

## Sewing Continued:

4. Sew the triangle units made in Steps 2 and 3 to each side of square units made in Step 1 to complete the blocks. Make 4 blocks.
5. Sew the completed blocks into a large square for the center of the quilt.
6. Sew a fabric D vertical border to opposite sides of the quilt center and a fabric D horizontal border to top and bottom.
7. Sew (6) triangle H and (5) triangle J into a long strip. Square off the ends of the strip with a small triangle J at each end to make a triangle border strip. Make 4.



8. Sew two other border strips made in step 7 to opposite sides of the quilt.
9. Sew remaining small triangles J and the (4) small triangles H into squares. Sew these squares to opposite ends of the (2) remaining triangle border strips, then sew these squares to opposite ends of the (2) remaining triangle border strips, then sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.
10. Center fabric A border strips and sew to each side of the quilt. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric.
11. Sew (6) triangles G and (7) triangles I into a long strip. Make 4. Sew the strips to each side of the quilt top. Stitch the miters at each corner together.



## Finishing:

12. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste, then quilt the layers together.
13. Fold the binding strip over lengthwise and sew to quilt top. Turn folded edge binding to back of quilt and stitch in place.

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# Fiona's Garden

Designed by Jean Ann Wright  
Fabric from the Fiona Collection by Anna Griffin  
Skill Level: Intermediate  
Finished Quilt Size: 56" x 66"  
Block Size: 4 - Block Size: 16"

## Fabric Requirements and Cutting:

- Fabric A 1-1/2 yd SKU # 29561-2 lt green  
(4) length of fabric strips 3-1/2" x 49-1/2" fussy cut for stripe border
- Fabric B 1/3 yd SKU # 29562-5 pink  
(1) 4-1/2" x width of fabric (wof) strip recut into (8) 4-1/2" squares  
(1) 4-7/8" x wof strip recut into (8) 4-7/8" squares, recut on the diagonal once for (16) triangles
- Fabric C 1/4 yd SKU # 29563-2 lt green  
(1) 4-7/8" x wof strip recut into (8) 4-7/8" squares, recut on the diagonal once for (16) triangles
- Fabric D 1/3 yd SKU # 29564-2 lt green  
(4) 2-1/2" x wof strips, recut (2) 32-1/2" vertical borders and  
(2) 36-1/2" horizontal borders
- Fabric E 1/2 yd SKU # 29564-5 pink  
(7) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding
- Fabric F 2/3 yd SKU # 29565-2 green  
(2) fussy cut 4-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (8) 4-1/2" squares with flower motif centered  
(1) 4-7/8" x wof strip recut into (8) 4-7/8" squares, recut on the diagonal once for (16) triangles
- Fabric G 1-1/4 yd SKU # 29565-5 pink  
(6) 4-5/8" x wof strips fussy cut with flower motif in center of each strip. Make a paper triangle template cutting a 9-1/4" square and cutting it in half on the diagonal twice for 4 triangles. Center the template over a flower motif on the strips as a guide to cut the triangles. Cut 24.
- Fabric H 3/4 yd SKU # 29566-1 brown  
(4) fussy cut 6-1/8" squares with flowers in each square

## Fabric Requirements and Cutting continued:

- (2) 7-1/4" x wof strips recut into (6) 7-1/4" squares, then cut the squares in half on the diagonal twice to make (4) triangles from EACH square. Trim remainder of 2nd strip to 3-7/8" and cut (2) squares, cut these squares in half on the diagonal once for (2) triangles from EACH.
- Fabric I 1 yd SKU # 29567-1 brown  
(3) 9-1/4" x wof strips, recut into (11) 9-1/4" squares. Cut squares in half on diagonal twice to make (4) triangles from EACH square.
- Fabric J 1/3 yd SKU # 29567-2 lt green  
(1) 7-1/4" x wof strip recut into (5) 7-1/4" squares, then cut the squares in half on the diagonal twice to make (4) triangles from each square.  
(1) 3-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (6) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half on diagonal once to make (12) triangles.

Backing: 4 yd fabric D. Cut in half for (2) 2 yd lengths and sew together selvage-to-selvage. Trim to 70" square for backing.

## Sewing:

1. Sew a fabric C triangle to each side of a fabric H square. Sew a fabric I triangle to each side of the fabric C triangles. Make 4 See diagram 1 and 2

2. Sew a fabric F triangle to two adjacent sides of fabric B square. Make (8)
3. Sew a fabric B triangle to two adjacent sides of fabric F square taking care to keep flower motif facing up when the triangle units are sewn to the center unit made in step 1. Make 8.
