Sampler Collection

A sampler tells a story, capturing the events and emotions of a particular time. The Colonial Williamsburg Foundation's important collection of samplers and needlework, dating from the 17th century to the mid-19th century, includes a diverse selection of British and American needlework that help us trace the roots of their makers and better understand the world in which they lived. The samplers and individual design elements of this collection are taken from samplers and other needlework in the Foundation's collection.

Derived from the Latin "exemplum" meaning example, samplers usually included examples of a variety of stitches used as a teaching tool for young schoolgirls. In addition to learning practical stitching techniques, lessons in the alphabet, numbers, religion, art, and geography were reinforced.

		29721-4)
29721-1 green sampler strip	e 1/2 yd	(17) Fussy cut 2-3/8" x 7-1/2"
29724-1 green scallop	1/8 yd	(24) Template A
29728-2 blue cross-stit ch	1/4 yd	(20) Template D
29724-7 rose scallop	1/8 yd	(28) Template A
29720-2 blue floral	3/4 yd	outer border: (2) 4" x 43-1/2", (2) 4" x 45-1/2"(pieced)
29724-2 blue scallop	1/8 yd	(20) Template A
29728-1 green cross-stitch	1/4 yd	(24) Template D
29723-x alphabet	1/4 yd	(16) Fussy cut 3-5/8" x 4"

BLOCKS:

Sew (1) Template A triangles (blue scallop) to (1) Template D triangles (blue cross-stitch). Repeat to make another of the same triangle set. Sew two new triangle sets together to make block B. Press. Repeat to make 12 green blocks, 10 blue blocks and 14 rose blocks.

Block B

Referring to the quilt picture for placement.

Sew block B to fussy cut 3-5/8" x 4" blocks (alphabet or sampler blocks.)
Repeat to make 32 sets.





Sew 2 block set to top and bottom of fussy cut 2-1/4" x 7-1/2" green sampler strips.



Center block:

Sew (1) blue block to (1) red block

Sew this set to the top of fussy cut 2-3/8" x 7-1/2" green sampler strip. Sew (1) red block to (1) green block and sew to the bottom of green sampler strip.



Referring to the quilt picture for placement.

Layout blocks and fussy cut 7-1/2" x 8-1/2" squares. Sew blocks together in rows.

Sew rows together.

BORDERS:

Sew (2) 2" x 40-1/2" stripe strips to right and left sides.

Add (2) 2" x 38-1/2" stripe strips to top and bottom. Press.


Add (2) 4" x 43-1/2" blue floral strips to right and left sides. Sew (2) 4" x 45-1/2" blue floral strips to top and bottom. Press.

Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt to finish. Bind.


