## Holiday Heritage

Piece two 4 1/2" plaid strips to measure 54 1/2" and attach to the sides of the quilt. Piece two strips to measure 4 1/2" x 44 1/2" for the top and bottom borders. Attach two 4 1/2" red floral squares to the outside edges of each strip and sew to the quilt.

Layer the quilt with backing and batting and quilt as desired. Trim the edges and bind with the 2 1/4" gold strips.

### **Materials List**

3/4 yd. focus print #29704-X multi (cut into 22 1/2" square)

1/4 - 1/2 yd. pieces of assorted red & green prints for blocks (cut into 6" squares)

1/2 yd. #29703-1 red & white floral for blocks and border corners (cut into sixteen 6" squares and four 4 1/2" squares)

1 yd. #29709-5 gold print for inner border and binding (cut into five 2 1/2" pieces and five 2 1/4" pieces)

1 yd. #29702-1 red plaid print for outer border (cut into six 4 1/2" pieces)

3 1/2 yds. backing fabric 56" x 66" piece of batting

### **Sewing Instructions**

To assemble quick half square triangle blocks, place two 6" contrasting squares, right sides together and draw a diagonal line across the lightest block. Stitch 1/4" from either side of the drawn line and cut apart on the line. Press open and trim block to 5 1/2",

if necessary.

Reserve six light red blocks to cut on the diagonal without sewing to use as half square triangles around the center square.

Following the quilt layout, place light and dark red, green and neutral squares right sides together to create half square triangle bocks as shown, alternating light and dark when possible.

Assemble eight rows into horizontal units for the center of the quilt, ending with the light red half square triangles around the 18 1/2" square. Pin and stitch these rows together into triangle units and then sew the units to the center square. See diagram below.



Continue piecing and adding the remaining units to complete the quilt center.

Piece and trim two gold 2 1/2" strips to measure 50 1/2" and attach to the sides of the quilt. Repeat to make two 44 1/2" strips to sew to the top and bottom.
