

# Cambridge Breeze

## BORDERS:

Sew flying geese rows to top and bottom. Press.

Add 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" tan tonal strips to right and left sides of the quilt.

Add 2" x 40-1/2" cream paisley strips to right and left sides.

Sew 2" x 37-1/2" cream paisley strips to top and bottom. Press.

Add 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" black floral strips to right and left sides.

Sew 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" black floral strips to top and bottom. Press.

Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt to finish. Bind.



FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
30134-4 navy floral	1-3/8 yd	(48) 2-1/2" squares (12) 3-3/8" squares (2) 4-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips (2) 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" strips
30139-5 red tonal	1/4 yd	(24) 2-7/8" squares – cut in half diagonally to make two triangles (48 total)
30139-4 tan tonal	5/8 yd	(64) 2-7/8" squares – cut in half diagonally to make two triangles (128 total) (2) 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips
30136-3 purple paisley	1/4 yd	(6) 5-1/4" squares – cut diagonally twice to make four triangles (24 total)
30137-5 burgundy floral	3/8 yd	(11) 5-1/4" square – cut diagonally twice to make four triangles (44 total)
		 5-1/4" square cut example
30136-4 cream paisley	3/8 yd	(2) 2" x 40-1/2" strips (2) 2" x 37-1/2" strips
30139-3 lavender tonal	1/2 yd	(48) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
Backing	3 yds	sewn horizontally

## FLYING GEESE BLOCKS:

Sew (1) purple paisley triangle to (2)- tan tonal triangles to make a flying geese block. Press.

Repeat with remaining purple paisley triangles.



Sew (1) burgundy floral triangle to (2)- tan tonal triangles to make a flying geese block. Press.

Repeat with remaining burgundy floral triangles.



Sew one purple paisley flying geese block to one burgundy flying geese block. Place the purple paisley block on the bottom for all sets except three. Place the purple paisley on top for these three to be used in the top and bottom borders.



Using (4) of the blocks with purple paisley on the bottom, arrange blocks according to the picture to make a windmill pattern. Sew blocks together. Repeat to make 3 more windmill blocks. Sew these four block together to make your quilt center.



With the extra flying geese blocks, arrange top and bottom borders according to picture. Sew rows together, press and set aside.

## DIAMOND SQUARE BLOCKS:

Sew (4) red tonal triangles to the sides of a black floral squares. Press.

Repeat to make 12 diamond squares.



Add a lavender 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" to the right and left side each square. Press.



Sew (2) black floral 2-1/2" squares to each end of the remaining 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" lavender pieces. Press. Add these to the top and bottom of the diamond squares to finish each block. Press.



Sew (2) diamond square blocks together. Press. Repeat to make another set. Add a set to the right and left sides of your quilt center. (windmill blocks) Press.

Sew(4) diamond square blocks in a row. Press. Repeat to make another set. Add a set to the top and to the bottom of quilt center. Press.
