to the TOP and BOTTOM to finish Border 3 at 39-1/2" x 43-1/2".

### Step 4 - Border 4

18. Sew (1) Light D 5-3/4" x 43-1/2" rectangle to both SIDES of the Center than sew (1) 5-3/4" x 50" rectangle to the TOP and BOTTOM to finish Border 4 and the quilt top at 50" x 54".

### Step 5 - Finishing the Quilt

19. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top and quilt as desired.

20. Using the Dark B 2-1/2" strips sew on the binding to finish the quilt.
