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### Making the Quilt Top


Press toward darker fabric when possible. All seam allowances are 1/4 inch.

1. Sew small black triangles to small blue triangles.

Make 8.



Add a blue square and silver square to two units.Make 4.




3. Sew 2 small black triangles to larger blue triangle.

Make 4 of each.



4. Add large silver triangle and two blue triangles to each of the first unit. Make 4.



5. Add two large black triangles to each unit. Make 4



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
6. Now take the other units from #3. To two units add a blue square on each end.




7. Sew the two remaining units to either side of center square.



8. Add strip from #6 to the other two side matching seams.



9. Add units from #5 to opposite sides of center making sure the star points are pointing out.





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10. Sew square units from # 2 to the ends of the two remaining units lining up the silver fabric.



11. Add these two units to opposite sides.



### **Adding Borders**

- Measure across the center of the star block. Make two border strips that length and attach
  to the sides. Measure across the center including the two border strips. Make two border
  strips that length and attach to top and bottom.
- 2. Repeat with the second border fabric.
- 3. Repeat with the outer border.
- 4. Make quilt sandwich and quilt as desired.
