3. Layer, bind and quilt as desired. This quilt was made with a diagonal straight line grid in one direction and straight line quilting in the vertical direction, forming a hanging diamond pattern.

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Quilt Size: 42" x 42"

Fabric Requirements:

Fat Quarter - #30037-2 (blue)
Fat Quarter - #30042-1 (red)
1 1/3 yds - #30029-1 (red) - Backing
1/2 yd - #30034-1 (red) - Binding
Assorted fat eighths of dark and light fabrics from the Clara Barton
Collection

GREEK CROSS BLOCKS:

Make 13 (6" finished) blocks. For EACH block, cut:


Red Fabric: (1) 2-1/2" square, (4) 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles Dark Fabric: (4) 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles, (2) 3" squares

Light Fabric: (2) 3" squares of #30037-2

Make (4) half-square triangle blocks by drawing a pencil line on the diagonal of each 3" light square.

Place right sides together with a 3" dark square and sew 1/4" on each side of the diangonal line.


Cut apart on the pencil line, press open to the dark side. Trim a perfect 2-1/2" sqaure. Assemble block per diagram.



9-PATCH BLOCKS:

Make 32 (6" finished) blocks. For EACH block cut:

Dark Fabric: (5) 2-1/2" squares Light fabric: (4) 2-1/2" squares Assemble block per diagram



SOLID BLOCKS:

Make 4 (6" finished) blocks. Centering the design fussy cut 6-1/2" squares from #30042-1 (red) fabric.

Assemble quilt rows per photo.
