
Chocolate Baskets

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Quilt Size: 42-1/2" x 51"

Fabric Requirements: All fabrics are frrom the Pink Chocolate collection by Nancy Gere for Windham Fabrics.

You will need:

Fat Quarters #29013-1, 29017-1, 29015-1 (pinks)

1/2 yd. #29014-1 (pink)

Fat Quarter #29007-2 (brown) for large center basket

Fat Quarter #29012-3 (red) for large center basket

2/3 yds. #29006-2 (brown)

2/3 yds. #29009-2 (brown

Assorted scraps of various reds and browns for small baskets

3-1/2 yds. #29011-3 – backing

1/2 yd. #29007-2 (brown) – binding

fusible web

12" Center Basket: cut:

Brown #29007-2

A - (1) 10-3/4" square, cut in half on diagonal(use only one half)

B - (2) 3" x 7-3/4"

C - (1) 5-3/4" square, cut in half on diagonal

Pink #29014-1

D - (4) 3-1/4" squares, cut in half on diagonal basket handle

Red #29010-3

D - (5) 3-1/4" squares, cut in half on diagonal

Using fusible web, trace large basket handle template and follow manufacturer's directions. Fuse handle to large brown triangle A before assembling the block.

6" Basket Blocks: cut:

Brown – use assorted browns and reds from collection

A - (1) 4-3/4" square, cut in half on diagonal

B - (1) 2-3/4" square, cut in half on diagonal

basket handle

Pink – use assorted pinks from collection D & E - (1) 5" square, cut in half on diagonal

C - (2) 2-1/2" rectangles

Using fusible web, trace small basket handle template and follow manufacturer's directions for fusing the handle onto upper triangle before assembling the block. Make 28 basket blocks

6" Plain Alternate Block:

Cut: (18) 6-1/2" blocks from brown #29006-2

Side Triangles: cut: (5) 10" squares, cut in quarters on the diagonal, of #29009-2.

Corner Triangles: cut: (2) 5 -1/4" squares, cut in half on diagonal, of #29009-2.

Assembly: Assemble rows on diagonal. Layer, quilt as desired and bind your finished project.



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
