	5/8 yard	35447-2 Turquoise	Fabric A 1 Strip set 10 Squares	Cut 1 – 5 ¾" strip. Cut 10 – 5 ¾" squares.
	5/8 yard	35448-2 Turquoise	Fabric B 1 Strip Set 4 Triangles	Cut 2 – 5 ¾" strips. Cut 1 – 8 ¾" square. Cut diagonally twice.
	5/8 yard	35447-1 Purple	Fabric AA 1 Strip set 10 Squares	Cut 1 – 5 ¾" strip. Cut 10 – 5 ¾" squares
	5/8 yard	35448-1 Purple	Fabric BB 1 Strip Set 4 Triangles	Cut 2 – 5 ¾" strips. Cut 1 – 8 ¾" square. Cut diagonally twice.
	1 yards	35451-1 Purple	Fabric CC 4 Small Triangles 46 Triangles	Cut 2 – 4 5/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. Cut 12 – 8 ¾" squares. Cut diagonally twice.
	1/2 yard	35451-6 Pink	Fabric DD 4 Small Triangles 14 Triangles	Cut 2 – 4 5/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. Cut 4 – 8 ¾" squares. Cut diagonally twice.
	1 yard	35451-2 Turquoise	<u>Fabric C</u> 4 Small Triangles 46 Triangles	Cut 2 – 4 5/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. Cut 12 – 8 ¾" squares. Cut diagonally twice.



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1/2 yard	35451-5 Green	Fabric D 4 Small Triangles 14 Triangles	Cut 2 – 4 5/8" squares. Cut once diagonally. Cut 4 – 8 3/4" squares. Cut diagonally twice.
3/4 yard	35450-1 Purple	Border	Cut 8 – 3" strips
3/4 yard	35450-4 Grey	Border	Cut 8 – 3" strips
3/4 yard	35450-5 Green	Border	Cut 8 – 3" strips
5/8 yard	35449-3 Black	Binding	Cut 8 – 2 1/4" strips

Additional Material Needed:

- 4 ½ yards for backing
- 81" x 81" Quilt Batting

Making the Quilt

1. Sew 2 Fabric B strips to the Fabric A strip. Cut 6 - 5 3/4" units. Do the same for Fabric AA and Fabric BB.





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2. Sew a Fabric C triangle short side to each end of this 5 3/4" strip as shown. Make 6 in each colorway. Press seams toward Fabric B square.



3. Sew the 14 D triangles to 14 C triangles to make 14 squares. Do the same for the 14 DD and 14 CC triangles.

4. Sew a CD Square to each side of a Fabric A square. Then sew a Fabric C triangle to each end as shown. Make 6 in each colorway. Press seams toward center and outside (oppsite # 2 strip.)



5. Starting with a #4 strip sew to a #2 strip matching seams. Contine alternating strips sew together 3 units of each kind. Make two sets in each colorway.



6. To make the end units, sew the following pieces together as shown. Make the small triangle unit first by sewing the small triangles together as illustrated. Make 2 for left side and switching colors make 2 for right side in each colorway.













7. Add end units to the four strips.



8. Sew resulting strips together matching seams. Press.







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Borders

- 1. Sew two border strips together end to end to make one long 80" piece. Make 4 in each border color.
- 2. Sew green to gray to purple. Make 4 set.



3. Make mitered corners by sewing a unit to each side stopping a ¼" from each end. Make mitered corners by folding corners together right sides matching seams. Pin and draw line from extended seam allowance. Sew along line, then check to see if seams match before trimming.

Finishing the Quilt

- 1. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top. I use temporary fabric spray adhesive for basting. Quilt as desired.
- 2. Join 2 ¼" wide strips into 1 continuous piece for binding. Fold lengthwise and press. Trim and square quilt. Sew binding to quilt with a quarter inch seam. Either hand stitch in place; or turn, press, and machine stitch in the ditch.
