Elegance II

- 7. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt the layers together.
- 8. Fold the binding strips in half lengthwise and press fold line. Align raw edges of binding with raw edges of quilt top. Sew in place then turn folded edge to back and stitch in place.

Embellishment option:

Fuse crystals to the centers of the flowers in the 13 blocks A to add sparkle to the quilt. (Beads can be sewn in place as an option).



2/3 yd	29099-1 Black Floral with swirls
1-3/4 yd	29100-1 – large floral for appliqué cut outs and wide outside border
3/4 yd	29102-1 – black stripe for blocks
2/3 yd	29102-1 – black stripe for binding
2/3 yd	29098-2 white with dotted swirls for blocks


Backing: 4 vds 29098-2 or 29100-2 (pick 1)

Backing: 4 yas 29	098-2 or 29100-2 (pick 1)
Cutting:	
29102-1 black	Cut (2) 5-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (13) 5-1/2"
	squares
	Cut (10) 1-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (48) 1-1/2" x 8" pieces
29096-2 mini-dots	Cut (8) 2" x wof strips, recut into (26) 2" x 5-1/2" pieces and (26) 2" x 8-1/2" pieces
	Cut (6) 1-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end and recut into (2) 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" vertical borders and
	(2) 1-1/2" x 52-1/2" horizontal borders.
29102-2 White	Cut (3) 3-7/8" x wof strips, recut into (24) 3-7/8"
	squares, cut each square in half on the diagonal once to make (48) triangles.
29095-1 flower	Cut (5) 5-7/8" x wof strips, recut into (24) 5-7/8"
	squares. Cut each square in half on the diagonal once to make (48) triangles.
29098-1 black	Cut (6) 2" x wof strips, recut into (26) 2" x 8-1/2" pieces.
	Cut (7) 2" x wof strips, recut into (26) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces
29100-1 floral	Cut (6) 6-1/2" x wof strips. Sew together end-to-end and
	recut into (2) borders 6-1/2" x 52-1/2" vertical
	borders and (2) 6-1/2" x 64-1/2" horizontal borders.
	Following manufacturer's directions iron the
	remainder of the fabric to the fusible web, then fussy
	cut (13) flowers, leaves and floral sprays for block


appliqué.

Sewing:

1. Refer to the Block A to sew 29096-2 short strips to sides of 29102-1 center square, then the sew the long same fabric strips to the top and bottom of the center square. Next sew the short 29098-2 short strips to opposite sides of the center square, then the long strips in the same fabric to the top and bottom of the center square to complete the block.



- 2. Fuse an arrangement of flowers, leaves and floral sprays to the center of each block, overlapping a little bit onto the first round of borders. Made a different arrangement in each block. Make 13 blocks A.
- 3. Center and sew a 29102-1 black stripe to the long side of each of the 29102-1 stripe triangles. Using your rotary cutting trim the ends of the black stripe even with the two short edges of the white stripe triangle as shown in the block B diagram. Sew each of these units to the flower print 29095-2 to make a square unit. Make (48) units. Sew four units together to make complete a block. Make 12 blocks B.



- 4. Alternate blocks A and blocks B in 5 rows of 5 blocks each referring to quilt photo for placement. Sew the rows together.
- 5. Sew vertical 29096-2 borders to the sides of the guilt top. Sew the same fabric horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 6. Sew the 29100-1 vertical borders to the sides of the quilt top and matching horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
