### Fabric Requirements:

Fat quarter of color #33433-2 Cut 12 1/2" square

33433-2

1/3 yard color #33438-3 cut 2 strips 1 1/2" with of fabric. Save the remainder of fabric for flying geese.

2 yards color #33434-3 Fussy cut 1 strip 1 3/4" x 54. Save remaining fabric for the Lemoyne stars and the border.

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard color #33435-1 fussy cut 4 (2 1/2") squares so you have a star in the middle of the square. Use the rest of the fabric for the flying geese.

½ yard color #33433-1 cut 2(12 ½ ") squares. Cut these in half diagonally.

12-14 fat quarters both light and dark to make flying geese.

 $\frac{1}{2}$  yard color #33438-5 cut into 5(2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips

 $\frac{1}{2}$  yard color #33440-2 cut into 6(2  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") strips.

#### Instructions:

- A. Sew the fussy cut piece from color 33434-3 and the strips cut from color 33438-3 together. Cut into 4 (12 ½") pieces.
- B. Sew a 12 ½" strip from A to the top and bottom of the 12 ½" square cut from color 33433-2. Sew the fussy cut star corner blocks to the ends of the remaining strips. Sew to the opposite sides of the square.
- C. Sew color 333433-1 triangles to top and bottom. Then sew remaining triangles to the sides
- D. Make 96 flying geese (use any method you are comfortable with). The flying geese should have dark centers and light outside triangles.
- E. Sew 12 flying geese in a row, make 8 rows. Sew 2 rows together side by side to make 4 rows. Each of the flying geese units should measure 2 ½" x 4 ½" (this includes seam allowance)
- F. Make 4 Lemoyne stars8 1/2" (use whatever method you want)
- G. Sew a row of flying geese to the top and bottom. Sew the stars to the end of 2 of the flying geese rows. Sew these rows to the side.
- H. Sew the 5 strips of color #33438-5 end to end. Cut from this 2 strips 40 ½" long Sew to top and bottom of quilt. Cut 2 strips 44 ½" long sew to the sides
- I. Sew the 6 strips of color #33440-2 end to end. Cut 2 stripes 44 ½' LONG. SEW TO TOP AND Bottom. Cut 2 strips 48 ½" strips and sew to sides.
- J. For the last border cut 4 strips(6 ½ ") from color #33434-5 using the two rows of floral strip with the clouds in the center. Sew to sides of quilt mitering the corners.
- K. Quilt as desired and bind.
